- **1. HARKANSAS DE L'OZE -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 21 April. Won his penultimate start and deserves respect
- **2. ILOMBA DU GUESCLIN -** Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class F at this course over 2950m on 12 May. Capable of winning when in the mood
- 3. GARTA MAG Has struggled this year and was 7th last time out in a Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 28 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. HIVAROSA DU BOCAGE -** In fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over this distance on 22 May. Could play a minor role
- **5. ILLUSION DU VAL -** More lethal over shorter but is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 April. Be right there at the finish once again
- **6. IPSY DU BOCAGE -** Showed improvement when fourth last time out in Class F at this course over 2950m on 12 May. Can contest the finish
- **7. HALICANTE MABON -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Chartres on 8 May. Capable of winning when in the mood
- **8. INCOGNITO -** Has won twice this year including last time out in Class H at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2825m on 5 May. Not out of it
- **9. GRAVONA -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Durtal on 19 May. Capable of a surprise when wise
- **10. ISTRA DU PERCHE -** Does best in claimers and was 9th last time out in Class G at this course over 2950m on 12 May. Others are preferred

- **3. JACY DE NARMONT -** Much improved since going barefoot and was victorious again last time out in Class F at La Réole over 2350m on 9 May. Can complete a hat-trick
- **4. JOSY -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Senonnes-Pouancé on 5 May. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- **5. JOLLY DES BORDES -** Bounced back to form with a Class F win last time out at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 19 May. Capable of following up
- **6. JARNY DE BERTRANGE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 19 May. Can earn some money
