**C1 - PRIX GEOGRAPHIE - 3000m (a2m) - TURF - Newcomers - Hurdles -  
EUR € 58,000**

**1. TALEND** - Filly by No Risk At All, the dam won 1 race over fences. From a respected trainer who can produce winners on debut. Looks vulnerable

**2. CREATRICE DE VIE** - Filly by Walk In The Park, the dam won 1 race over hurdles. Some good aspects to her profile and she is worth a market check

**3. FEMME DE COEUR** - Filly by Nirvana Du Berlais, the dam won 6 races over jumps, including a Grade 2 and Grade 3 chase and was placed in a Listed hurdle and Grade 2 chase. From the Nicolle stable that has newcomers well prepared

**4. N'AIE PEUR DE RIEN** - Filly by Cokoriko, the dam won 1 race and was Listed placed over hurdles. Full sister to Sain D'esprit ( Grade 1 and Grade 3 winner over hurdles) From a top stable and worth monitoring in the betting for clues

**5. SCARLETTS STAR** - Filly by Telecaster, the dam won 1 race over hurdles. Nice profile and from a good stable. Ought to be involved on her racecourse bow

**6. SUZETTE** - Filly by Cokoriko, the dam won 1 race over hurdles and was placed in a Listed hurdle. Her connections will have her well-tuned and a bold show can be anticipated

**7. CHIC ME** - Filly by Moises Has, the dam Won 1 race over jumps and was placed in a Listed hurdle. One to watch in the betting for any support

**8. ALANA MOON** - Filly by Sea Moon, the dam won 3 races, 2 on the flat and one over jumps. Likely to improve for this run unless the betting says otherwise

**9. MYAJIMA** - Filly by Kapgarde, the dam won 1 race over jumps. Looks good on paper and any market support could be informative

**10. QUAIN** - Filly by Magic Dream, the dam won 7 races on the flat. Stable runners warrant respect on debut. Others make more appeal

**11. NOUVELLE IDEE** - Filly by Zaskar, the dam won 3 races , 2 on the flat and 1 over hurdles. From a good stable that can be expected to have this filly well prepared. In the mix

**Summary:** N'AIE PEUR DE RIEN (4) has a taking profile and is from a stable that does well with newcomers. She is full sister to Sain D'esprit (Top class Grade 1 and Grade 3 winner over hurdles) and is given a marginal vote ahead of FEMME DE COEUR (3). who is out of a mare that knew how to win and she is from the Nicolle stable that knows the time of day. SUZETTE (6) is from a respected stable that is known to produce plenty of first time out winners. MYAJIMA (9) has some good aspects to her profile and could be useful.

**C2 - PRIX FLEURET - 4400m (a3m) - TURF - Gr3 - Steeple Chase - EUR €  
140,000**

**1. DUC DE ROCHE** - Fair 3rd over 3500m in a Grade 3 chase at this track on March 7th and a win over 3600m in a Listed chase before that in December. Live contender with improvement likely

**2. KOFFI KOMET** - Creditable 4th over 3500m in a Grade 3 chase at this track on March 7th on the latest start . Merits consideration

**3. SHANNON MAESTRO** - 5th on the latest start over 3600m in a Grade 3 hurdle at this track on March 1st. 3rd in the Prix Cambacérès (Grade 1) in November 2025 over hurdles. Warrants respect if back at the top of his game

**4. WILD FUN** - Two solid 2nd place runs of late, the most recent over 3450m in a Class 2 chase at Compiègne on March 11th. Look elsewhere

**5. METRONOMIQUE** - Four wins in a row, the most recent over 3600m in a Class 2 hurdle at Compiègne on March 2nd and three wins over fences before that including a Listed event. Hard to oppose on Auteuil debut

**6. KAP OF GOLD** - Placed 3rd on the most recent start over 3600m in a Class 1 chase at this track on March 14th. Needs a few to falter

**7. QUONSTANTINE** - Solid efforts of late, 2nd on the most recent over 3500m in a Grade 3 chase at this track on March 7th. One to pay close attention to

**Summary:** METRONOMIQUE (5) has scored on the last four runs, the latter in a Class 2 hurdle at Compiègne earlier this month and three wins over fences before that including a Listed chase at Compiègne. He can score at the expense of DUC DE ROCHE (1), who ran well to be third in a Grade 3 chase at this track on March 7th and will have benefited for that run. In second that day was QUONSTANTINE (7), who can once again be expected to be competitive. SHANNON MAESTRO (3) is also one to consider back over fences.

