**C1 - PRIX TITLIS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR €  
22,000**

**1. JOLIE BOES** - Only modest form of late and finished 7th last time out in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**2. JUSTINE DU MESNIL** - Unreliable and finished 6th last time out in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**3. ILE DU SABLIER** - Victorious in the 66th start, in Class G at Feurs over 2850m 23 March. Tougher task this time and others are preferred

**4. JALAPA** - Disqualified last time out at Hyeres on 9 February. On a long losing run but is capable of playing a minor role when in the right mood

**5. IVANKA** - Unreliable but was a winner last time out in Class G at Feurs over 2850m on 23 March. Hard to trust but is capable of an upset

**6. INDESKAYA BIRD** - On a long losing run and finished 9th last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**7. JOYEUSE MAB** - Holding form and finished fourth last time out in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 2 March. Can be competitive once again

**8. JUST FOR YOU** - Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 2 March. Finished runner-up in her penultimate start over this track and trip and has a winning chance

**9. JEWELLE OF JANE** - Disappointing of late and finished 8th in Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Loves this track and can bounce back to score

**10. JEEP DES CHARRONS** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Needs major improvement to win

**11. JET SET DU BELLAY** - Unreliable but was runner-up last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Not easy to trust but can fight out the finish

**12. JOIE DE BERTRANGE** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 21 March. Capable of making the frame

**Summary:** JEWELLE OF JANE (9) clearly loves this course and is unbeaten here. She can bounce back to beat these rivals. JUST FOR YOU (8) is unreliable but did run well at this track and could be a threat. JET SET DU BELLAY (11) is hard to trust but could go one better than a very good last performance if in the right mood. JOIE DE BERTRANGE (12) was not disgraced at Toulouse but is struggling to end a long losing run.

## C2 - PRIX DES ACCATES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **JUST BENOIT** - Fair recent form and finished 5th in Class E over this track and trip on 10 February. Could play a minor role.
2. **JERICO BADREC** - Below best when 6th in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 4 October. Capable of better but returns from a break.
3. **JO THUNDER** - Has struggled and finished 10th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 January. Needs to find a few lengths.
4. **JIMMYZ** - In good form, finishing 3rd in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 March. Can be a strong contender.
5. **JAG D'URZY** - Unreliable but finished as runner-up in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 March. Can be competitive again.
6. **JOKER DU DOLLAR** - Holding decent form this year, finishing 4th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 March. Not out of contention.
7. **JERRY LOVES GINGER** - Disqualified in his last three starts, most recently at this track on 10 February. Capable of earning prize money if staying on track
8. **JOLI CHARMEUR** - In good form and was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 10 February. Strong chance to go one better.
9. **JAIME DE DOMPIERRE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 15 March. Capable of making the frame
10. **JULES ET JIM** - Unreliable this year and finished 7th at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Capable of an upset on best form.
11. **JOE TEJY** - Disqualified last time at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. In good form before that and has a winning chance if keeping his stride.
12. **JOCKSTRAP** - Disqualified last time at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Won over this track and trip in his penultimate start and can score again

**Summary:** JOCKSTRAP (12) clearly has his issues but was a good winner over this track and trip in his penultimate start. He can bounce back and win again if in the same mood. JOE TEJY (11) was victorious when last seen at this course and should be a lively danger. JAIME DE DOMPIERRE (9) is unreliable but will be fully unshod this time, and improvement can be expected. JOLI CHARMEUR (8) is in good form and has an obvious winning chance.

## C3 - PRIX D'ENDOUME - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **KOMEET D'AZUR** - Disappointed when 8th at Gelsenkirchen over 2000m on 8 December while barefoot. Capable of better and could play a minor role.
2. **KERMARIA DE VAL** - Struggling for form and finished 9th in a claimer at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 17 March. Needs to improve significantly.
3. **KUEEN MARGOT** - Still searching for a first win and finished 6th last time in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 February. Might play a minor role
4. **KOURANE LA CHENAIE** - Major disqualification issues and faulted last time at Marseille-Borely on 21 March. Probably best watched for now.
5. **KOMANIA D'ABY** - Yet to win a race but in good form, finishing 3rd last time in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 15 March. Has a winning chance.
6. **KOTKITA** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time at Marseille-Borely on 21 March. However, she was in good form before that and is a serious threat if she stays faultless.
7. **KATCHINA** - Below her best when 8th in Class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 14 March. Loves this course and is barefoot, so could be ready to strike.
8. **KEONA DELALANDE** - Unreliable but finished 6th in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 March. Runs barefoot and is capable of an upset.
9. **KANTARELLINA CHIC** - Winless in 38 attempts, finishing 6th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 February. Can make the frame on best form
10. **KOKINE JABA** - Out of form and finished 10th last time in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 4 March. Others appeal more.
11. **KALINE DES RIOULTS** - Very unreliable, finishing 6th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 February. Others preferred.

