

## R2 LYON-PARILLY [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'AZUR - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000**

- 1. MAESTRA DU PRATOU** - A four-year-old filly by Alto de Viette out of Vitesse du Stade who is making her debut. Her mother won 8 of her 64 starts. Can be a threat
- 2. MAC LAREN CHENOU** - Has not shown much so far and finished 9th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Needs major improvement to score
- 3. MISS DE GODINIÈRE** - Has major disqualification issues and was 8th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. MAGIC MOVER** - Showed vast improvement when runner-up in Class H at Julliangés over 2425m on 21 June. Might play a minor role
- 5. MARA D'ATOUT** - Has faulted in her last six starts, the latest at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Hard to trust but can surprise if smart
- 6. MAGALI DU CHERISAY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 19 June. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 7. MAJORA BELLA** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 19 June. Has yet to win a race but might play a minor role when smart
- 8. MERCI MERCY** - Fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Can make the frame if staying in stride this time
- 9. MEGANE** - Unreliable but was fourth last time out in Class H at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Has claims in this line-up
- 10. MISS HAPPY** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class F at this course over 2600m on 9 June. Can contest the finish once again
- 11. MOME DES ANDRAUX** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Needs to do more to score

**Summary:** MEGANE (9) has thrived since joining the southern yard of David Békaert and will, as usual, be driven by her trainer, who looks set for a good evening. MISS HAPPY (10) and MERCI MERCY (8) both ran well in the key race on 9 June and are worth another chance. MAESTRA DU PRATOU (1), the only debutant in the field and a well-qualified sort, adds further interest in a tricky opening event and must be respected.

## C2 - PRIX DE LA CRAU - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **MEMPHIS GABINLEA** - Disqualified in both starts so far, the latest at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 24 June. Hard to trust and makes little appeal
2. **MERCURY DRY** - Has shown little in two starts, the latest when disqualified at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. Others are preferred
3. **MEKTOUB DE NAPPES** - Finished 7th in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 13 June. Kept to mounted races so far and others make more appeal
4. **MACLOBEL DE FADAJE** - Disqualified in three of his last five starts, the latest in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Hard to trust but is capable of playing a minor role.
5. **MORAVCIK** - Showed some improvement when third in Class H at Montluçon over 3025m on 7 June. Might play a minor role at best
6. **MON LUCERNAIS** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Might pop up in a place if at best
7. **MY BEAUTIFUL** - Has improved of late and finished fourth in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Could make the frame
8. **MAGIC DU SABLIER** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 8th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **MACHTWO DU MORTIER** - Unreliable but was third in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Capable of scoring in an open race
10. **MYLOVE DES RIVIERE** - Has shown improvement of late and finished fourth in Class F at this course over 2600m on 9 June. Should fight out the finish
11. **MISTRAL DE RATILLY** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F over this course and distance on 21 May. Successful before that and can score again
12. **MAGIC PEGASUS** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a claimer at Vichy over 2975m on 18 June. Capable of earning some money when smart

**Summary:** Handed to David Békaert for the first time, MACHTWO DU MORTIER (9) could finally break through after a series of near misses in recent weeks. In good form MYLOVE DES RIVIERES (10) and MISTRAL DE RATILLY (11) look set to provide the main opposition. MYLOVE DES RIVIERE (10) has course experience and is slightly preferred to MYLOVE DES RIVIERE (10). MY BEAUTIFUL (7) has been knocking on the door of a podium finish and may well get her reward here

### C3 - PRIX DU MEDOC - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

1. **LORD SUGAR** - Has struggled all year and was 11th in a Class G harness race at this track over 2600m on 5 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
2. **LE BEAU GOSS D'ABY** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a Class F mounted race at Bollène over 2800m on 7 June. Can do even better this time. Place chance
3. **LORD DAIDOU** - Disappointing form of late and was 9th in a Class F harness race at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score.
4. **LUSKO** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, the latest in a mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 10 June. Not easy to trust but can make the frame
5. **LAURE DES RACQUES** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 10 June. Might play a minor role
6. **LOOK DES FANES** - Did not show his best when 9th in a Class F harness race over this course and distance on 9 June. Can be a threat back under the saddle
7. **L'ARTISTE DERONFIN** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Oraison over 2650m on 8 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
8. **LOVA DE FROMENTEL** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Erbray over 2700m on 14 June. Yet to win but can contest the finish when smart
9. **LAPSUS** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class F harness race at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. Might be better in harness races but is not out of it
10. **LABEL DE CHENU** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at Chartres over 2825m on 17 June. Big chance back under the saddle

**Summary:** Partnered with the in-form Quentin Seguin for this ambitious assignment, LABEL DE CHENU (10) looks a strong contender. Usually reliable, LOVA DE FROMENTEL (8) is best forgiven her recent disqualification and is a real threat, LAPSUS (9) is worth another chance on his return to mounted action. LUSKO (4), if keeping his mind on the job is also capable of getting involved with the finish over this course and distance.

