**C1 - PRIX DE GINAI - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness
- EUR € 6,000**

1. JAILLIR - Yet to win a race and finished 9th in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score

2. KHEOPS DE L'EST - Probably needed his only run of the year when 8th in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Fitter now and is capable of an upset

3. JOCKEY CADENCE - Disappointing recent form and was disqualified at Reims over 2500m on 1 March. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

4. JERIDAN - Has some fair recent form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. Can earn some minor money

5. IRONIE DES BROUETS - On a long losing run and finished 6th in Class G at Reims over 2500m on 1 March. Needs to do a bit more to score

6. INDRA DE FORGES - Finished unplaced last time out in Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 16 October. Returns from a break and might play a minor role at very best

7. HALLO DE MANCHE - Returned from a break in good form and was runner-up in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Can go one place better this time

8. HUGO FRATI - Needed his only run of the year when 7th in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 7 March. Fitter this time and is capable of scoring

9. JUST LOVE D'ALSACE - Probably needed his only run of this year when 7th in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Can contest the finish

10. GIORGIO DU VIVIER - Off form and was unplaced in Class G at Maquenchy over 2150m on 16 March. Capable of winning a race of this nature

Summary: A very weak race and anything is possible in this opening event. HUGO FRATI (8) did not run badly in his only run of this year. He should strip fitter and gets the narrow vote to score. JOCKEY CADENCE (3) is not reliable but does have claims in a race of this nature. JUST LOVE D'ALSACE (9) has some form at this track and should be competitive after needing the last run. GIORGIO DU VIVIER (10) is capable of beating these rivals if back to his best.

C2 - PRIX GENYBET - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,000

- 1. NATSUMI QUEEN** - A three-year-old filly by Hokkaido Jiel out of Idole d'Henlou who is making her debut. Her mother was unraced. Well bred and can be a threat
- 2. NEYLIA DU CYFLO** - A three-year-old filly by Harvest de Bulière out of Vague Mika who is making her debut. Her dam won 4 of her 92 starts. Monitor the betting
- 3. NOVAK** - A three-year-old colt by Impressionist out of Conquête à Deux who is making his debut. His mother won twice in her 15 starts. Qualified nicely at Caen and can score
- 4. NAUSICAA JIEL** - Disqualified in both starts so far, the latest in a mounted race at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Probably best watched for now
- 5. NOUMEA BUROISE** - Not disgraced when fourth on debut in Class G at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 6. NOBLE SAUTONNE** - Showed promise on debut when third in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 8 March. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. NOSTALGIE CENE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 15 January. Capable of being a threat to these rivals
- 8. NIGHT CLUB** - A bit of a disappointment when 7th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 14 March. Did better on debut and could make the frame
- 9. NARCISSE BUROIIS** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Reims over 2550m on 14 March. Has a place chance on best form

Summary: NOBLE SAUTONNE (6) showed promise when third on debut at Strasbourg, setting a solid standard for this race and making him a confident choice to score. Some newcomers also look likely to challenge. NOVAK (3) is well bred and posted a good qualifying time at Caen. The two fillies, NATSUMI QUEEN (1) and NEYLIA DI CHEFLYO (2), both catch the eye—NATSUMI QUEEN looks ready for this, while NEYLIA DI CHEFLYO qualified with a solid time and should be a danger.

**C3 - PRIX ANTONIN DAUM - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
17,000**

- 1. MISS FINE** - Disqualified in both her starts so far, the latest in class G at Chartres over 2800m on 16 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 2. MANADE** - Consistent and was runner-up in class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 14 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. MAGNIFICA JOSSELYN** - Not reliable but was 3rd in class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of contesting the finish
- 4. MURCIELAGO MIJO** - Disqualified twice in just four starts, including in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Capable of bouncing back to score
- 5. MAX LA FRIPOUILLE** - Successful in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Has shown improvement and can double up if in the same frame of mind
- 6. MENHIR** - Disqualified twice in four starts, including at Avenches over 2400m on 19 March. Victorious back in February but others are preferred
- 7. MONA VILI** - Victorious in Class F at Savenay over 2600m on 28 September. Has disqualification issues and is returning from a break. Might place
- 8. MAMOUR DU CHENE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in class E at Reims over 2550m on 10 November. Returns from a break but has a place chance if staying in stride
- 9. MELANOURA** - Not disgraced when 4th in class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 10. MARWIN** - Did not show his best when 6th at Mons over 2300m on 17 February. Capable of making the frame in this line-up
- 11. MOGADOR DE LATZ** - Needed his last run when 5th in class F at Feurs over 2850m on 8 March. Fitter now and should be right there at the finish

Summary: MURCIELAGO MIJO (4) has had some issues in her career so far but is talented and can bounce back to beat these rivals if showing her best form. MOGADOR DE LATZ (11) will be fitter after his comeback run and should be a threat. MAGNIFICA JOSSELYN (3) is not reliable but does finish well when in the mood and is not out of it. MARWIN (10) is better than his last run at Mons and is capable of making the frame.

