C1 - PRIX DU HANDBALL HYERES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. LILY ROSE - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Marseille-Borély on 7 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal

2. LOZARI - Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Did win at this track before that and is not out of it

3. LOUKOUM DE L'ITON - Much improved last run when barefoot and fourth in a claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

4. LOOKING SIXTY ONE - Has struggled of late and was 13th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Barefoot this time and is capable of scoring

5. LA HORSE - Broke through with a victory last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 25 April. May be better under the saddle

6. LIGNE BLANCHE - In good form this year and was not disgraced when fourth in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 May. Big chance in this line-up

7. LADY DE GINAI - Holding her form and she finished fourth in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Could play a minor role

8. LOOPING GRIFF - Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 18 May. Can double up

9. L'AMERICAIN - Has struggled all year and finished 12th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Needs major improvement to win

10. LUCKY ARCTIC - A winner of three of his last four starts, with the latest being in Class E at this track over 2850m on 10 May. Can follow up

11. LASKO DES FORGES - Needed his only run of the year when 6th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Fitter this time and has a winning chance

Summary: LIGNE BLANCHE (6) has been very consistent this year and was not disgraced at Marseille-Borély earlier this month. This distance likely suits her better, and she is capable of beating these rivals. LASKO DES FORGES (11) needed his last run and will be a danger if returning to his best form. LUCKY ARCTIC (10) has been in excellent form recently and scored a win at this track, so it would not be a surprise to see him win again. LOOPING GRIFF (8) has also improved lately and cannot be ruled out.

C2 - PRIX FABIEN ROSSOLINI - 2850m (a2m) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **KAPITANO DREAM** - Disappointing last run when 8th in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Has won three times this year and is capable of an upset
2. **KING'S DAY** - Has struggled a bit this year and was 6th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
3. **KADOR D'ESPACE** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, including last time out at Vincennes on 9 May. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money when wise
4. **KRISTAL DREAM** - Probably needed his only run of the year when 9th in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Fitter and is barefoot this time so must be respected
5. **KIEFFER D'OURVILLE** - Very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Has a place chance
6. **KHAN D'HERIPRE** - Unreliable but did finish 7th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 5 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
7. **KENZA KALOUMA** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 5 May. Barefoot this time and can contest the finish again
8. **KOOL CRISTAL** - At the top of his game with some nice wins of late, the latest in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Quite capable of completing the hat-trick
9. **KASH SNIPER** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification in his latest start at Cavaillon on 8 April. Has already won twice this year and has a winning chance
10. **KOLBE DESBOIS** - Unreliable and was 12th in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 16 May. Was a barefoot winner at this track in his penultimate start and is unshod this time. Not out of it
11. **KEROS DES BAUX** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over this distance on 1 April. Capable of earning some minor money

Summary: KOOL CRISTAL (8) has been very good of late and has a bright chance of completing a hat-trick. KASH SNIPER (9) has disqualification issues, but he has already won a couple of times this year and is capable of winning again. KOLBE DESBOIS (10) won his penultimate start when barefoot and is unshod all four; he is capable of bouncing back from a weak last effort. KENZA KALOUMA (7) is not reliable, but can also get into the mix of things again.

C3 - PRIX LIONEL GAZENGEL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. **GO AWAY BIRD** - Has really struggled this year and was tenth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 30 April. Needs major improvement to win
2. **IDEAL GREEN** - In good shape of late and was fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. On a long losing streak but could be ready to score
3. **HOLD UP NOCTURNE** - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély on 7 May. In good form before that and has a winning chance
4. **GAUCHO DE HOUELLE** - Unreliable and finished tenth in Class C at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 22 May. Capable of a surprise but others are preferred
5. **GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - On a long losing run and finished 7th in Class C at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
6. **HISTOIRE DU MIDI** - Has lost her way and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély on 4 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
7. **HARLEQUIN** - On a very long losing run and was fourth in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 11 April. Can contest the finish once again
8. **GALINETTE BLEUE** - Has struggled in three starts this year and was unplaced in Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 18 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
9. **INCROYABLE BLACK** - Has disqualification issues and was 6th in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 18 May. Distance-suited and is capable of winning if in the right mood
10. **FOND OF YOU** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class C at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 22 May. Others make much more appeal
11. **HAPPY ATOUT** - On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 17 May. Capable of making the frame
12. **HAYASTAN DE ROSAN** - Has some fair recent form and was fourth in Class E over this track and trip on 1 May. Could play a minor role

