## Race 1 - PRIX DU PONT ALEXANDRE III - 2150m MOBILE E50 Harness. Purse EUR €41,000.

- 1. **ILLUSION DU RUEL** Last raced at Laval on March 14 when she was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 2. **IBIZA DU CHERISAY** Reasonable effort when fourth at her first run back from a layoff at Laval last start. Watch for a spike in form.
- 3. **IRENE FLASH** Is closing in on a win after placing at two of the last three runs, the latest effort a third at Caen, beaten 1.7L. Likely to play a major role.
- 4. **IVORY PERRINE** Didn't measure up two runs ago at Vincennes but bounced back last time when a winner by 0.4L at Laval. Heading the right way now.
- 5. **IPANEMA DE LOU** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 5.5L from the winner in eighth at Nantes. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 6. **INASTIE DANICA** Was disqualified last start at Les Sables on October 24. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 7. **INNEE DU RIL** Last raced at Mauquenchy on March 13 when she was disqualified. Put a line through that latest run. Top pick if at her best.
- 8. **ILOUANE DU VIVIER** Is in sparkling form with five wins on end, the latest by 4L at Le Croise-Laroche. Top chance.
- 9. **IPSIE DE LA LUNE** Recorded a comfortable 2.1L win last start at Caen. Finds a suitable contest. Expected to measure up again.

**Summary**: ILOUANE DU VIVIER (8) recorded a fifth-straight success when landing a Class E mobile race by 4L at Le Croise-Laroche twenty-two days ago. Top hope with a progressive profile. IPSIE DE LA LUNE (9) can go well up in grade following Class F autostart success at Caen. Player in first-time pads. INNEE DU RIL (7) won a Class E at Laval two starts ago. Key claims on that form. Recent Caen third IRENE FLASH (3) remains unexposed without rear shoes and cannot be ignored.

ILOUANE DU VIVIER (8) - IPSIE DE LA LUNE (9) - INNEE DU RIL (7) - IRENE FLASH (3)

- 1. **BODY N SOUL** Was disqualified last start at Vincennes on February 28. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 2. **INVADER AM** Was a winner two back when resuming at Vincennes then could only manage a midfield finish last time at Vincennes. Hard to beat.
- 3. **HADRIEN MERITE** Easily accounted for last time at the first run of the campaign when 9.9L from the winner in fourth at Mauquenchy. This looks a far sterner task.
- 4. **HERMES PAN** Is in sparkling form, winning two of his past five, the latest victory coming at Caen. Leading contender again.
- 5. **CABASSE** Has not been in the money in two runs this campaign, the latest when 5.6L away in seventh at this track. Hard to have.
- 6. **MISTER INVICTUS** Missed the placings again last start, beaten 5.2L when sixth at this track. Big chance in this line-up.
- 7. **IMPERIAL COGLAIS** Won two back at Vincennes but followed that with a sixth at Vincennes last time. Among the leading players.
- 8. **IT'S EAGLE COGLAIS** Bounced back last start when second at Cordemais, beaten 3.1L. With even luck is a winning chance.
- 9. **NEVELE HALL GRAUX** Missed the placings again last start, beaten 3.9L when fourth at this track. Expecting a better run this time.
- 10. **HIC DU MOUCHEL** Ran an improved race second-up to finish second at Mauquenchy. Rates well on last run but needs to improve further.
- 11. **COMPANY SM** Last raced at Vincennes on February 23 when he was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 12. **HOUKO SPORT** Was a most impressive winner last time out, scoring by 3.4L at this track. Strips fitter fourth-up from a spell and is going to be hard to beat.
- 13. **HOTEBO DE BREMONT** Comes here off a last-start fourth at Bihorel Les Rouen, beaten 10L. Facing a tough assignment this time around.

**Summary**: INVADER AM (2) finished sixth in a driven event last outing but is better judged on his all-the-way 0.75L Class E mounted win at Vincennes in January. Top chance. HERMES PAN (4) arrives in excellent heart and commands respect following a Class E mounted success at Caen earlier in the month. Notable claims. MISTER INVICTUS (6) showed promise on his French mounted debut when fourth at Vincennes two starts ago. Interesting for a top yard. HOUKO SPORT (12) made all to win a Class D in the saddle here thirteen days back and cannot be ignored.