## C4 - PRIX DE L'ENTRE-DEUX-MERS - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **KALINKA KOP** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in a Class F mounted race at Bollène over 2800m on 7 June. Might earn some minor money
2. **KRISTINA BELLA** - Has struggled of late and finished 14th in Class G at La Roche-Posay over 3150m on 31 May. Needs major improvement to score
3. **KIMBRA DJOC** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class G at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Could play a minor role at best
4. **KELINA SUPREME** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in Class F at Vichy over 2800m on 18 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
5. **KENZA SPORT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Capable of being a threat on best form
6. **KELLY DU LYONNAIS** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a claimer at Jullianges over 2450m on 21 June. Tougher task this time but might earn minor money
7. **KOMANIA D'ABY** - Battling to find best form and finished 14th in Class F at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. More is needed to score
8. **KATE METEOR** - Has some fair form of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 10 June. Can win a race of this nature
9. **KANTARELLINA CHIC** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at this course over 2600m on 9 June. Capable of earning minor money at best
10. **KANEA DE L'ABBAYE** - Not easy to trust and was 7th in Class G at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Capable of challenging for top honours
11. **KALLISTEE** - Remains in good shape and was runner-up in Class G at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Can go one better

**Summary:** Transferred to David Békaert after the winter, KATE METEOR (8) has fully blossomed and looks to have a fine opportunity to open her account. By far the most accomplished runner in the field, KALLISTEE (11) is not without hope despite conceding 25 metres. KENZA SPORT (5), back among professional ranks can be competitive. KANEA DE L'ABBAYE (10) is capable of a revival and can get into the mix of things as well.

## C5 - PRIX DU PAYS DE DER - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LATINO TURGOT** - Has only been modest of late and was 9th in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Needs to do more to score
- 2. LINO DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest over this track and trip on 9 June. Capable of a surprise when staying in stride
- 3. LOLA DE CHANLECY** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 9 June. Can be competitive once again
- 4. LOULOU DU SABLIER** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Capable of an upset over this track and trip
- 5. LEA D'EP** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. In good form before that and can make the frame
- 6. LENNON DU VIVIER** - Disqualified last time out at Vichy over 2950m on 15 June. Not easy to trust but cannot be ruled out
- 7. LEADER DU RABUTIN** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class F at this course over 2600m on 14 April. Returns from a short break and could need this run.
- 8. LUTIN QUICK** - Finished third in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 10 June. Has disqualification issues but is quite capable of scoring
- 9. LE MAGNIFIQUE DJOC** - Has some fair form and was fifth in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. On a long losing run but is not out of it
- 10. LIKE A JULRY** - Successful last time out in Class E at Nîmes over 2750m on 14 June. Has only lost once in 9 starts and can score again
- 11. LEMON DE LA VALLEE** - Very consistent and finished third in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Should contest the finish once again.

**Summary:** LIKE A JULRY (10) was likely having an off day when beaten once but has since resumed winning ways and could record a ninth success in ten starts. Runner-up in that same race, LEMON DE LA VALLEE (11) should once again be in the thick of things. If keeping her stride, LUTIN QUICK (8) holds a winning chance. LEA D'EP (5) is better than the last run would suggest and is quite capable of making the frame once again.

## C6 - PRIX DE LA VENDEE - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000

- 1. JUAN D'OCCAGNES** - Has major disqualification issues and was 14th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 18 June. Hard to trust and makes little appeal
- 2. ISIS DU CORTA** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Might play a minor role.
- 3. IGLIANO DES IRIS** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class F at Vichy over 2800m on 13 June. Capable of being a threat when smart.
- 4. JAKABINO** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Has a place chance on best form.
- 5. JUPITER FRANCE** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 8th in Class F over this track and trip on 9 June. Quite capable of contesting the finish
- 6. JIM JULRY** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 5 June. Should get involved with the finish once again
- 7. IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 16 June. Could earn some more money
- 8. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - Not reliable and was 11th in Class F at Nîmes over 2750m on 14 June. Has already won three times this year and could score again

**Summary:** JOLI MEC D'AMOUR (8) is only partnered with David Békaert for major targets and, racing unshod, looks an obvious contender. However, this is far from straightforward against JIM JULRY (6), who is knocking at the door, and JUPITER FRANCE (5), who is expected to rediscover his form sooner rather than later. IGLIANO DES IRIS (3) faces a tough task against younger rivals but can still be competitive for this.

## C7 - PRIX DU DAUPHINE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. LEYLI DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vichy over 2950m on 18 June. Very unreliable but can be a threat when smart.
- 2. LE BON MAYENNAIS** - Battling to regain best form and was disqualified last time out at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Others are preferred
- 3. LOFTEUR** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. More is needed to score
- 4. LOVA DE BOURGOGNE** - Successful in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 16 June. Not reliable but is also not out of it.
- 5. LAZZARO THE BEST** - Has only been modest of late and finished 9th in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Can be competitive again.
- 7. LEADER DES RIOULTS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 24 April. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. LORD DES FANES** - Victorious last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Capable of following up.
- 9. L'ESPOIR** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred

**Summary:** A very open looking lucky last race. LORD DES FANES (8) had to battle for a year and a half before landing only the second win of his career and may well have finally unlocked the door to further success. He will, however, need to beware of the three fillies in opposition: LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (6), ideally configured in terms of shoeing; LOVA DE BOURGOGNE (4), transformed since going unshod; and LEYLI DE LA VALLEE (1), who is best not judged too harshly on recent efforts.
