

SATURDAY, 28/02/26

C1 - PRIX PEACE CORPS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. LEIRIA - Has lost the way of late with many faults, the latest being at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 13 February. Probably best watched for now

2. LADY DU JAS - Did not show her best when 9th in Class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 29 November. More is needed to beat these rivals

3. LIZY DU VIVIER - Not reliable but did not run badly when fourth in Class F over this track and trip on 25 January. Might play a minor role again

4. LUNE D'ERABLE - Disqualified last time out at Nimes over 2750m on 11 November. Returns from a break and could need this run

5. LADY BLACK ROCHEL - Likes this track and trip and was third in Class E on 12 February. Has a big winning chance in this line-up

6. LIZA MARCEAUX - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Might play a minor role at very best

7. LOLITA DE RICO - Has major disqualification issues and finished 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 12 February. Needs to do more to score

8. LUNE SMILE - Has been struggling of late and was 7th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 10 February. Others are preferred

9. LAIKA D'ESPACE - Showed some improvement when 6th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Can make the frame

10. LADY FLO DE MAX - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 12 February. Can go one place better

11. LOVICTORY WILLIAMS - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 13 February. Runs best with this shoeing. Can be a lively danger

12. LADY DRY - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 12 February. Has a place chance if smart

13. LILLY DE GOUYE - In good shape and was fourth in Class E at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Can be competitive once again

Summary: An interesting start to the card. LADY BLACK ROCHEL (5) was unlucky not to win over this course and distance a few weeks ago and should go one better. LOVICTORY WILLIAMS (11) has only been modest of late but is at her best with this shoeing and could be a lively danger. LILLY DE GOUYE (13) remains in good shape and could get involved with the finish. LAIKA D'ESPACE (9) is capable of improvement and could make the frame.

C2 - PRIX HELLO CLASSIQUE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. KEOPS JUTH - Three disqualifications in his last five starts, the latest at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Capable of winning when staying on the trot

2. KONTIO DE LOU - Has really struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Others are preferred

3. KRAC DE CAZOULENE - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Can earn some more money

4. KING GIORGIO - Disqualified three times in last five starts, including last time out in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

5. KALYPSO DE CHOC - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score

6. KRISTAL DES MOYEUX - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Capable of making the frame when smart

7. KHAZAR DES CORVEES - Showed vast improvement when a barefoot winner in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Does tend to struggle at this track but cannot be ruled out from winning

8. KLEPPER DU LOIR - Off form and finished 14th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 16 February. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

9. KABYLIE DES EDEL - Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 16 January. Can earn some money

10. KOUGAR DE SIMM - Did not show his best when 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 16 January. Did win before that and can bounce back to score

11. KADO D'OCCAGNES - Very unreliable and finished 8th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Should need this run returning from a break

12. KONOR HIGHLAND - Not reliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Could be a threat this time around

13. KUNG FU FAMILY - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Can contest the finish when in the right mood

14. KINGSLEY - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Does well going left-handed and is not out of it

Summary: KOUGAR DE SIMM (10) is not reliable but he did win a good race in his penultimate start and is capable of bouncing back with another victory. KINGSLEY (14) has a string of recent faults but could be a threat when staying in stride. KUNG FU FAMILY (13) does not always show his best side but is capable of winning when smart. KONOR HIGHLAND (12) hinted that he could get involved with the finish with a fair run at Saint-Galmier.

C3 - PRIX PLUTO DU VIVIER - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **MINDFREAK** - Has done little wrong so far and was successful in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Big chance in this line-up
2. **MERLIN FAMILY** - Has shown improvement of late and finished third in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Clearly not out of it
3. **MONTENEGRO** - Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Should be a threat of staying in stride
4. **MYSTIC BOND** - Has yet to win a race and does have disqualification issues but was a good runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Can go one place better
5. **MISTER MAGIC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this course over 2150m on 21 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
6. **MAJOR JENILOU** - Not easy to trust and faulted last time out over this course and distance on 10 February. Has ability and can be a real threat when smart
7. **MICHIGAN HAWK** - Very unreliable but did not run badly when 5th in Class D at this track over 2150m on 21 January. Others do make more appeal though
8. **MUCHO CASH** - Only modest of late and was 6th at Modene over 2080m on 3 February. Others are preferred in this line-up
9. **MAD DREAM** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Might play a minor role
10. **MOONLIGHT DJOC** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 10 February. Should be right there at the finish once again
11. **MIMOSA DE LARRE** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E at at this track over 2150m on 20 February. Has a place chance
12. **MANITOBA** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Cagnes over 2150m on 20 February. Can earn some minor money

Summary: MINDFREAK (1) has impressed with two wins in just three starts. His latest victory was at this course, so it is only really the drop in distance that may be of some concern. MAJOR JENILOU (6) has disqualification issues but is a threat when staying in stride. MOONLIGHT DJOC (10) is in good shape and can get into the mix of things once again. MYSTIC BOND (4) is also not easy to trust but does look likely to win a first race soon.

