PREVIEW: RAZZLE DAZZLE EM failed to build on her promising debut second over this trip when stepped up to 1600m last time out but could make amends with the experience of another outing and natural improvement expected. IMPERIAL BALLET and FLY TO RIO have both the form and experience to keep that rival honest, although a bigger threat is likely to come from PRINCESS OF WINTER who has finished in the money in recent starts over this trip with blinkers (retained) on. REAL JOY wasn't beaten far in over shorter last time and gave the impression that she'd be better for this step up in trip, so could improve to stake a claim too.

CAPTAIN DIZZY finished a creditable third in his hat-trick bid recently but had beaten back-to-form SPEED OF NIGHT in his previous start and on that form should go well again. The latter is better off on these revised weight terms so should be competitive. Last-start winner SPRING AWAKENING is highly thought of and has rediscovered his form, so could fight it out with further progress likely. FORT RED and BRAVE TIGER are capable on their day. Good race.

PREVIEW: FIGHTER won a stronger contest over track and trip when last seen and a resultant four-point penalty is unlikely to prevent another forward showing. CAMPS BAY improved to open his account last time out and further progress is expected. DE BULL and BALTIMORE JACK will enjoy a return to this trip (both disappointed over further last time) so must be respected. The former could improve with cheekpieces on, while the latter has solid recent form over this distance. ROSTROPOVICH has rediscovered his form of late and is an unknown quantity over this trip. LINE OF POWER has claims off this mark and shouldn't be overlooked.

PREVIEW: Competitive handicap. MISS MILLSTREAM capitalised on a reduced merit rating to win her last start in a similar contest and may have escaped with just a two-point penalty. Stablemates CELTIC NIGHT and ROYAL BLUE have similar profiles. They have scope for improvement and are likely to be competitive with further progress expected of both runners over this trip. Recent maiden winners PRETTY BETTY and ROSE PRINCESS have scope too but will need to improve to have a say on handicap debut. Hard-knocking HAMMIE'S FAN has been holding form and could pose a threat under these conditions. GILLIAN ANNE is another to consider.

PREVIEW: Consistent MAJOR ATTRACTION fared better than three of her re-opposing rivals when they clashed in a similar contest over this trip at Durbanville recently. She finished ahead of both CHILE JAM and LAURENTINA and with further improvement should confirm that form. The latter is better off on these revised weight terms and should pose a threat. SPRINGISINTHEAIR boasts solid form credentials and wouldn't be a surprise winner either. DAD'S CATCH and CRUSADE'S PROMISE are capable, but it could pay to follow the progress of unexposed OSCAR'S WINNER who caught the eye in a comeback sprint recently. She will strip fitter and should also improve for the step up to this distance. Tricky.

PREVIEW: JAIMALA has improved with each run and took a big step forward when wearing blinkers for the first time in his last start. On that evidence, this step up in trip should bring about further improvement, so a bold bid is expected. Well-bred ROYAL GROVE has a bit to find on that form but was on debut so would've come on since. LORD MARMITE has improved after a rest and is likely to be at peak fitness now, so should be competitive from an inside gate. Both BEY SUYAY and TARA ITI have the form to pose a threat, while BUFFALO THORN and AFRICANROYALJEWEL are others with earning potential.
