- **1. HARRY GOLD -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 27 February. Yet to place in three efforts but can play a minor role
- **2. SACHA SUNRISE -** Yet to win but was third last time out in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 20 December. Been on a break but showed ability last year. Can go close if ready
- **3. SUPER TIE BREAK -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at this track over 2000m on 3 May.Performs well at this track and has Theo Bachelot in the saddle. Respect
- **4. KOVEL -** A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at La Teste-du-Buch over 1800m on 17 May. He was a little green then and should improve on that effort.
- **5. REINE DE BAVIERE -** Was 7th on debut in a Conditions race at La Teste-du-Buch over 1800m on 17 May. Open to improve but others are preferred

Summary: SACHA SUNRISE (2) acquitted himself well in good company as a two-year-old so it could pay to follow his progress on his reappearance, especially against opposition of this ilk. Consistent COUPE D'EUROPE (6) lines up in good form and physical condition with the aid of an excellent position in the starting stalls. She ought to pose a threat along with debut runner-up KOVEL (4). Of the remainder, SUPER TIE BREAK (3) appeals most.

- **3. HOUBI -** Won a Handicap last time out at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 3 May. She is a strong front-runner and can lead all the way.
- **4. PRETTY BERRY -** Was 8th in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 12 April. Drawn well and was a runner-up at this track in February. Not out of it
- **5. SOVEREIGN -** Was 5th in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 1600m on 4 May. She might prefer this distance but is yet to win. Place chance

Speedy last-start winner HOUBI (3) could play another leading role under a penalty, while PRETTY BERRY (4) ought to redeem herself with the blinkers removed after overracing with the headgear fitted last time. LOUIS DE LA KLAUSS (2) opened his account in a maiden recently and can continue his momentum.

- **3. SMILE FOR ME -** She debuted on this track when third in a Conditions race over 1200m on 10 May. With natural improvement can go close again
- **4. ALLABARA -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1200m on 8 May. Can at best play a minor role