- 1. **INSTALL D'ALOUETTE** Registered a minor placing two starts back then a win five-and-a-half weeks ago by 0.8L at Laval. In fine form and looks a serious player again.
- 2. **IN LOVE D'ECAJEUL** Last raced at Caen on March 6 when he was disqualified. Prefer to see him perform well before recommending.
- 3. **IRUN DU BOCAGE** Comes here off a last-start sixth first-up at Laval, beaten 8.9L. Won't find this easy. Not keen.
- 4. **INSTANT KARMA** Improved sharply last start to return to winning form by 0.4L at Le Croise-Laroche. Can measure up again.
- 5. **INSTINCT DE CLERCE** Didn't do a lot when resuming last start, finishing fourth at Laval and beaten 7.7L. Capable of testing this line up.
- 6. **INSERT DU BAS BOSQ** Finished third at Vincennes two starts back then missed the frame but wasn't beaten all that far last time out at Vincennes. Sure to be there at the business end.
- 7. **IVALO DU BOCAGE** Scored at Vincennes two starts back then finished third at Meslay-du-Maine more recently, finishing 2.9L from the winner. Winning prospects.
- 8. **IRON CASH** Gave nothing else a chance and scored by 3.3L last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer. Finds a suitable contest. Among the leading chances.
- 9. **ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS** Was a much better run last time finishing second at Le Croise-Laroche, beaten 0.4L. Leading player.
- 10. INCREDIBLE GO Was a much better run last time finishing third at Caen, beaten 2.9L. Leading player.
- 11. **IALKO JENILAT** Turned in a solid run when resuming at Meslay-du-Maine last start, finishing 1.7L back in second. Plenty of improvement to come. Sure to run well.
- 12. **IRON MAN DE HOERDT** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Finished 12th last start at Vincennes, 30L from the winner. Cannot enthuse.
- 13. **IN PETTO** Turned in a solid run when resuming last start at Mauquenchy, finishing fourth but beaten only 2.5L. Generally runs well second-up. In the mix if on-song.
- 14. **ILFUEGO** Last raced at Saint Brieuc on March 21 when he was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.

**Summary**: Dual autostart winner IRON CASH (8) impressed when a 3.25L Class E walk-up winner at Cagnessur-Mer eighteen days ago. Leading chance for a top stable. INSTANT KARMA (4) makes plenty of appeal on the back of a 0.25L Class E mobile success at Le Croise-Laroche. Notable contender. Class E Laval winner INSTALL D'ALOUETTE (1) should have more to offer without rear shoes and must be respected alongside IVALO DU BOCAGE (7).

IRON CASH (8) - INSTANT KARMA (4) - INSTALL D'ALOUETTE (1) - IVALO DU BOCAGE (7)

- 1. **FINGER DE RODREY** Continued a long run without winning when fifth at Laval last time out. Must do a lot more.
- 2. **GAVROCHE BEST** Back in winning form last time at this track, scoring by 0.8L. Great chance to make it two in a row.
- 3. **GAI PRINTEMPS** Has not done much in two runs this season, the latest a 15L seventh at Laval. Prefer others.
- 4. **GRETA** Is racing well with a sequence of three minor placings, the latest a third at Laval, beaten 0.8L. Racing well and should be in the finish again.
- 5. **FLEUR DU POLEA** Was expected to do more last time out, finishing fifth and beaten 8.3L at Vincennes. A return to form is on the cards.
- 6. **FALCAO DE CHENU** Disqualified last start at this track. Overlook the recent mishap. Well placed to make amends.
- 7. **GALAXIE D'HAVANE** Unplaced two runs back then again missed the frame last start but was only beaten 1.7L when fourth at Laval. Can make amends.
- 8. FLORA VENESI Won by 1.3L at this track. In form and should feature in the finish again.
- 9. DE LA CHENEVIERE Was safely held last time out in 14th at this track. This looks a far sterner task.
- 10. **FRENCH WAY OF LIFE** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 12L from the winner in 11th at Le Croise-Laroche. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 11. **FIGOLU FRAZEEN** Continued a long run without winning when fourth at Caen last time out. Watch for a spike in form.
- 12. GAIA D'OCCAGNES Looked good in winning last start by 0.4L at Caen. In form and holds claims.
- 13. DI MAGGIO Safely held last time when 30L from the winner in 11th at this track. Unlikely to threaten.

- 15. **EMERAUDE DEL PHEDO** Missed the placings again last start, beaten 13L when fourth at Cordemais. Capable of a better showing.
- 16. **FLUO MESLOIS** Finished sixth at this track last start but his form prior to that run was sound. Expected to do much better this time.

**Summary**: GRETA (4) has been in good form of late and produced a solid effort when third in a Class E European mounted race at Laval last outing. Hard to ignore as an eight-time mounted scorer. GAVROCHE BEST (2) has won seventimes in the saddle and needs the utmost respect following a 0.75L Class D mounted win here. FLORA VENESI (8) took out a Class C mounted event at this venue a week ago and looks like a key contender once more. FLUO MESLOIS (16) should find this easier than the Class C European-mounted race he finished sixth in at this track last start. Holds claims. GAIA D'OCCAGNES (12) is worth a second look.

