- **2. LUEUR DU CHATELET -** Racecourse debutante that qualified respectably under harness here a month back. Fitted with 4 pads for the occasion and should prove competitive for a first-3 place
- **3. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER -** Qualified in 1'17"5 under the saddle but still to make good on her promise, latterly sanctioned in a Class F over course and distance two weeks ago. Entrusted to Paul Ploquin for the occasion and it is only a matter of time before she comes good
