- 1. HAPPY FACE Fifth beaten 9.5L in a lower class recently. Has placed at this level and not ruled out.
- 2. **HEADSCOTT** Third beaten 3.25L behind a subsequent winner in this class at Les Sables-D'olonne. In the mix.
- 3. FAKIR DU VALLON Ninth in a lower class recently and hard to consider.
- 4. **HAMYOT DE BOMO** Second beaten 0.25L at Cabourg in a lower class. Time before made all to win in this grade.
- 5. **HOTEL MYSTIC** No form in last six and hard to have.
- 6. **HAILEY D'OURVILLE** Third beaten 3L at this venue in this class. Proven at this level and has a win and a placing from three starts barefoot.

- 3. HYPOTHESE MADRIK Back to back DQ and starting to get difficult to trust.
- 4. HIKATIKA Down the field ten days ago in a lower class. A bit to prove now.
- 5. **HOMELIE** Eighth beaten 5.5L at Craon in a higher class. May improve down in grade.
- 6. **HANNA KARENINE** Bidding for a hat-trick after winning here in a lower class by 0.75L. Won both outings in this shoeing combination. The one to beat.
- 7. HIPPIE FUN Ninth beaten 10L here in a lower class. Not an obvious winner.
- 8. **HAZILYS** Four DQ in last five. Second beaten 6L at Caen on the only completed outing. More needed.

- 3. **FLOWER BY MAGALOU** Second beaten 1L at Carentan in a lower class three weeks ago. Capable at this level.
- 4. CARINA DU PARC Shown little in last three outings and unlikely to change here.
- 5. **CLEA MIQUELLERIE** Eighth beaten 15L here in this class. Solid third at a lower level prior. Worth another try.
- 6. **DELMONICA** Eighth beaten 9.25L in this class at Amiens two weeks ago. This looks a weaker event.

- 3. **GROUPIE DU QUENNE** Nose winner of a tougher contest at Lisieux two back before a DQ. Good place record at this venue and races barefoot.
- 4. **GIPSY DES CAILLONS** Struggling to find the frame at this level and higher recently. Place claims based on 1.25L fourth at Agen in June.
- 5. **GUADALUPE** DQ three times from last four outings. Solid record over this distance when completing with one win and three placings from eight attempts.
- 6. GOMORRA QUICK DQ on first two outings of the campaign and needs a completion.

- 4. **ILLUSTRE MAN** Useful 3.25L third at this venue against similar competition latest. Rates well on that form.