- 1. **JOLLY LADY** Won two runs ago at Mauquenchy then didn't back it up last time when beaten 5.4L at this track. A big run would not surprise.
- 2. **JAGGERA BOMB** Was disqualified last start at Vincennes on November 29. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 3. **JALISCA DE CHENU** Last raced at Lisieux on March 22 when she was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 4. **JANE AIMEE** Last raced at Lisieux on March 22 when she was disqualified. Prefer to see her perform well before recommending.
- 5. **JULY DE BREMONT** Was last produced when 12th at Vincennes ten weeks ago. Wait and see how she returns.
- 6. **JANE'S FELLA** Found one better last start at Vincennes off the back of a win at Laval two runs ago. Hard to beat.
- 7. **JADE DE TOUCHYVON** Is yet to taste defeat in two runs this season, the latest at Caen by 1.3L. Fitter and still lightly raced so expect she has more to offer. Leading contender.
- 8. **JAGABABA** Last raced at Caen on March 16 when she was disqualified. Forgive the recent mishap. Looks ideally placed.
- 9. **JOYCE DES GRANGES** Didn't do a lot when resuming last start, finishing ninth at this track and beaten 5.8L. Solid prospect with that run under the belt.
- 10. **JOYCE CAUVELLIERE** Was not a factor when resuming last start, finishing fifth at Caen and beaten 5L. Expect a better performance this time.
- 11. **JAPONICA** Form only moderate and has been without a win now for 10 runs. Last start finished ninth at Caen. One of the contenders if at her best.
- 12. **JASMINE DE VAU** Was disqualified last start at Meslay-du-Maine on March 17. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 13. **JIRELLITA** Was plain when 34L away in 11th most recently at her first run back from a break at Vincennes. Will take a lot from that run. Major player.
- 14. **JAVA DU BOUFFEY** Finished third at this track last start after she was out of the money two back at Vincennes. Forward performance expected.
- 15. JAZZY DU LIAMONE Disqualified last start at Lisieux. Overlook the last run. Looks ideally placed.

**Summary**: The hat-trick seeking JADE DE TOUCHYVON (7) looks progressive and can follow up back-to-back Class F wins at Mauquenchy and Caen. Expected to take this rise in class in her stride. Narrow Class E Vincennes second JANE'S FELLA (6) cannot be discounted racing in pads while JIRELLITA (13) would be interesting on the form she showed when second in a Vincennes Class D last August. JAZZY DU LIAMONE (15) makes each-way appeal.

- 1. JALNA ROBSONS Won by 0.4L at Cagnes-sur-Mer. In fine form and looks a serious player again.
- 2. **JOAQUIM DIESCHOOT** Failed to measure up two runs back then last start was a well-beaten sixth at Vincennes, 39L from the winner. Must do a lot more.
- 3. **JAG MAHCATH** Failed to threaten two runs back then last start was a well-beaten fifth at this track, 5.8L from the winner. Not going well enough.
- 4. **JUS DE FRUIT** Was disqualified last start at Vincennes on February 28. Overlook the most recent outing. Can turn things around.
- 5. **JACKPOT DE CHENU** Disqualified last start at Vincennes. Overlook the recent mishap. Well placed to make amends.
- 6. **JUST TO BE STRYCK** Bounced back last start when second at Vincennes, beaten 11L. One of the key runners.
- 7. **JAZZ IN JEEP** Has been about the mark lately, the latest effort a third, beaten 13L at Vincennes. Contender.
- 8. **JACK DRY** Was plain when 57L away in sixth most recently at his first run back from a spell at this track. Hard to have in this line-up.
- 9. **JOLLITY GABY** Last raced at Vincennes nine weeks ago when she finished second, beaten 2.9L. Winning prospects.
- 10. **JIRI PACHA** Finished off last campaign with a win at Vincennes three-and-a-half months ago. Finds a nice race to launch the campaign.
- 11. **JAMAIQUE PAJELO** Placed at the final run of her last campaign, finishing third at Vincennes five months ago. Solid claims.

**Summary**: JIRI PACHA (10) returns to action in the same shoeing combination that saw him win a Class D mounted event at Vincennes in December. Obvious appeal on reappearance. JUST TO BE STRYCK (6) has found the frame on four of his five mounted outings and looks like a key threat following a sound Class D second at Vincennes last start. Class D Vincennes runner-up JOLLITY GABY (9) is respected racing without rear shoes for the first time and JUS DE FRUIT (4) would hold claims on his two close second-place finishes at the same venue prior to a recent DQ.