Summary: A weak-looking race and IDEAL GREEN (2) does look the best of them. IDEAL GREEN (2) is in good form of late and can break a long losing streak. HARLEQUIN (7) has a good record when barefoot and is fully unshod, so could be a threat once again. INCROYABLE BLACK (9) has probably needed all three runs this year and is capable of improvement. HOLD UP NOCTURNE (3) was in good form before fluffing his lines with a fault at Marseille-Borély earlier this month.

C4 - PRIX DU CHATEAU REAL-MARTIN - 2850m (a2m) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 51,000

1. FAMEUX SAX - On a long losing run but was third in Class C at this track over 2650m on 10 May. Has a place chance in this line-up

2. GABY DES VALS - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 16 May. Might play a minor role

3. HARRY LE BEAU - Returned to form with a victory in Class C at this course over 2650m on 10 May. Quite capable of following up

4. EREGON DE JUPILLES - Very unreliable but was third in Class B over this course and distance on 1 May. Could earn some minor money

5. FARMER KERYVON - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in Class C at this track over 2650m on 10 May. Can contest the finish

6. GOODMAN TURGOT - Has really struggled of late and was tenth in Class B at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 May. Capable of better but others are preferred

7. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS - Ultra-consistent and was victorious in a Group 3 at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 28 April. Be right there at the finish

8. FUTUR DU CHENE - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 10 May. Battling to regain best form but might sneak some minor money

9. GOLIATH DU CAUX - Has really struggled of late and was 11th in Class B at Marseille-Borély over 2150m on 16 May. Needs major improvement to win

10. EDEN JULRY - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 12 May. Might lay a minor role

11. INGRID TURGOT - Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in Class B over this track and trip on 1 May. Can follow up if wise

12. INDUS VAL - Very consistent of late and only found one better on the day when runner-up in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 May. Big chance in this line-up

13. HUDO DU RUEL - In good form and was victorious last time out in Class B at Cavaillon over 2525m on 8 April. Not barefoot this time so others are preferred

Summary: INDUS VAL (12) has been a model of consistency this year and comes off a strong recent run at Vincennes. He sets the standard here and looks poised to go one better. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS (7) impressed with a Group 3 win over a shorter trip last month. If arriving in the same form, he's a major contender once again. INGRID TURGOT (11) scored convincingly over this course and distance earlier in the month. However, past disqualification issues raise some caution. FARMER KERYVON (5) is without a win for some time but continues to show promise. A breakthrough could be imminent.

C5 - PRIX ENUMIERE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **HALBI** - Holding form well and was third in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 9 May. Be right there at the finish once again
2. **ILLICO DE BUSSET** - Has struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély on 18 May. Needs major improvement to win this race
3. **HADES JULRY** - Has struggled of late and was 13th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 11 May. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
4. **GLADIATOR DE NIMES** - On a very long losing run but was fourth in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 9 May. Could make the frame
5. **ISSALIO** - Very consistent of late and was third in Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 28 April. Big chance in this line-up
6. **ICARE FILE** - Unreliable and was 6th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 11 May. Capable of better this distance and is not out of it in this line-up
7. **GALVESTON** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 26 April. Can go one better in this line-up
8. **ISBA BESNOT** - Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 18 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
9. **IPSOS D'ARIANE** - Only modest of late and was 5th in Class H at Oraison over 2650m on 8 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
10. **IRINUSHKA** - Unreliable and was disqualified at Toulouse on 9 May. Not easy to trust but does have a winning chance
11. **GENTLEMAN POWER** - Disqualified last time out at Strasbourg on 15 May. Needs major improvement to win a race like this and others are much preferred
12. **IPSO SIMARDIERE** - Has struggled in both starts this year and was 8th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 16 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
13. **IL VILLAGGIO** - Unreliable and was 12th in Class F at Vichy over 2800m on 12 May. Did better at this course before that and has a place chance
14. **HIBISCUS DE MAISY** - Has lost his way this year and was 8t in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 18 May. Others make more appeal

Summary: ISSALIO (5) has not won for some time now but has been very consistent of late. He can be rewarded with some winning success any day now. HALBI (1) remains in very good form and should be right there at the finish once again. ICARE FILE (6) has been best around this distance and has won with this shoe combination in the past. IRINUSHKA (10) is not reliable but is quite capable of getting involved with the finish when in the right mood.