## C3 - PRIX ROSE OR NO - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Listed Divided Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 98,000

- 1. KASSEL ALLEN** - Two 3rd placed runs of late, the latter over 4100m at Compiegne on March 2nd in a Class 2 chase. Leading chance of scoring
- 2. LOQUAS** - Five unplaced runs of late, 6th two runs back in a Listed hurdle at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 4th over 4300m. Can return to form and make the top-four
- 3. LOU FAST** - Two unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 4200m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 1st in a Class 4 chase. Might find this difficult
- 4. MOHICAN** - Fair 5th last time over 3900m in a Grade 3 hurdle at this track on February 23rd. Previous course winner in 2025 and warrants respect
- 5. AULKO** - Finished 5th last time over 3900m at this track in a Listed hurdle on March 7th, won three times over hurdles in 2025 at this track and can make the frame at nice odds
- 6. SHAENJET** - Three unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 3600m at this track in a Class 4 hurdle on November 5th. Can bounce back and be involved
- 7. TATOO** - Won last time over 3600m in a handicap hurdle at Compiegne on March 2nd by 0.75L. Expected to be on the premises despite a weight rise
- 8. DIXAN SENORA** - Finished 2nd on the most recent start over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at this track on March 7th. One to pay attention to
- 9. PABLO** - Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 3800m at Pau on January 28th in a handicap hurdle. Needs to be more reliable
- 10. LE LASCAR** - Unplaced last time, a win before that over 3800m at Pau in a handicap hurdle on December 8th. Capable of a surprise winner if in the mood
- 11. GOLDKIKOU** - Placed 3rd last time over 3800m at Compiegne in a claiming hurdle on March 11th and two wins before that over hurdles and fences. More needed up into a stronger race
- 12. RAFFLES LIAISON** - Two unplaced runs of late, a win previously over 3800m at Pau on January 28th in a handicap hurdle. Has work ahead to feature
- 13. MOSSY WALSH** - Four placed efforts over hurdles, the most recent when 3rd behind TATOO (7) at Compiegne in a handicap over 3600m on March 2nd. Among the leading each-way options
- 14. JUMPER BAIE** - Won over 3900m in a handicap hurdle at this track on March 7th with a game success. Capable of following up despite a penalty
- 15. ROYAL MOON** - Two unplaced efforts this year, a win at Cagnes-Sur-Mer before that on December 29th over 4000m in a handicap hurdle. Seems more suited to Cagnes-Sur-Mer than this track
- 16. TALK SHOW** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 3600m at this track in a handicap hurdle on February 14th. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** JUMPER BAIE (14) won over the track and trip on March 7th in a handicap hurdle and is capable of following up despite a weight rise. His main threat could be SHAENJET (6), who is better than recent form figures and is a course winner in 2024 over hurdles. KASSEL ALLEN (1) has been racing over hurdles and fences recently and looks like a sensible option each-way. LOQUAS (2) can bounce back to form and be involved after a few unplaced efforts. DIXAN SENORA (8) is another to consider after a recent second over the track and trip in a Listed hurdle 21 days ago.

## C4 - PRIX COLONEL DE LA HORIE - CHALL. DE L'OBST. EQUINAXY - 3500m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Steeple Chase - EUR € 61,000

- 1. ESPRIT TRANQUILLE** - Two unplaced runs since a win over 3800m at Strasbourg on November 11th in a Class 3 hurdle. Others make more appeal and he has to convince back over fences
- 2. FAUDA** - Unplaced on the one run this year over 3600m at Compiègne on March 2nd in a handicap hurdle. Not seen before that for two years and is one to avoid
- 3. PAS DE QUARTIER** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 4400m at this track in a handicap chase on November 15th. Course winner last year and hard to overlook at this track
- 4. JOLIVENT** - Creditable 4th at this track over 4400m in a Class 2 chase on February 23rd last time out. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 5. ZAKY** - Two 3rd place efforts of late, the latter over 4100m at Saumur in a Class 3 chase on March 8th. Looks vulnerable
- 6. ZANHOWE** - Placed 4th last time over 3850m at Fontainebleau on February 21st in a handicap chase. Unlikely to be a threat
- 7. KLONG DAO** - Unplaced last time over fences, 2nd before that over 3900m at Machecoul on February 22nd in a Class 4 hurdle. In the mix
- 8. QUEL BONBON** - Two unplaced runs of late, a win before that at Auteuil in a handicap chase on November 15th over 4400m. Can be on the premises
- 9. KING OF FRANCS** - Two placed runs this year, the most recent when 2nd over 4200m in a claiming chase on March 15th at Meslay-Du-Maine. Can make the frame
- 10. NEON HAS** - Finished a creditable 5th last time over 3900m at this track in a handicap hurdle on March 7th. Back over fences and is one to consider
- 11. LA PAGAILLE** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 3800m at Angers in a Class 3 hurdle on February 12th. Looks hard to be enthusiastic about
- 12. HENRY BRULARD** - Two tame efforts this year over hurdles and fences, the most recent over 4400m in a handicap chase at this track on March 1st. Hard to fancy

**Summary:** PAS DE QUARTIER (3) is a previous course winner over fences and seems to raise his game at this venue. He is given the vote ahead of QUEL BONBON (8), who is also a previous winner at this track and is capable of making the selection work hard for success. KING OF FRANCS (9) has performed well on the last two runs, and is one to look at each-way. JOLIVENT (4) is another worth considering and can be involved at the business end.

