- 1. **NOWENDOC** 1L winner at Fontainebleau on reappearance two runs back. Back at a realistic level now and should go well.
- 2. LIFRENCHTEEN Modest form in two starts so far. Easily opposed.
- 3. **DESIR WAY** Lost his way this campaign and needs to bounce back to form now.
- 4. **LA GREGORIENNE** Only a modest performance on debut at Fontainebleau and needs to improve sharply.
- 5. **CANDY CANE** Trailed the field on debut at Fontainebleau just under three weeks ago. Happy to take on.
- 6. **HEPZIBAH** 1.3L winner at Deauville AW on just second career start. Likely there is a lot more to come. Big chance.
- 7. **ARAZY** 2L second at Fontainebleau on reappearance was a great effort. Should only improve. Keep safe.
- 8. **MA DIFFERENCE** Slightly better on second career start but remains unlikely to factor amongst this field.
- 9. **FLASH TEMPO** Mid-field finishes in handicaps on recent outings. Shaped with promise and may progress trying a new distance. Each way chance.
- 10. **CHANTEUSE** 3L third at Fontainebleau second up. This is no tougher and should progress further.
- 11. **LIFELINE** Inconsistent filly. Very much a player on best form but hard to trust.

Summary

ARAZY (7) won on final start of the previous campaign. Resumed close to that level with good second and is improving all the time. The one to beat. NOWENDOC (1) struggled in a strong Chantilly event. This is more realistic however and already is a winner this season. Big chance. HEPZIBAH (6) took a step forward on second career start breaking through. May improve further so keep safe. FLASH TEMPO (9) shaped with promise on recent outings. Now third up so can be primed.

- 1. **MON BEL CANTO** With a top yard and won first two starts. Highly tried following that and came up short but was far from disgraced. Contender in this level.
- 2. **MIAMI VOICE** Stayed on well for 1.3L debut success at Fontainebleau. This is a lot tougher but will enjoy the extra distance. Hard to rule out.
- 3. **BOUTTEMONT** Struggled in the Longchamp 1800m G3 Prix La Force on reappearance. Can show up much better in this grade.
- 4. **CANTOS** 2L success at this track and trip on debut four weeks ago. That was impressive and should only improve. Big chance.
- 5. **WATCH HIM** Chantilly AW winner on debut but failed to progress second up. Can show more now. Shortlisted.
- 6. **EXCITING** Game long-neck winner here on sole career start three weeks ago. Open to improvement. Each way chance.

Summary

CANTOS (4) is a perfect one from one having won impressively here on debut. Can only improve and is the one to beat. MON BEL CANTO (1) comes with two wins and a placing from four starts. Now commences a second campaign and likely there is more to come. Keep safe. WATCH HIM (5) had excuses when a beaten favourite in a similar class. Expect better now. BOUTTEMONT (3) drops in grade. Each way claims at a more realistic level.

- 3. **BELLE EVASION** Trailed the field on reappearance. Now second up should progress but a place may prove best.
- 4. **LIBERTY ISLAND** Game 0.5L winner on debut at Strasbourg. This is a lot tougher but may improve. Holds claims.
- 5. **ANTOLYA** Resumes following a six month absence. Looked a smart prospect on first campaign and should improve for a notable yard. Keep safe.
- 6. **LAHAAIB** Placed on both starts so far. Good head second at Fontainebleau six weeks back. Can improve further. In the mix.
- 7. **DRAWN TO RACE** Took a big step forward from first to second start when a 2L winner at Pornichet. Likely to be primed for reappearance. Shortlisted.
- 8. **TALABAAT** Made the perfect start to her career when a 1L winner at Toulouse. Gets a notable jockey booking. Worth a second look.

Summary

COMPLICATION (1) is improving with each start. Impressed when going clear for a 3L success and could be hard to beat again. DRAWN TO RACE (7) delivered a positive second career outing and may do much better this campaign. Easy to fancy. TALABAAT (8) showed promise when making a winning debut. Top jockey booked and can progress. LAHAAIB (6) placed twice from two attempts so far. Could improve further. Holds each way claims.

- 2. **PEACE MESSENGER** First time starter by Air Force Blue. Wide stall not ideal for debut and likely best watched.
- 3. **CAESARS PALACE** Expensive purchase as a yearling. With a top yard and likely to be primed. Big chance.
- 4. **MY SYMBOL** One of two nicely bred debutants for the yard. Market check will prove a good guide.
- 5. **CEASE AND DESIST** With a top stable but has an apprentice booked for debut. Market check advised.
- 6. **NOUVEL EMPIRE** First time starter from the A & G Botti stable. Related to winners and could easily factor on debut.
- 7. **ICAMPARO** All siblings to have made the track have won so certainly bred to have ability. Eye-catching jockey booking. Each way chance on debut.
- 8. **BOTAS** Slightly concerning this speedily bred gelding has not managed to make the track until now. Do not discount without a market check.
- 9. **AFGHANY** Colt by The Gurkha. Yard can ready one so no surprise to see him go close first up.
- 10. **INVINCIBLE LIGHT** Gelding by Territories. Yard can ready one so he is of interest. Each way chance.

Summary

In a field full of debutantes a market check will prove telling. SIYAZANN (1) is beautifully bred. Likely to be fit enough to do himself justice and looks the one to beat. CAESARS PALACE (3) was an expensive purchase. May deliver a big run first up. ICAMPARO (7) comes related to multiple winners. Each way player on debut. CEASE AND DESIST (5) represents a top yard. Secures apprentice assistance for initial run. Each way chance.

- 1. **VARDANA** Smart prospect by Awtaad. Wide stall not ideal and yards runners can need a start but remains of interest.

- 3. PINGO Eye-catching jockey booking for this filly by Anodin. Holds claims.
- 4. VILLA WAGRAM Expensive purchase as a yearling. Likely to be primed for debut and is easy to fancy.
- 5. TAN TAMASHA First time starter from the Fabrice Chappet stable. Market can guide.
- 6. TANIA Inexpensive purchase and looks up against it on debut.
- 7. **MILLENIAL** Nicely bred daughter of Siyouni. This trip looks suitable for debut and should enjoy conditions. Shortlisted.
- 8. NESKA POLITA Speedily bred filly. Good jockey booked and well drawn. Of interest first up.
- 9. MON AMOUR Siblings have been limited and may prove best watched on debut.

- 1. **GENOLA** High class type that is yet to miss the placings after eight career starts. Game 2L winner in this grade a month ago. Contender.

- 3. **GESS OF THE VALLEY** Only mid-field in an easier contest than this four weeks back at Marseille-Borely. Needs more.
- 4. **HOLA KLASS** Progressive filly who remains unexposed and open to further progression. This is a step up in grade but holds each way claims.
- 5. **HESTER D'ATHON** Game 0.8L winner at Angers on debut last October over 2900m. Upped in grade. Shortlisted.
- 6. **HERMINE DES OBEAUX** 6L victory at Le Lion-D'angers three weeks ago. This is a lot tougher but deserves a try at this level.
- 7. **GIRLISH DE GRUGY** Mid-field at this track on reappearance. Should progress but happy to just watch.

- 3. **BOIS D'ARGENT** 3L victory at Fontainebleau on reappearance. Impressed that day and remains open to further progression. Shortlisted.
- 4. **FROHSIM** Placed on both recent outings and now third up so should be primed. Good jockey booked and is easy to fancy.
- 5. **UGOTTHELOOK** Won on debut at this venue but a very poor outing at Fontainebleau since. Needs to bounce back.