**Summary:** A tough race with a number of them holding a winning chance. KOTKITA (6) is not easy to trust but can bounce back with a win if wise. KATCHINA (7) loves this track and is barefoot and ready to score. KEONA DELALANDE (8) is unshod this time and could show improvement. KANTARALLENA CHIC (10) has yet to win a race after numerous attempts and is not likely to win this either but can make the frame.

## C4 - PRIX DE BELCODENE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **IRMOSA BELLA** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 1 March. Unreliable but could make the frame
2. **HAMLET DE L'ITON** - Disqualified in class H at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
3. **HOPE COGLAIS** - Disqualified in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 February. Returns barefoot but probably needs to find a few lengths to win
4. **IDEE D'AMOUR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 14 March. Remains barefoot and can go one better
5. **IDA DES MONTS** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th at Hyeres over 2850m on 1 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
6. **HELIOT DES LANDES** - In good shape and was thrd in class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 15 March. Capable of being competitive once again
7. **HAVATAR** - Only modest of late and was 7th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 14 March. Might play a minor role
8. **GALAXY VAUCEENNE** - Has struggled this year and was 7th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. Others make more appeal in this line-up
9. **GENESALIA** - Disqualified in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. On a very long losing run but could pop up in a place
10. **HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Needed the last run when 6th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 9 March. Victorious back in August but others are preferred this time
11. **HIDALGO BOY** - Finished 15th in class G at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Has struggled of late and others are much preferred
12. **GRAINE D'URZY** - Finished 6th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
13. **GIRLY VICTORY** - Holding from and finished third in class G at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
14. **ILLICO DE CASTELLE** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. Has a place chance on best form
15. **HOLY ROMAN EMPEROR** - Disqualified in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 26 February. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

**Summary:** IDEE D'AMOUR (4) seems to have shown genuine improvement of late and can go one better after a very good last performance at Marseille-Borely. GIRLY VICTORY (13) has not won for some time now but is in good form and can fight out the finish again. HELIOT DES LANDES (6) has been good of late and can be a threat once again. IRMOSA BELLA (1) has only been modest of late but could sneak into the frame.

## C5 - PRIX DE JOINVILLE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **KEDERMANN** - In good shape and was runner-up at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March when barefoot. Has shown improvement and can earn some more money
2. **KENZO DE KERUZOC** - Yet to win a race but was 4th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 2 March. Probably needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
3. **KALL ME SIXTY ONE** - Yet to win a race but was third in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 2 March. Capable of earning some minor money
4. **KING GIORGIO** - Has major disqualifications and was runner-up in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 18 December. Won well in November and can contest the finish
5. **KABARDINO** - Victorious in Class F at Oraison over 2650m on 15 September when barefoot. Not unshod this time and could need this run returning from a break
6. **KHERMES D'URZY** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race
7. **KIKIO DU CHATEAU** - Not disgraced when 5th in class D at Fleurance over 2600m on 11 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
8. **KLASSIC BEAUJOLAIS** - Finished 9th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 25 January. Unreliable and others are preferred this time
9. **KRISTOF D'OURVILLE** - Finished 8th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
10. **KOREDE** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. Fitter this time but others are much preferred
11. **KILL THE BLUES** - Finished 10th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 21 March. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role
12. **KHEOPS TURGOT** - In very good form and was victorious in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 2 March. Can follow up in this line-up
13. **KONOR HIGHLAND** - Disappointing of late and was 8th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 March. Won well in November and is capable of getting involved with the finish
14. **KRUNCH BOCNEUF** - Unreliable and was runner-up in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. Did better last year and is capable of winning again
15. **KABRIEL** - Disappointing last run when 7th in class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 March. Victorious back in February and is not out of it
16. **KANTISSIME WINNER** - Victorious in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 13 July when barefoot. Returns from a break but is capable of earning some money

**Summary:** KHEOPS TURGOT (12) is not easy to trust but ended 2024 barefoot and in good form. He returns from a break unshod and is capable of following up. KING GIORGIO (4) has major disqualification issues but is capable of winning a race like this when smart. KABRIEL (15) drops in class and has a winning chance. KONOR HIGHLAND (13) did better last year and deserves respect in this line-up.

