C1 - PRIX LEGTPA HYERES-AGRICAMPUS VAR - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. IZZIE PONCELET** - On a long losing run and finished 9th in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. HARMONICA** - Did not show his best when 6th in class F over this track and trip on 25 April. Quite capable of contesting the finish
- 3. JEEN LOVER** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class G at this course over 2850m on 1 May. Remains barefoot and can be a threat to these rivals
- 4. ISIS PASSION** - In good shape and finished 4th in class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 7 May. Can be competitive once again
- 5. IXCES BUROIS** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at Landivisiau over 3200m on 9 May. Has shown improvement and is barefoot. Place chance
- 6. INSAISSABLE DUO** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in class F over this course and distance on 25 April. Has claims in this line-up
- 7. JEWELLE OF JANE** - Needed her only run of the year when 11th in class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 24 April. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 8. JUST D'HERIPRE** - Has shown improvement of late and was 3rd in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 May. Could be a lively danger
- 9. ISLA** - Disqualified in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Has struggled all year and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. HOOLIGAN ONE** - Did not show his best when 13th in class E at Lignieres over 2825m on 17 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 11. JAKARTA DU LEVANT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 May. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now

Summary: A tricky opening event. INSAISSABLE DUO (6) is sent out with confidence by his trainer and should be firmly in the mix. JEEN LOVER (3), shaped encouragingly at this course last time, looks the main danger. HARMONICA (2), who meets a field within her capabilities so should be respected in this line-up. ISIS PASSION (4), representing Jean-Marie Roubaud, also has solid claims as she has been in good form of late.

C2 - PRIX DES PARTENAIRES PMU - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. MAEVA DE COQUERIE - Did not show her best when 7th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

2. MAVERICK ELLIS - Successful in 4 of just 7 starts, including last time out in Class A at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 8 November. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough

3. MADONE DU TRIEUX - Disqualified five times in a row, including last time out at Vichy over 2150m on 18 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred

4. MACARENA D'HOULBEC - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 15 May. Battling to find best form but is capable of making the frame

5. MUCHO CASH - Disqualified in two of his last three starts, including last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

6. MALIDA - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

7. MISTER DU CHOQUEL - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Has claims in this line-up

Summary: MISTER DU CHOQUEL (7) made a very pleasing impression last time and is likely to attract plenty of support. The main threat could come from MAVERICK ELLIS (2), returning from a break with front shoes fitted has shown ability and is capable of scoring. MAEVA DE COQUERIE (1) is worth another chance and should not be dismissed too quickly. MACARENA D'HOULBEC (4) is capable of springing a surprise in this small-field contest.

C3 - PRIX FABIEN ROSSOLINI - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LATINUS DU PRE** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2650m on 1 May. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
- 2. LIBERTANGO** - Victorious last time out in Class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Has improved this year and could make the frame
- 3. LITTLE CROWN** - On a long losing run but did finish 5th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Could play a minor role
- 4. LOTHBROCK** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Can play a minor role in this line-up
- 5. LASCAR D'ENFER** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 6. LILY CARNOIS** - On a long losing run but has been consistent of late and finished fourth in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Should be competitive once again
- 7. LANNISTER** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Can go one place better
- 8. LOOKING SIXTY ONE** - Holding form well and finished fourth in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 24 April. Should make a bold bid for victory

Summary: A very competitive looking form. LOOKING SIXTY ONE (8), is holding form nicely and could well return to winning ways. Ultra-consistent at this level, LANNISTER (7) is the main threat. LASCAR D'ENFER (5), arrives on the back of solid efforts in the provinces but should be competitive at this track. The reliable LILY CARNOIS (6) has not won for some time now but is capable of making the frame yet again.

C4 - PRIX DU CHATEAU REAL-MARTIN - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 38,000

- 1. ICARE DE PHYT'S** - On a long losing run and was 7th in Class B at Hyères over 2850m on 1 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class A at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Capable of doing better and can be competitive this time
- 3. HOT SUMMER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class A at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Has claims in this line-up
- 4. HEYDAY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Did win over this course and distance before that and can challenge for top honours
- 5. FOX PAPA TANGO** - Off form and finished 11th in Class D at Castillonès over 3475m on 8 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. GALOPIN DES CHAMPS** - Unreliable and finished tenth in Class A at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. FLYING BRICKELL** - Disqualified in three of his last five starts, including last time out at this course. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. INSTRUCTOR** - Finished 6th in Class D over this course and distance on 9 May. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it on best form
- 9. ILLICO DU JAS** - Has struggled of late and finished 7th in Class D over this track and trip on 9 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: HOT SUMMER (3) has only been modest lately but is barefoot and ready to striek in a race of this nature and gets the vote to score. HEYDAY (4), seeking redemption, heads the opposition and has won over this course and distance.along. INSTRUCTOR (8), is capable of going well at this level if he keeps his action together. Proven in this grade, GAVROCHE DE L'ITON (2) is not without a chance as well.