JIRI PACHA (10) - JUST TO BE STRYCK (6) - JOLLITY GABY (9) - JUS DE FRUIT (4)

- 1. **DEGANAWIDAH** Continued a long run without winning when 12th at Le Croise-Laroche last time out. Can do a lot better in this suitable contest.
- 2. **EMENCOURT BLEQUIN** Continued a long run without winning when tenth at Amiens last time out. Certainly worth another chance.
- 3. DROP DE COLLEVILLE Disqualified last start at this track. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.
- 4. **DOW JONES EMGE** Continued some plain form when a poor eighth at this track two-and-a-half weeks ago. Not on current form.
- 5. **FRANKLIN PARK** Continued a long run of outs when 11th, 11L from the winner at Machecoul nine days ago. This looks a suitable assignment.
- 6. **DISCO D'OCCAGNES** Last raced at Vincennes three-and-a-half months ago when he finished sixth, beaten 4.8L. Sure to be primed for a big run.
- 7. DIVALLO Finished third two starts back at Laval then missed the top-three last time out at Laval. Consider.
- 8. DERBY DU DOLLAR Struggled last time in G3 company at Amiens three weeks ago. Needs more.

- 13. **EMBLEME CASTELETS** Was disqualified last start at this track on March 21. Overlook the most recent outing. Can turn things around.

**Summary**: A tricky event where a market check is advised. EMBLEME CASTELETS (13) arrives following back-to-back DQ but was in the process of running fairly well in a Class C mounted event latest. Interesting contender back behind the mobile (five-time winner). ENERISE FLASH (11) finished sixth in a Class E European mobile race at Vincennes last month. One to note at this level. Four-time mobile scorer DISCO D'OCCAGNES (6) should feature following a decent 5L sixth in a Class D European autostart at Vincennes in December and DIVALLO (7) is considered eased significantly in standard.

- 1. **FALCO DE BELLANDE** Struggling to find form and has been out of the winners' list at his last six runs. Last start finished fourth at this track. Can be competitive if at his best.
- 2. **FIER D'ARS** Was disqualified last start at Reims on March 19. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 3. **FOSTINE DE CRENNES** Was a gutsy winner last time out at Graignes, the second success from her past four runs. Winning chance on recent efforts.
- 4. **HURRICANE DREAM** Second-up after finishing runner-up at his first run of the campaign, beaten 1.2L at this track. Sure to play a major role with added fitness.
- 5. **FAVELA SOMOLLI** Was last produced when tenth at Mauquenchy four months ago. Will be better for the run.
- 6. **FLICFLAC DU LOGIS** Will be better for this run following a spell of four months. Last raced when third at Vincennes.
- 7. **HABIBI** Scored a fine win at Amiens two starts ago then couldn't follow it up at this track last time, finishing 5.9L away from the winner. Forward performance expected.
- 8. **GAME UP** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 16L from the winner in ninth at Laval. This looks a far sterner task.
- 9. **FILOU RIEZAIS** Was a strong winner last time out by 0.5L at Fougeres to continue the great form this campaign. Among the chances again.
- 10. **FIDJI SMILING** Was disqualified last start at Mauquenchy on March 13. Prefer to see her perform well before recommending.
- 11. **GO TO AMERICA** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 6.5L from the winner in eighth at this track. Unlikely to threaten.
- 12. **HIPPOCRATE DU TRIO** Has raced twice this prep and failed to fill a top-three spot on either occasion, the latest when sixth at this track, beaten 2.6L. Capable of a better showing.
- 13. ECLAT DE SUN Looked good in winning last start by 1.3L at this track. Looks hard to beat again.
- 14. **GUERRIER CASTELETS** Returned from a spell in top order last start with a win at this track by 2.1L. Big chance of back-to-back wins.
- 15. **FOR LOVING YOU** Made an encouraging return when she was third at La Capelle last start, beaten 4.6L. Bold showing expected again.
- 16. **FAUBOURG DU PERCHE** Improved to finish second at this track most recently on the back of a mediocre fourth at Strasbourg prior. Will be right in the thick of things.

**Summary**: GUERRIER CASTELETS (14) made it three from six over this trip when scoring by 2L in a course and distance claimer last outing. Selected to go in again with a good amateur booked. HIPPOCRATE DU TRIO (12) is seven from twenty without shoes and will certainly find this easier than the Class C course mobile he finished a close sixth in latest. Notable chance. ECLAT DE SUN (13) looks to hold solid claims following a 1.25L Class G amateurs track and trip win last start. Four-time barefoot scorer HURRICANE DREAM (4) is also noted on the back of a good second in a Class F here recently.