C4 - PRIX EMILE GALLE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. LADY DE JANEIRO** - Unreliable but was runner-up-up in a Class F at Caen over 2200m on 16 March. Can earn some more money
- 2. LUCIUS DE PUCH** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Needed that run and might play a minor role at very best
- 3. LESS TIME** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class F at Reims over 2500m on 19 March. Can make the frame again
- 4. LUGER** - Has some fair form of late and finished 3rd at Wolvega over 2600m on 21 March. Tackles a bit tougher this time around
- 5. LEXOVIENNE** - Returned to form when runner-up in a Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 15 March. Should contest the finish
- 6. LIBERTY AVENUE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class E at Le Croise - Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. LUMIERE DAIRPET** - Disqualified in her last three starts, the latest at Toulouse on 30 January. Capable of earning some money when smart
- 8. LOCAL HERO** - Continues to win his races, his latest a Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 15 March. Can add another win to his tally
- 9. LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS** - Clearly talented and finished 4th in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 2 August. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 10. LINAS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 9 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. LUCKY CASTELETS** - Has shown improvement of late and finished 3rd in a Class E at Le Croise -Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Keeps that shoeing and has a place chance
- 12. LUCIA DU CHATELET** - Disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 31 January. Hard to trust but is capable of an upset when staying on the trot

Summary: An open-looking race. LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS (9) is talented and could take the win, though he returns from a lengthy break and his fitness is a question mark. LOCAL HERO (8) has been winning freely this year and will be a strong threat again. LEXOVIENNE (5) bounced back to form at Amiens and can improve further, while LESS TIME (3) is progressing and is another contender for the finish.

- 1. KALIE PIQUENARD** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class F at Reims over 2500m on 14 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. KIRSCH VRIE** - Not reliable and was disqualified at Reims on 14 March. On a long losing run and others are preferred in this line-up
- 3. KEEP CONTROL** - In good form and was runner-up in a claimer at Bihorel-Les-Rouen over 2500m on 8 March. Tougher task and has disqualification issues
- 4. KHA ETOILE** - Unreliable but did finish 3rd in a Class H at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Can play a minor role at very best
- 5. KIRUNA DU PONCELET** - Disqualified at Reims on 14 March. Hard to trust and is probably best watched until improvement is shown
- 6. KOSTA BUROISE** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class H at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Barefoot this time but others make more appeal
- 7. KOKO D'ARNHEM** - Only modest form of late and finished 8th in a Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. KIMBILA** - Disqualified at Mauquenchy on 24 February. Consistent before that and has a place chance if staying in stride
- 9. KAKI DE VAL** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class D at this track over 2600m on 9 November. Remains barefoot and is returning from a break. Might place
- 10. KASH ELEVEN** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Could be the surprise package of the race, fitter this time
- 11. KARLOS NAY** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class F at Castillonnes over 2475m on 8 March. Races without shoes and has a place chance
- 12. KEEP TOUCH** - Did not show her best when 7th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 28 October. Capable of making the frame returning from a break
- 13. KEOPS DU RABUTIN** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class D at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Barefoot this time and could earn some minor money
- 14. KING DE FOURCHES** - Unplaced in both starts this year, the latest in a Class D at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Barefoot and ready to strike this time around
- 15. KIARHA DE NAPPES** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class G at Reims over 2575m on 19 March. Races without shoes and should contest the finish
- 16. KATITZI** - Finished 4th in a Class G at Le Mans over 2850m on 15 December. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough

Summary: KING DE FOURCHES (14) is running barefoot and looks primed for a victory, with his two early runs this year easily overlooked. KIARHA DE NAPPES (15) also races without shoes and should be competitive once more. KATITZI (16) returns from a break but has talent and could easily spring a surprise. KEEP TOUCH (12) is clearly better than her last run at Vincennes and must be respected on her previous form, returning from a break.

- 1. JEROME PICOULERIE** - Off form and finished 11th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 2 November. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- 2. JAMIN DE BRY** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a claimer at Montauban over 2400m on 23 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. KAPORAL DE VIETTE** - Returned from a break and was unplaced in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 15 March. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 4. KARLA DES THUYAS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. KILLER DE BEAULIEU** - Disqualified in class E at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- 6. KINGLY DREAMS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 19 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 7. KADOR DU RABUTIN** - Has some fair recent form and was 5th in class G at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Can earn some minor money
- 8. KATYUSHA** - Victorious in Class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Ultra-consistent this year and can follow up
- 9. JACOBSON** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Needs to do more to score
- 10. JOHNNY MIX** - Not reliable and was 5th in class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Victorious back in February and can make the frame
- 11. JULIAN DARK** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 29 January. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 12. KIWI DU LOISIR** - In good shape and was 5th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Successful back in February and can be a threat again
- 13. JAFLO GEMA** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Remains barefoot and needs to improve to win
- 14. KISS ME JULRY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 25 February. In good form before that and has claims

Summary: KATYUSHA (8) picked up a confidence-boosting win at La Capelle and could follow up over this track and trip. KISS ME JULRY (14) is better than her last run would suggest and will not go down without a fight for top honours. KIWI DU LOISIR (12) remains in good form and should be right there at the finish once again. JOHNNY MIX (10) has some solid recent performances and is another capable of shining brightly on a good day.

- 2. INKERMAN DE PLAY** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Enghien over 2875m on 13 March. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 3. HELLO CAUVELLIERE** - Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class F at Amiens over 2925m on 9 December. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. HARABICA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2900m on 15 March. Is capable of making the frame
- 5. IDEAL MOSSA** - Off form this year and was 9th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 4 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