C5 - PRIX LIONEL GAZENGEL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. GOLZAC DE REM** - Has shown improvement of late and finished runner-up in Class E over this track and distance on 1 May. Can go one place better
- 2. GALVESTON** - Has won two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 1 May. Can follow up
- 3. JEREMY D'AS** - Has only been modest this year and finished 6th in Class E at Thouars over 2700m on 14 May. Capable of doing better and can contest the finish
- 4. ICARE FILE** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in Class A at Nîmes over 2750m on 17 May. Has disqualification issues but must be respected for that performance. Can upset
- 5. HOUSTON PEJI** - Disqualified last time out at Graignes over 2725m on 30 December. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 6. HARBOUR D'ORGERES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this course on 9 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. JUDOPOCK** - Not easy to trust and arrives after a disqualification at Vichy over 2800m on 18 May. Others are preferred
- 8. FELDSPATH THEPOL** - Has not won for some time now and finished 6th in a claimer at Elbeuf over 2775m on 26 April. More is needed to score
- 9. JAGUAR DU BOCAGE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class D at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Has a place chance on best form

Summary: Back to his best, GALVESTON (2) is expected to follow up. and beat these rivals as well. JEREMY D'AS (3), sent out with confidence by his trainer, will try to show improvement and be a threat. GOLZAC DE REM (1), is returning to form, also warrants plenty of respect. ICARE FILE (4), who shaped encouragingly last time at Nîmes but he does have disqualification issues and has not won for some time now.

C6 - PRIX AMYA EXPERTISE - 2850m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **NOLANN DES AGETS** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Might play a minor role at very best

2. **NIDORINO** - Not reliable but was fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 29 April. Can be a threat to these rivals

3. **NORMANDIE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 15 May. Capable of making the frame when staying on the trot

4. **NABUCCO DES ARRIS** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 15 May. Can surprise if smart

5. **NARRATRICE** - Consistent so far and was runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Can go one place better

6. **NELSON DU DUDY** - Successful last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 May. Improving and is capable of scoring again

7. **NOVELTY** - Has won two of her three starts, including last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 29 April. Should fight it out

8. **NIRVANA D'HERMES** - Disqualified in three of just six starts so far but was third last time out in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 15 May. Clearly not out of it when smart

Summary: An interesting race. NELSON DU DUDY (6) got off the mark last time out over this course and distance and will look to follow up. He is improving but faces strong opposition from NOVELTY (7), who bolted up at Marseille-Borély. NIRVANA D'HERMES (8), is very hard to trust but is capable of scoring when staying in stride. NORMANDIE (3) has the ability to spring a surprise but will have to be smart this time around.

C7 - PRIX DU HANDBALL HYERES - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

- 1. JEAN D'HOLLENBOURG** - Disqualified last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Tries a mounted race but others make more appeal
- 2. IN THE MOOD GEDE** - Broke a long losing run when a barefoot winner in a Class E mounted race at Monflanquin over 2500m on 10 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 3. JET DU RAVARY** - Unreliable but was successful when barefoot in a Class F mounted race at Cavaillon over 2600m on 19 September. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 4. HERCULE DU LEVANT** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Fitter this time and is capable of earning some money
- 5. GO FOR BELLAY** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a Class F mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Can get involved with the finish
- 6. HAVRE DE PAIX** - On a long losing run and finished fifth in a Class E mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 May. Capable of contesting the finish
- 7. HOLD UP NOCTURNE** - Finished fourth last time out in a Class E mounted race at Monflanquin over 2500m on 10 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. JOKER DU HAMEL** - Much improved of late and was a barefoot winner in a Class E mounted race at Cavaillon over 2600m on 7 April. Could follow up

Summary: JOKER DU HAMEL (8) was an impressive winner at Cavaillon last month and has every chance of following up. Talented but unpredictable, HAVRE DE PAIX (6) heads the opposition along with JET DU RAVARY (3), who returns from a break but whose connections are confident of a decent performance. IN THE MOOD GEDE (2) is a potential spoiler and arrives for this after confidence-boosting success at Monflanquin earlier this month.

- 1. INTEL** - Victorious in his last two starts, the latest in class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Can score again
- 2. JESCO DE LA VALLEE** - Unreliable of late and finished 9th in class G at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. ITXASSOU** - Has shown improvement of late and was 3rd in class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Can be a thret to these rivals
- 4. JUAN LES PINS** - Vsuccessful twice in a row, the latest in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Capable of completing the hat-trick
- 5. JORDANA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. INGENIOUS BOND** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Consistent when staying in stride and is not out of it
- 7. ITYA DE BOSSENS** - Disqualified twice i last three starts, including last time out in class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. On a long losing but can make the frame when smart
- 8. GAETANE DU VIVIER** - Holding form and finished 4th in class H at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Has a place chance in this line-up

Summary: A potential match-race in this lucly last race. JUAN LES PINS (4) arrives on the back of two consecutive wins and looks well placed to complete the hat-trick. INTEL (1), remains iin excellent form, heads the opposition along with INGENIOUS BOND (6), who is sent out with confidence by his connections. If keeping his action together, ITYA DE BOSSENS (7) has the ability to also get into the mix of things.