C4 - PRIX DE DRAGUIGNAN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **MALAGA D'ATOUT** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class E at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Keeps that shoeing and is not out of it
2. **MADE IN ATALANTE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Very unreliable but might play a minor role at very best
3. **MANZANA ERA** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this course over 2925m on 5 January. Can do even better this time around and is one to consider
4. **MANOLITA** - Holding form and finished third in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Can be competitive once again
5. **MELODIE D'HOULBEC** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February. Clearly capable of better and has won at this track. Not out of it
6. **MOUSTACHE** - Broke through with a Class E victory over this course and distance on 17 February when barefoot. Remains without shoes and could double up
7. **MAMBA DES DURIEZ** - In good shape and finished third in Class D over this course and distance on 23 January. Can earn some more money
8. **MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF** - Improving and was victorious in Class E at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Remains barefoot and could follow up
9. **MALICE D'OCCAGNES** - Not reliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Could play a minor role
10. **MAJORELLE** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in Class E at this course over 2925m on 31 January. Has disqualification issues but can win again over this shorter distance
11. **MOON IN THE SKY** - Bounced back to form when barefoot and third in Class E at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Can be a threat once again
12. **MY LADY DARLING** - Has lost her way of late with some disqualifications, the latest over this course and distance on 17 February. Capable of earning some money when staying on the trot

Summary: A very open-looking race and only a few of them can safely be ruled out. MAJORELLE (10) showed her best side when racing without shoes and scoring at this track last month. This is a tougher ask of her but she may well double up. MARIE BASHKIRTSEFF (8) has shown improvement and picked up a confidence-boosting win, so will be a threat. MALAGA D'ATOUT (1) is not reliable but is also not out of it. MANZANA ERA (3) is also capable of making the frame.

C5 - PRIX FAN IDOLE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **JERRY QUICK** - Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class F at this course over 2700m on 17 February. Can be competitive once again
2. **JALNY DE CASTELLE** - Successful on his last two starts, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 23 January. Can complete the hat-trick
3. **JOE TEJY** - Faulted last time out over this track and trip on 10 February. Not reliable but does have a place chance in this line-up
4. **INTREPIDE TURGOT** - Clearly likes the track and was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 12 February. Should be right there at the finish
5. **JALAPENO** - Not reliable but was victorious in Class E over this course and distance on 12 February. Can double up
6. **JUNON DE LOU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest being at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
7. **HUNIQUE** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Could be a threat if staying in stride
8. **HAPPY LYL** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at this course over 2700m on 31 January. More is needed to score
9. **JANDICE STAR** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Could earn some more money
10. **JASPE DU DOLLAR** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class F at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Clearly not out of it
11. **HARFAN DES GRANGES** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2700m on 31 January. Needs to a lot more to beat these rivals

Summary: JALNY DE CASTELLE (2) is in very good form. He was a solid winner of his last two starts and is a confident pick to complete his treble. JALAPENO (5) is not as reliable as that fellow but was a good winner of his latest course and distance start and is a threat once again. INTREPIDE TURGOT (4) is in very good form and likely to be right there at the finish once again. HUNIQUE (7) is not reliable but can earn some money when smart.

C6 - PRIX DES MARGUERITES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **MAHALIA D'IRAI** - Faulted last time out at Graignes over 2700m on 9 February. Very hard to trust but is barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
2. **MARBELLA DREAM** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Can go one place better
3. **MAEVA DE COQUERIE** - Only moderate form of late and was 6th in Class E over this course and distance on 31 January. Has a place chance on best form
4. **MAYBE UP STAR** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Yet to win a race but can earn some money
5. **MELODIE FAVORITE** - Disqualified in her last 5 starts, the latest over this course and distance on 7 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
6. **MADISON DE NIMES** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Quite capable of contesting the finish
7. **MEA MARIS** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when fourth in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Can get involved with the finish if smart
8. **MYSTESS DE CANI** - Showed what she is capable of with a Class F victory over 2925m on 25 January. Can follow up if in the same mood
9. **MA BICHE NOA** - Disqualified three times in her last four starts, including last time out at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February. Is capable of scoring when smart
10. **MESANGE DU PLESSIS** - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. A winner of her penultimate start and must be respected for that
11. **MY LADY PRINCESS** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Langon over 2800m on 15 July. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough
12. **MOLLY FLIGNY** - A four-year-old filly by Fairplay d'Urzy out of Bright Star who is making her debut. Her mother won once in 16 starts. Can contest the finish

