- **1. LORD OF WAR -** Won over 1700m at Marseille Borely on November 10th in a Class 2 race on his last start. Seasonal return and might improve for this outing
- **2. BAUHINIA RHAPSODY -** Three unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1900m at Deauville on January 3rd in a Class 3 race. Not the most reliable
- 3. LOST IN MUSIC 7th last time out, he won before that over 1600m at Pau on February 11th in a Class 3 handicap. Needs to drop a few kilos in the handicap
- **4. GREY TORNADO -** 6th last time out over 1700m at this track in a Class 3 race on March 13th. Seems out of form and is hard to fancy
- **5. GOLUPTIOUS -** Three unplaced runs of late, he won before that over 1300m at Deauville in a Class 2 handicap on November 27th. Needs a return to form

- **2. MOWAEVA -** Four unplaced runs since a win over 1300m in a Class 3 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 15th. Needs more reliability
- **3. TOLLARD ROYAL -** Four unplaced runs of late, 4th before that over 1400m at Deauville on December 4th in a Class 3 handicap. Others preferred
- **4. SIXTUS -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1100m at Fontainebleau on March 1st in a Class 3 handicap. Capable of making his presence felt
