

# MONDAY, 28/08/23

## R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX ANDRE CHOISSELET - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class E - Mounted -  
EUR € 35.000**

- 1. KINGALO DU CHENE** - Showed improvement when fourth in a Mounted race last time out. Steps up in distance and is not out of it
- 2. KILT** - Much improved when runner-up in a Mounted race last time out. That was his first Mounted race and he can go one better
- 3. KARMEL JOYEUX** - Improving and was not disgraced when third in his last two starts. Capable of contesting the finish once again
- 4. KAPITANO VALOU** - Disqualified on his debut but did a lot better when third in his second start. Smarter now and could contest the finish once again
- 5. KARMA JIEL** - Showed improvement when winning a Mounted race in June but has been disqualified twice since then. Capable of an upset if smart
- 6. KRAC DE GUIBRAY** - Disqualified in five of his nine starts. Can run well when smart but is hard to trust so others are preferred
- 7. KAMAY DES CORONS** - Very unreliable and has also been disqualified once but is capable of earning some money when smart
- 8. KHEOPS DE FREDLAU** - Yet to win a race but has been runner-up twice so far in eight starts. First time in a Mounted race but has a winning chance
- 9. KENZO VEETA** - Fit and has run well in four of his Mounted race. Capable of fighting out the finish once again and has a winning chance
- 10. KOKO MARBOULA** - Holding form with three fourth-place finishes at this course. Likely to contest the finish once again
- 11. KYO FERFAY** - Won a Mounted race in June but has struggled in three starts since with two of them being disqualifications. Can win if smart

**Summary** : A tough opening race and anything can win it. KILT (2) showed massive improvement when runner-up in his only Mounted race so far but will need to confirm that run. KHEOPS DE FREDLAU (8) has been runner-up twice in harness races and can win trying a Mounted race for the first time. KINGALO DU CHENE (1) was not disgraced when fourth last time out but is stepping up in distance. KOKO MARBOULA (10) is holding form and can contest the finish.

**C2 - PRIX DES BRUYERES - 2175m (a1 5/16m) - Class C - Harness - EUR €  
38.000**

**1. LE SENS DE PADD** - A two-year-old colt by Gu d'Héripéré out of Flora de Padd who is making his debut. Can win

**2. LIGNERY** - A two-year-old colt by Ready Cash out of Amy Ligneriers who is making his debut. Can win

**3. LUDIVER DES VAUX** - Fair debut when fourth but was disqualified in his second start. Probably best watched for now

**4. LAGNU MAG** - Fair third on debut but was disqualified in his second start. Probably needs to do more to win this race

**5. LOVER DES BROUSSES** - Ran well when third over a similar distance earlier this month and looks likely to contest the finish

**6. LANCELOT PLATANES** - Did all that was asked of him when winning on debut earlier this month. This looks a tougher task but deserves some respect

**7. LUCKY EVER** - Won well over a similar distance on debut earlier this month. Tackles stronger but can contest the finish

**8. LITTLE BROWN** - Looked good when winning on debut over a similar distance earlier this month. Can follow up

**9. LIVRE BLANC** - Showed promise when runner up over a similar distance earlier this month and can fight out the finish once again

**10. L'AMERICAIN** - Fit and showed improvement when winning on his third try. This is tougher and he may need to find a few lengthsh to win this race

**11. LARGO DE CASTELLE** - Ran well when runner-up on debut over a similar distance earlier month. This looks a tougher ask. Might place

**Summary** : Another tough race. LITTLE BROWN (8) could be the best of them as he did look good when winning on debut and he can double up. LIGNERY (2) amkes his debut but he could be a threat. LIVRE BLANC (9) showed promise when runner-up on debut and could have more to offer. LOVER DES BROUSSES (5) ran well when third last time out and could contest the finish once again.

**C3 - PRIX DE TOULON - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class D - Mounted - EUR €  
40.000**

- 1. JOJO DE L'AUNAY** - Remains barefoot. Both wins were last year but was a fair fourth and is always capable of earning some more money
- 2. JOS DU JAL** - Disappointing last run but did run well when barefoot the last two times and is barefoot again. Place chance
- 3. JAFF DE MESLAY** - Remains barefoot. Kept to harness races this year. Better in Mounted race and is capable of winning
- 4. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE** - Remains barefoot. Has his disqualification issues but is talented when smart and gets a narrow vote to score
- 5. JOULE DE LA FYE** - Kept to harness races this year and has been disappointing, Better in Mounted race and could be the surprise package of the race
- 6. JAGUAR DE VILLETOT** - Remains barefoot. Was disqualified in penultimate start but has been running well at this course this year and has a winning chance
- 7. JOAO DE VANDEL** - Remains barefoot. Not disgraced when fifth in a Mounted race last time out but will need to do more than that to win this race
- 8. JOCKEY** - Kept to harness races so far and has won three times. Runs well with this shoeing arrangement and can win on Mounted race debut
- 9. JUPITER** - Only modest of late but was fourth in a Mounted race last year and is fit and ready to shine

