- **1. MOZAR DE REVE D'OR -** Good 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 2.5 weeks ago. Clearly an up-and-coming colt and will take all the beating
- **2. MAJOR MESLOIS -** Made up for a pair of sanctions when 3rd of 13 in a 2450m Caen Class F on 3 March, and with form maintained, will be no soft touch
- **3. MAESTRO DE PAGERIE -** 5th of 12 in a 2450m Caen Class F a fortnight ago. In less-exalted company this time and is well-placed to make a big splash
- **4. MISTER FRIPOUILLE -** 6th of 12, a place behind MAESTRO DE PAGERIE (3), in a 2450m Caen Class F on debut a fortnight ago, and will need to find considerably more
- **5. MYTHIQUE RENKA -** 6th of 11, on return from a layoff, in a 2450m Caen Class F 10 days ago. Has yet to put his full potential on display but it is just a question of time
- **6. MITCH DE GRANOU -** 6th of 13 behind MAJOR MESLOIS (2) in a 2450m Caen Class F on 3 March. Can clearly trot and will be expected to finish closer this time

Summary: Nicely-related and thoroughly professional on his recent debut, MOZAR DE REVE D'OR (1) has an excellent opportunity to get off the mark. Romain Derieux's untried MONACO (11) will not be inconvenienced by the draw and appears to have the class to win a race of this nature. MAJOR MESLOIS (2) got back in the game at Caen and, with stride in check, will be expected to contest the finish. MYTHIQUE RENKA (5) will have progressed for his solid return run and should have the wherewithal to finish in the mix.

- **2. JENNY DAIRPET -** 6th of 16 when preparing for this in a 2800m Cholet harness Class F on 2 March. Will be race-fit by now and, if applied, will not go down easily
- **3. KALEA DREAM -** Lost her action early in a Class F under these conditions 12 days ago. Yet to make her mark in this branch of the business but can get a look-in if applied
- **4. JIVANOF DE GUEZ -** Unseen since running 10th of 12, first time under the saddle, in a 2800m Vire Class F on 1 December. Runs barefoot on re-entry but chances still appear limited
- **5. JAIZKIBEL -** 9th of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 16 March. Is considerably better than the result would suggest and can figure prominently if she turns
- **6. JASMINE DE LYONS -** Sanctioned in a 2850m Loudeac harness Class F on 16 March. Races barefoot for first time but still not a concern
- **7. KOOKIE DE BELLANDE -** 10th of 11 finishers, on first start since September, in a 2875m Enghien harness Class E on 11 March. Yet to win under the saddle but always gives her best and should not be underestimated

Summary: A complicated mare she may be but KRILLE ELLIS (8) encountered little opposition en route to victory here mid-month and, provided that Charline Blaizot keeps her focused, she has a decent chance of doubling her money. 25m worse off, JAFF DE MESLAY (15) has two runs under his belt, reverts to racing with hind shoes fitted, and looks the main threat. KIARA D'ECOTAY (10) left an excellent impression at Vire earlier in the month and, already a winner for Oscar Placier, must be considered a major player. KARAMAZOV (1) should not be too hastily-judged for his recent sanction; he has confirmed references under the saddle, sports a new configuration, and will have a lot to offer if he takes to the new profile.

- **2. LADY D'ELFE -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 11 March. Has a good spot in front and even racing shod looks a decent first-5 prospect
- **3. L'ETOILE FILANTE -** Fine servant making first appearance since running 2nd of 10 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 months ago. Returns to racing shod, has not once finished out of first 3, and must be afforded respect

- **2. HAROLD SAUTONNE -** Valiant 3rd of 11 in a 2550m Reims Class F on 15 March. Enjoys a front row break and will be expected to contest the finish
- **3. HUITRE D'OR -** Imposed at Caen on 3 March before running 3rd of 16 in a 2450m Class D at the same venue a week later. Enjoys a golden-entry here and François Lagadeuc will be eager to make hay
- **4. HEROINE DE GUERRE -** Has had time to recover after running 5th of 11 in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class E early last month. Handed a fine spot behind the car and has a good hand to play
- **5. HOPE YOU CAN -** Ran 4th at Amiens before repeating behind HARLEY DELTO (11) in a 2725m Graignes Class F on 16 March. Well-positioned on the front line and, reconfigured for the occasion, can play a small role
- **6. HEMILIO PIERJI -** 8th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class F a fortnight ago. Has looked ordinary this term and even with hind shoes off still appears to have his work cut out
- **7. GALON D'AMIRAL -** Failed to confirm Laval performance when 9th of 11 behind HAROLD SAUTONNE (2) in a 2550m Reims Class F on 15 March and will have few takers
- **8. HUNMEC SOMOLLI -** Made up for Caen blip when 3rd of 11, a place behind HARLEY DELTO (11), in a 2725m Graignes Class F on 16 March. Not a priority but with some luck in running can pick up a cheque
- **9. GRISBI DU PERSIL -** 8th of 11 behind HAROLD SAUTONNE (2) in a 2550m Reims Class F on 15 March. Has never excelled racing clockwise and is not about to start now
- **10. HUNADORA** Twice placed at Vincennes before running 7th of 15 behind HUNMEC SOMOLLI (8) in a 2900m Amiens Class F on 22 February. Is plainly better than that though and despite a 2nd line draw, still looks competitively well-in
- **11. HARLEY DELTO -** 2nd of 11 in a 2725m Graignes Class F on 16 March. Is new to the venue but has demonstrated fine versatility and must be classed as a contender
- **12. HALMIA DE VANDEL -** Unraced since running 5th of 18 in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last November. Barefoot for re-entry though, with Benjamin Rochard in the bike, and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **13. HILTON DU HOULET -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2500m Reims Class F on 2 March. On back line but is shod to preference and the engagement of Adrien Lamy will only enhance his prospects. First 5
- **14. FULGURIS SEGAH -** Has not been seen out since finishing 12th of 13 in a 2750m Cabourg monte Class E last October and has nothing to contribute

Summary: In cracking form and ideally-placed behind the car, HUITRE D'OR (3) races shod for her Lisieux bow but still looks the pick of the field. Starting just to her inside, HAROLD SAUTONNE (2) has been knocking at the door recently and Matthieu Abrivard will be eager to get a win into him under such good conditions. Similarly well-positioned in front, HEROINE DE GUERRE (4) seldom disappoints when focused and should appreciate the Lisieux profile. Runner-up in 4 of his last 5 races, HARLEY DELTO (11) is forced to break from the 2nd line but deserves to be rewarded soon.
