- **1. KERIDO DU TILLET -** Finished 12th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 20 November. Battling to find form and needs major improvement to win
- **2. KIMONO WIC -** Finished 9th in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 March. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- **3. KAKAO DECAST -** Finished 11th in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 15 December. Unreliable and needs to do more to win this race
- **4. KIWIX PONT VAUTIER -** Disqualified in class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March when barefoot. Has major disqualification issues and is probably best watched for now
- **5. KILLER POINT -** Disqualified in class F at Loudeac over 2850m on 16 March. Not easy to trust but is capable o scoring when wise
- **6. KABASCO -** Disqualified in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 February when barefoot. Has yet to be victorious and others are preferred this time
- **7. KHAO LAK -** Unreliable and finished 7th in class G at Toulouse over 2325m on 14 March. Capable of better and could finish in the money
- **8. KANAYOU -** Disqualified in class F at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 10 November. Has yet to win and is best watched returning from a break
- **9. KINGPIN -** Disqualified in class G at Toulouse over 2325m on 14 March when barefoot. Has won once in twenty career attempts and others make more appeal
- **10. KAMARO DUEM -** Finished 6th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Disappointing form this year but is capable of an upset on best form
- **11. KATMAI -** Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 23 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **12. KRISTOBAL -** Unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 2 March. Won at this course before that and can bounce back to score
- **13. KLANT D'OLIVERIE -** In good form and was third in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Should fight out the finish once again
- **14. KLASSIC MENCOURT -** Disqualified in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2025m on 16 October. Remains barefoot but is likely to need this run returning from a break
- **15. KASGAGNAT -** Very consistent and was fourth in class F at Auch over 2800m on 9 March. Hoding form well and should be very competitive in this line-up
- **16. KRIS ROC -** Disappointing recent form and was 8th in class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 March. Won well in December but has been unreliable since. Others preferred

- **17. KOSAK DU FER -** Disqualified in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 23 March. Won a nice race in his penultimate start and can contest the finish if smart
- **18. KING DE BOUTEAU -** Disappointing last run when 6th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 23 March. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

Summary: Trainer Julien Foin has a decent hand in this race. KRISTOBAL (12) was a good winner at this track in his penultimate start and gets the vote to score again. KLANT D'OLIVERIE (13) is in excellent form and will put up a strong challenge. KASGAGNAT (15) is very consistent and poses a serious threat to his stablemates. More was expected from KING DE BOUTEAU (18) last time, and he could be a danger as well.

- **3. KINCI DE BERCE -** Finished th in class F at Loudeac over 2875m on 16 March. On a long losing streak and others are preferred this time round
- **4. KAOLIK DE GUEZ -** Disqualified in class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 21 March. Won three races last year and has won once this year. Deserves some respect
- **5. KARELIA -** Unreliable but was runner-up in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 March. Has won once in twenty-five attempts but could earn some money
- **6. KIMONO JULRY -** Disappointing last run when7th in class E at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 2 March. In good form before that and has a winning chance
- **7. KHALEESI DE KACY -** Victorious in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 February. Has shown improvement and is capable of earning some more money
- **8. KOLORADO -** Finished 8th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 31 January. Victorious back in September but is in poor form since. Others preferred
- **9. KALITA DU PADOUENG -** Disqualified in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 March. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- **10. KIKI -** In good form and was victorious in Class F at Auch over 2250m on 16 February. Can double up against these rivals

- **3. HAMBO -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 27 December. Others are much preferred
- **4. HEURE BLEUE -** Likes this track and was victorious last time out in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 March. Has disqualification issues but can follow up
- **5. IZAYA DE COUSSERAT -** On a very long losing run and finished 13th last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 14 March. Others are preferred
- **6. GALAXIE DU PARC -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 14 March. Very unreliable but is capable of earning money

- **4. HIDALGO DE VARENNE -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 2 March. Has disqualification issues but can go one better this time
- **5. FALCOM DU BOCAGE -** Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 16 March. In good form before that and can make the frame

- **3. KYA DE JELMA -** Twenty-two starts without a victory and was 10th in Class F at Langon on 21 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break.
- **4. KANDY VENESI -** Disqualified last time out at Cholet on 2 March. Not easy to trust but is quite capable of contesting the finish when in the right mood
- **5. KALINKA DE NIEUL -** Battling to regain best form and finished 8th in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 15 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win.

- **3. LUCKY MAJYC** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 20 September. Returns from a break but could surprise if wise.
- **4. LORD DU GILET -** Yet to win a race but is in good shape and finished 3rd last time out in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 9 March. Has disqualification issues but is not out of it.
- **5. LUCKY RED -** Showed what he is capable of with a barefoot win in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 27 February. Can double up if in the same mood.
- **6. LITTLE DREAM D'ERI -** Yet to win a race but is knocking hard at the door and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 23 March. Can go one better.
- **7. LAZIO BUROIS -** Unbeaten in two starts barefoot, with the latest being in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 9 March. Can complete the treble.

- **9. LE GRAND BORNAND -** Returned from a break and finished 3rd in a claimer at Montauban over 2425m on 22 February. On a long losing run but could play a minor role
- **10. LE LITTLE CORSE -** Unreliable and finished 7th last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 March. Has disqualification issues, and others make more appeal.
- **11. LANCELOT BOCAIN** Returned to form and was not disgraced when 4th in Class E at this track over 2750m on 7 March. Capable of an upset.

- **5. LEA DANSE** Seemed to prefer the shorter distance and was victorious last time out in Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 7 January. Tries a lot further this time but is not out of it.