**C5 - PRIX GRANDAK - 3000m (a2m) - TURF - Newcomers - Hurdles - EUR  
€ 58,000**

- 1. DOC DU MATHAN** - A three-year-old colt by Doctor Dino out of Surprise Du Mathan who is making his debut. His mother was unraced. His brother finished third last year
- 2. LE SIRE** - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions flat race at Chantilly over 1900m on 10 November. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 3. NETKO** - A three-year-old gelding by Cokoriko out of Be Work who is making his debut attempt. His mother won 4 of her 29 starts. Could earn some money
- 4. GOLD LEGEND** - A three-year-old gelding by Latrobe out of Shabby Gold who is making his debut. His mother won 2 of her 24 starts. Monitor the betting
- 5. ANETO** - A three-year-old colt by Saint Des Saints out of Belle et Chic who is making his debut. His Dam never won a race after 5 starts. Monitor the betting
- 6. NEWTON LE DUN** - A three-year-old gelding by Martinborough out of Faaa le Dun who is making her debut. His Dam was unraced. Others make more appeal
- 7. NIKAROF** - A three-year-old year old gelding by Cokoriko out of Vuktip who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced. Others make more appeal
- 8. BATHY DIAMOND** - A three-year-old gelding by Bathyrhon out of Sand Diamond who is making his debut. His Dam won 1 of her 8 starts. Others are preferred
- 9. THE GREY DANDY** - A three-year-old gelding by Masked Marvel out of Kat K who is making his debut. His trainer won this race in 2023. His mother was unplaced in all five of her starts
- 10. ROYAL FLUSH HAS** - A three-year-old gelding by Doctor Dino out of Royale Maria Has who is making his debut. His Dam won 6 of her 19 starts. Should be a threat
- 11. NOM D'UN CHIEN** - A three-year-old gelding by Doctor Dino out of Chasse Gardee whos is making his debut. His mother won 2 of her 17 starts. His brother won this race last year
- 12. NARUTO BANBOU** - A three-year-old gelding by Nirvana du Berlais out of Vestale Banbou who is making his debut. His Dam won one of her 6 starts. Can earn some money
- 13. ZAUGUROK** - A three-year-old gelding by Zaskar out of Augura who is making his debut. His Dam won 4 of her 25 starts. Monitor the betting

**Summary:** Only 1 of the 13 runners has raced before, so it is an interesting race. NOM D'UN CHIEN (11) has a brother who won this race last year, so he immediately catches the eye. ROYAL FLUSH HAS (10) is out of a dam who won six races and would not be a surprise winner for James Reveley. DOC DU MATHAN (1) has a brother who ran third last year and must be respected. ANETO (5) is well bred and one of many others that could be capable of scoring.

## C6 - GRAND STEEPLE-CHASE MASTERS - PRIX MURAT - 4400m (a3m) - TURF - Gr2 - Steeple Chase - EUR € 220,000

**1. TOSCANA DU BERLAIS** - Top-class chaser who finished his year in style with a Group 1 chase victory at this course in the Prix La Haye-Jousselin over 5500m on 16 November. Returns from a break and could just need the run

**2. BON GARCON** - Very consistent and finished fourth in a Group 2 chase over this course and distance on 18 October. Has run well fresh before and can contest the finish

**3. KOLOKICO** - Top-class chaser making his comeback. It is probably best to ignore his last run when unplaced in a Group 1 chase at this track over 5500m on 16 November. Very consistent before that and can be a threat to these rivals

**4. LANIVTSI** - Grade 1 Chase winner in May 2025. Ultra-consistent and was not disgraced when fourth in a Group 1 chase over this track and trip on 16 November. Has claims up against the older horses for the first time

**5. KARRE D'AS** - A faller last time out in a Group 2 chase over this course and distance on 7 December. Exuberant type but has plenty of class and can run well fresh. Must be shortlisted

**6. KAPACA DE THAIX** - Remains in good form and finished third in a Group 3 chase over this course and distance on 14 February. Fit and should be competitive yet again

**7. KIVALA DU BERLAIS** - Did not show his best side when 6th in a Group 1 chase at this course over 3900m on 16 November. Capable of doing better and has claims for some money

**8. MARTHA CANNARY** - Not reliable but did finish fourth in a Group 3 chase over this course and distance on 7 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

**Summary:** KOLOKICO (3) finished 2nd in this race last year before repeating in the Grand Steeple de Paris in his next start. He is coming back from the winter break but should be ready enough to give a good account of himself. The hot-tempered KARRE D'AS (5) does not lack ability and has proven effective when back from a break. She warrants the utmost respect. TOSCANA DU BERLAIS (1) is a very talented horse but could be in need of a run. Stablemate BON GARCON (2) cannot be excluded of the equation.