## C6 - PRIX DE L'EURE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,000

1. **LAGOMYS** - Has disqualification issues and finished 7th last time in Class F at Cavaillon over 2600m on 23 March. Needs to find a few lengths to challenge.
2. **LE BON MAYENNAIS** - Unreliable, finishing 8th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2600m on 17 March. Ran better in his penultimate start but others are preferred.
3. **LOTOIS JEC** - Disqualified in his last three starts, most recently at Lannemezan on 21 August. Returns from a break and is best watched for now.
4. **LATIUM** - Disqualified in his last two starts, latest at Hyères on 1 March. Clearly unreliable but capable of featuring when keeping stride.
5. **LOOK DES VALLEES** - Disqualified last time at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 16 March. Needed that run and can be competitive if wise this time.
6. **LEWIS KING** - Has some form of late, finishing 5th at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Needs more to win but could play a minor role.
7. **LIVE UP STAR** - Has been inconsistent, finishing 8th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 March. Capable of earning a cheque if in the right mood.
8. **LORENZO PAULOIS** - Very hard to trust but finished 5th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 September. Returns from a break and could surprise if on form.
9. **LUCKY MAN** - Disqualified last time at Marseille-Borely on 21 March. Yet to win but can contest the finish if faultless
10. **LITTLE KING ELEVEN** - Has disqualification issues but won last time out in Class F at Nîmes over 2750m on 15 February. Not out of it in this line-up.
11. **LE MARGINAL** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 18 September. Returns from a break and could be a factor if fit.
12. **LAMIRAL D'ERABLE** - Needed his only run this year when 7th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 4 March. Capable of an upset on best form.
13. **LUCKY D'AVAIL** - Disqualified in his last three starts, most recently at Marseille-Borely on 21 March. Hard to trust but can earn if staying error-free.
14. **L'OR DU MELEUC** - Disqualified in his only start this year at Lyon-La Soie on 10 March. Had good form last year and can bounce back now fitter.
15. **LOOSER ROMO** - Unreliable but finished third last time out in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 5 March. Has a winning chance

**Summary:** L'OR DU MELEUC (14) fluffed his lines in his only run this year. He had very good form last year and does set the standard if showing his best form. LORENZO PAULOIS (8) has major disqualification issues and is returning from a break but will be a danger if at his best. LUCKY MAN (9) has yet to win but does have a winning chance in this line-up. LOOSER ROMO (15) could be improving and is not out of it.

## C7 - PRIX DU REALTOR - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,000

- 1. LA PRESIDENTE** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3025m on 2 December. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 2. LOULIE DE GUEZ** - Finished 9th in class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 16 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. LANCE DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 4 March. Has major disqualification issues and is bets watched for now
- 4. LADY DE DOMPIERRE** - Disqualified in class F at Châtelailon over 2600m on 17 March. Unreliable but should be very competitive in this line-up
- 5. LEGENDE D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 January. Capable of better but may be best watched for now
- 6. LADY ORANGE** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Very hard to trust but is capable of scoring in a race like this
- 7. LYNETTE CAT** - Much improved and was a good third in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 4 March. Has shown improvement and is not out of it
- 8. LILIBETH TURGOT** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 9. LESLEY ARCTIC** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Has struggled this year and needs major improvement to win
- 10. LYUBOV SEVEN** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Victorious back in August and is capable of an upset
- 11. LOVICTORY WILLIAMS** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Did better last year and is capable of earning some money
- 12. LOLITA DE RICO** - Victorious in a claimer at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 2 March. A surprise winner last time but others are preferred

**Summary:** A tricky race as both the top two selections are not easy to trust. LILIBETH TURGOT (8) gets a narrow vote to score based on the best she has done, and if wise, she may well score again. LADY ORANGE (6) has a lot more disqualifications than good runs but is a threat to these runners if smart. LADY DE DOMPIERRE (4) is not reliable but should contest the finish. LYNETTE CAT (7) showed improvement and can also shine.

## C8 - PRIX DE LA SAMBUC - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 17,000

**1. MA FELICITE** - A three-year-old filly by Feliciano out of Fortaleza. Full sister to Lover Still and has a winning chance

**2. MAUZIN DE CROUAY** - A three-year-old gelding by Gotland out of Comtesse Ile de Re. David Bakaert drives and has a winning chance

**3. MILORD EVENING** - Disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Capable of improvement but is probably best watched for now

**4. MIRACLE DE KHOREN** - Disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Has room to improve but is probably best watched for now

**5. MY WAY ENJOY** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3025m on 14 March. Expected to improve on debut and could earn some minor money

**6. MAMOUNIA** - Disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Finished 6th on debut before that and more is needed to win

**7. MAEVA DES PRES** - Finished 5th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 February. Has shown improvement but more is needed to win

**8. MONARA DE GUEZ** - Not disgraced when fourth in class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 21 March. Needs to do a bit more to win this race

**9. MOOREA BOND** - Finished fourth on debut in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3025m on 14 March. Can do even better this time around

**10. MADISON ATALANTE** - Disqualified in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 March. In good form before that and is not out of it

**11. MARIE CURIE** - In good shape and was fourth in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 21 February. Big chance in this line-up

**12. MINOS DE BERLES** - Victorious in at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Showed improvement and is clearly not out of it

**Summary:** MARIE CURIE (11) has done enough in her career to justify winning this lucky last race. Two newcomers could be a threat to her. MA FELICITE (1) is a full sister to some fair fillies and deserves respect. MAUZIN DE CROUAY (2) gets a drive from David Bakaert, suggesting he could be ready to win on debut. MOOREA BOND (9) showed promise on debut and also deserves respect.