C6 - PRIX BDCA - 2850m (a2m) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. MISS MARGOT** - Showed some improvement second time out and was runner-up in Class D over this course and distance on 10 May. Can earn some more money
- 2. MAITRE D'HOULBEC** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Marseille-Borély on 16 May. Hard to trust but could earn some money
- 3. MAMBA DES DURIEZ** - Yet to win a race and was 7th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Others are preferred
- 4. MERLIN DES CHAMPS** - Improving and was victorious in Class D over this track and trip on 10 May. Capable of being very competitive in this line-up
- 5. MOON TURGOT** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Capable of making the frame again
- 6. MISTRAL LOMIG** - Bounced back to form and was fourth in Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 16 May. Could earn some minor money
- 7. MANOLITA** - Yet to win a race but was third last time out in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. MEJANES** - Consistent this year and was runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 9. MY LOVE PANAME** - Consistent so far and was runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 March. Can go one better this time
- 10. MY LOVE GIO** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Vincennes on 6 May. Two good wins before that and can bounce to score

Summary: MY LOVE GIO (10) faulted at Vincennes but perhaps that run is best ignored. He looked good in his two wins before that and can bounce back to score. MY LOVE PANAME (9) has been very competitive in all three of his starts and should be a lively danger again. MERLIN DES CHAMPS (4) was a very easy winner at this course earlier this month and can double up. MEJANES (8) continues to improve and has to be considered.

1. GOAL DE LA MORTRIE - Unreliable and was 12th in a Class F Mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 13 May. Capable of better and is not out of it

2. HERCULE DU LEVANT - Has struggled this year and was 9th in a Class E Mounted race at Cavaillon over 2600m on * April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

3. HATHAWAY - Probably needed his only run of the year when tenth in a Class G Mounted race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 7 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

4. INVERSION JULRY - On a very long losing run but was runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 16 May. Be right there at the finish once again

5. GIPSY THORIS - Did not show his best when tenth in a Class f harness race at Moulins over 2600m on 18 May. Did better under the saddle before that and has a place chance

6. FIRST DU MILAN - Returned to form and was fourth in a Class C Mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 30 April. Consistent under the saddle and has a place chance

7. HANA D'OCCAGNES - Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 16 May. Can contest the finish this distance

8. HERMOSO - On a long losing run and was 8th in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Could earn some money trying a Mounted race

Summary: IRST DU MILAN (6) is very consistent under the saddle and is barefoot so ready to contest the finish yet again. HANA D'OCCAGNES (7) is not reliable but is quite capable of getting involved with the finish when in the mood. INVERSION JULRY (4) is very consistent and threatening to win a race but has yet to win under the saddle. GOAL DE LA MORTRIE (1) has struggled of late but is capable of an upset.

1. GEORGIO LE FOL - Unreliable again this year and was 12th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Capable of contesting the finish on best form

2. HURRICANE FRANCE - On a very long losing run and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 16 May. Capable of contesting the finish

3. FOREVER STONE - Unreliable but did not run badly when 5th in Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 7 May. Has a winning chance in this line-up

4. FORMIDABLE VOYAGE - Disappointing form this year and was 8th in Class E over this track and trip on 10 May. Capable of an upset on best form

5. GORLANDO LUDOIS - Has struggled this year and was 9th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

6. HAPPY D'AIMTE - Unreliable and was 7th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 March. Capable of bouncing back to score

7. GRAINE D'URZY - Has only been modest this year and was 9th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 18 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: HAPPY D'AIMTE (6) has struggled of late but has an excellent record in this division so gets the vote to take out this lucky last race. HURRICANE FRANCE (2) has not won for some time but does have a winning chance in this line-up. GEORGIO LE FOL (1) is unreliable but a threat to these rivals. FORMIDABLE VOYAGE (4) did better last year and could surprise.
