# C1 - PRIX DE LA LIGUE CONTRE LA CARDIOMYOPATHIE - 2825m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. IMPEC D'ECOUVES -** Has lost his way completely of late and was 11th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 22 April. Best watched for now
- **2. INTERMEDE DU RIL** Disqualified in his last two starts with the latest being at this course on 22 September. Returns from a break but can surprise if wise
- **3. IMEO DU BOULAY -** Disappointing form this year and was disqualified last time out at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre on 13 April. Others are preferred
- **4. ISOLACCIO -** Returned to form when barefoot and runner-up last time out in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 15 April. Can go one better this time
- **5. IVORY DU CHERISAY -** Has some fair form this year and was fourth last time out in Class E at this course over 2825m on 31 March. Can make the frame
- **6. INCREDIBLE CHARM -** Showed improvement when runner-up and barefoot last time out in Class H at Orléans over 3400m on 1 April. Can contest the finish
- **7. IBISCUS DE L'ITON -** Disappointing last two runs and was tenth last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **8. ICONE DE L'ETRE -** Very unreliable but did show her best when runner-up last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 26 February. Has major disqualification issues but is capable of winning

**Summary:** A very tough race to start with. ISOLACCIO (4) returned to form with a good run when barefoot and remains barefoot and capable of going one better. INCREDIBLE CHARM (6) ran well over further on the grass last time out but is not out of it. ICONE DE L'ETRE (8) is very unreliable but did run well last time out and could be ready for another good performance. IZELDA (9) is one of many more that are capable of a surprise if wise.

- 2. JALISCA FLIGNY Has disappointed in both starts this year and was 7th last time out in Class D at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 21 April. Capable of making the frame
- **3. JOIA DE PIENCOURT -** A bit of a disappointment when 7th last time out at Alençon over 2650m on 21 April. Capable of better and is capable of contesting the finish
- **4. JACKSON HILL -** Disappointing form of late and was disqualified last time out at this course on 14 April. Best watched for now
- **5. JOKER DU LYS -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D at Alençon 21 April. Might play a minor role

- 2. IRVING HEROLD Much improved of late and was a barefoot winner of his last two starts with the latest being in Class F over this course and distance. Can complete the hat-trick
- **3. HANACK DE VIVOIN -** Disappointing last run when 7th last time out in Class E at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 14 April. Capable of an upset on best form
- **4. HAPPY COCO -** In very good form of late winning two of the last three starts including a Class H win at Orléans over 3400m on 1 April. Not out of it
- **5. IDYLLE PIYA -** Unreliable of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 11 April. Capable of earning some money

- **2. KALAGA DU CADRAN -** Unreliable but was barefoot and tird last time out in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 7 April. Not barefoot tis time but could play a minor role
- **3. KALIMBA DE CAPONET -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Laval on 19 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. KATE DU RIL -** A winner on debut but was disqualified last time out at Reims on 21 March. Capable of bouncing back to score
- **5. KIERA MAGIC -** Unreliable and was fourth last time out in Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 31 March. Others are preferred