Summary: A very open race. MA BICHE NOA (9) has disqualification issues but it is worth noting that she was unlucky at Vincennes at the beginning of the month, so must be respected for that. A narrow vote to score. MOLLY FLIGNY (12) makes her debut but is well bred and could be a threat. MY LADY PRINCESS (11) returns from a break but has enough form to suggest a win is possible if fit enough. MEA MARIS (7) is not easy to trust but can get involved with the finish if smart.

C7 - PRIX IVOIRE DU MOULIN - 2925m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 16,000

1. NAVIDA PURA VIDA - A three-year-old filly by Clif du Pommereux out of Star des Jacquets who is making her debut. Her mother did not win a race after 15 starts. Can be competitive

2. NEIGE TURGOT - A three-year-old filly by Sancho Turgot out of Royal Island who is making her debut. Her dam won 10 of her 59 starts. Can be a threat on debut

3. NINETEEN SIXTY ONE - A three-year-old filly by Face Time Bourbon out of Anantara Jet who is making her debut. Her mother won 5 of her 24 starts. Can be a threat

4. NODESSA JOSSELYN - A three-year-old filly by Ready Cash out of Bélina Josselyn who is making her debut. Her dam won 23 of her 74 starts. Can be succesfull

5. NATIVEDARCHE - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2125m on 23 December. Can make the frame if smart this time

6. NANCY ANGANO - Finished 7th in her second start, in Class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Did better on debut and has a place chance

7. NIGHT OF CARLESS - Only modest so far and finished 6th in Class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

8. N'ATTENDS PERSONNE - Not reliable and was 5th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Might play a minor role at very best

9. NESMILLE ELEVEN - Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Returns from a break and has a place chance

Summary: A very tricky race and it looks like the newcomers could be the ones to side with. NODESSA JOSSELYN (4) catches the eye being by Ready Cash and out of a mare who won 23 races. NINETEEN SIXTY ONE (3) is well bred and her mother did win five times. NAVIDA PURA VIDA (1) will be driven by David Békaert, so should be a threat on her debut. NEIGE TURGOT (2) is another debutant whose mother won 10 races and must be considered a possible winner.

C8 - PRIX DES ORANGERS - 2925m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

1. **ICK DU VIVIER** - At the top of his game and was successful in Class G at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Quite capable of following up
2. **ILTON BEAUREGARD** - Returned to his best with a barefoot win in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Not barefoot this time but might play a minor role
3. **JET SET CODIE** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class G at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
4. **JIVAGO DE BEYLEV** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Battling to find his best form and others make more appeal
5. **JARNAC DE L'ITON** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 12 February. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
6. **JEFFREY** - Faulted last time out over this course and distance on 16 February. Very consistent before that and will be a threat if smart this time
7. **ILLUSTRE BLUE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 12 February. Capable of earning some money
8. **JAZZ LINOIS** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 28 July. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
9. **HACKER MESLOIS** - Battling to find his best form and finished tenth in Class F at Cagnes over 2700m on 17 February. Needs major improvement to score
10. **JOY FOR EVER** - Clearly likes this track and was victorious in Class E over 2150m on 7 February. Can double up over this longer distance
11. **IWAN D'AVEL** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class G over this track and trip on 17 February. Should be right there at the finish once again
12. **FIFTY WINNER** - Disqualified in four of his last five starts, including last time out over this course and distance on 20 February. Can earn some money when staying on the trot
13. **GENIALISSIME** - Off form and finished 8th in Class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
14. **IRON D'ERONVILLE** - Not reliable but was victorious last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Can score again

Summary: JOY FOR EVER (10) is in very good form and clearly sets the standard for this lucky last race. She will need to fight off many challengers, though. ICK DU VIVIER (1) has shone brightly of late and will not go down without a fight. IRON D'ERONVILLE (14) was a solid winner over this course and distance a few weeks ago but is not reliable. IWAN D'AVEL (11) is knocking at the door and could be a threat once again.