**C7 - PRIX DE MARSAN - 3600m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Class 1 - Hurdles - EUR  
€ 60,000**

- 1. KILL PASS** - Twice a winner in just four starts and was runner-up in a Conditions hurdle over this track and trip on 7 March. Fit and should be very competitive once again
- 2. SILVER LASER** - Has done little wrong so far and was runner-up in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 14 February. Should be right there at the finish
- 3. CHATEAU LA BARRE** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions hurdle over this track and trip on 7 March. Can make the frame again
- 4. MON MARCEL** - A faller last time out in a Conditions hurdle over this course and distance on 7 March. Unlucky that day and can contest the finish
- 5. KILLING BID** - A faller last time out in a Group 2 hurdle race over this track and trip on 12 October. Unlucky last time out and could contest the finish if fit enough
- 6. TROUBLEINPARADISE** - Improving and was victorious in a Conditions hurdle at Fontainebleau over 3550m on 21 February. Tougher task in this line-up
- 7. MESSE DE MINUIT** - Holding form and finished third in a Conditions hurdle at this track over 3500m on 7 March. Might earn some minor money

**Summary:** A small field but a very competitive-looking race. KILLING BID (5) was a faller last time out, but he was threatening a challenge and can bounce back to score. SILVER LASER (2) is clearly talented and only found one better on the day when trying this track last time out. KILL PASS (1) is fit and has won half his starts, so would not be a surprise winner. MON MARCEL (4) fell when disputing a place earlier this month and is also capable of shining.

## C8 - PRIX PHILIPPE DEMERCASTEL - PRIX NECOR - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 60,000

- 1. DINOZAURE** - Unreliable but was victorious last time out in a handicap hurdle at this track over 3600m on 14 February. Carries a penalty but is not out of it
- 2. I'M SUPER QUICK** - A winner of her last three starts, all chases, the latest at Meslay-du-Maine over 4200m on 26 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. GARRYGAL** - Returned from a lengthy break and was fourth in a Conditions hurdle at Machecoul over 3900m on 8 March. Tougher task in this line-up
- 4. MAZARIN DU BERLAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 7 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. TRES PLUMEUR** - Not reliable but was a good third in a handicap hurdle over this course on 7 March. Has claims in this line-up
- 6. FOR FRIENDSHIP** - Bounced back to form with a track and trip victory on 7 March. Carries a penalty but must be respected for that win and can make the frame
- 7. KOP DE BOULOGNE** - Not reliable and was 7th in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 7 March. Might earn some minor money at very best
- 8. OAK CREEK** - Holding form and was fourth in a claiming hurdle at Compiègne over 3800m on 11 March. Might play a minor role
- 9. BOOM BOOM CIAO** - Consistent last year and was third in a handicap hurdle at this track over 3600m on 29 November. Returns from a break but can earn some money
- 10. NAIROBI D'OROUX** - Not reliable but did run well when fourth in a handicap hurdle over this track and trip on 7 March. Has a place chance
- 11. KOLOMBIN DES ISLES** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions hurdle at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 10 March. Could be a lively danger on handicap debut
- 12. WALFER** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in a Conditions hurdle over this course and distance on 7 March. Should be a threat once again
- 13. THE MUST** - Not disgraced in both starts this year, the latest when 5th in a handicap hurdle over this track and trip on 7 March. Might play a minor role
- 14. JACKSON DIGEO** - Returned from a lengthy break and was 5th in a Conditions hurdle at Argentan over 3600m on 6 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 15. SIRLIGHT** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a handicap hurdle over this track and trip on 7 March. Can be competitive once again
- 16. JIKITO** - Yet to win a race and finished 5th in a Conditions chase at Compiègne over 4100m on 2 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 17. CELEB** - On a long losing run and dislodged the rider last time out at this track over 3900m on 7 March. Others are preferred
- 18. ALGAJUST** - Very unreliable but did run third last time out in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 7 March. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** A very open-looking lucky last race. TRES PLUMEUR (5) is not as reliable as some others in this line-up, but he did run well when third over this course and distance earlier in the month. It could be his winning turn. DINOZAURE (1) was a good winner that day and it would not be a surprise to see him follow up while carrying a penalty. WALFER (12) is in good shape and should fight it out once again. FOR FRIENDSHIP (6) carries a penalty for a track-and-trip success and is another to consider.