**Summary :** JAZZ PETTEVINIERE (4) is talented but is also hard to trust but does look the one to beat provided he is smart. JUPITER (9) was fourth in a good Mounted race last year and is capable of winning if returning to that level of form. JOCKEY (8) tries a Mounted race for the first time and has won three harness races so does deserve respect. JAFF DE MESLAY (3) has been kept to harness races this year and is better in Mounted races so deserves respect.

**C4 - PRIX DE DIJON - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Autostart - Class D - Harness -  
EUR € 46.000**

- 1. HASHTAG CHAMANT** - Remains barefoot. More lethal over much further but was not disgraced when fourth in his penultimate start. Place chance
- 2. HOCO MESLOIS** - Versatile distance -wise but is at very best over further. Capable of earning some minor money
- 3. HENZO DE MOUTIERS** - Remains barefoot. only modest form of late and last win was a claimer over this course and distance. Might place
- 4. HAMILTON DU HAM** - Fit and in good form with two wins in the last three starts including over a similar distance. Has a winning chance
- 5. HAPPY DE LA COTE** - Ignore his last start disqualification. Ran well when fifth in his penultimate start and is better this shorter distance. Has a winning chance
- 6. HOTEL MYSTIC** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing last two runs but has done better at this course and is capable of bouncing back to score
- 7. HASHTAG DUB'S** - Versatile distance-wise and did win with this shoeing arrangement last time out. Can follow up this shorter distance
- 8. HAIKIDO** - In fair form of late but last win was over much further and others are preferred this time
- 9. HIROSS** - Remains barefoot. Fit and has been consistent of late but has only been fair at this course in the past. Place chance
- 10. HORTINO** - Remains barefoot. Has run well over the shorter distances and he could pick up some minor money
- 11. HAXOS DE DIGEON** - Fair fifth over a similar distance last time out. Unreliable and has run well over this course and distance before. Might place

**Summary** : HAPPY DE LA COTE (5) ran well when fifth in his penultimate start and has a winning chance this shorter distance. HASHTAG DUB'S (7) won well with this shoeing arrangement last time out and can follow up. HOTEL MYSTIC (6) likes this course and is capable of scoring. HAMILTON DU HAM (4) is in good form and should be right there at the finish once again.

**C5 - PRIX DE JUSSEY - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
40.000**

- 1. JOOST D'OLERON** - Disappointing record at this course but has ability and was not disgraced when third last time out. Can upset
- 2. JE REVE DU BOIS** - Disqualified the last two times he was seen at this course but has been very consistent since then and is clearly not out of it
- 3. JO LIGNERIES** - On a long losing streak since only win and has been unreliable at this course. Capable of playing a minor role
- 4. JAGUAR DU LOISIR** - Remains barefoot. Both wins were last year but has fair form of late. Capable of finishing in the money
- 5. JAMAIS** - Disappointing last run at this course when ninth but is clearly better than that run would suggest and has won at this course. Can upset
- 6. JUSTE UN DALY** - Has yet to win at this course but is distance suited and ran well when third last time out. Not out of it
- 7. JOUR DE GLOIRE** - Mostly modest form since winning only race in February. Needs to do more to win but might sneak a minor place
- 8. JACK SURPRISE** - In good form and is at home over this course and distance. Would not be a surprise winner of this race
- 9. JIBI DU FRUITIER** - Disappointing form at this track but is in good form at present and is barefoot and ready to shine
- 10. JOYAU DE MORTREE** - Remains barefoot. Mostly disappointing this year and his last win was a claimer last year. Others are preferred
- 11. JACK L'EVENREUR** - Returned to form with a claiming win last time out. Likes this shoeing arrangement but this is a tougher ask
- 12. JAZZY FLIGNY** - A bit of a disappointment this year but ran well when runner-up last time out and is barefoot this time. Has a winning chance
- 13. JONAGOLD** - Disqualified when last seen at this course but returned to form with a nice run last time out and is just as good this distance. Can go one better
- 14. JO DU DON** - Has been disappointing at this course of late but is good form at the moment and has a winning chance
- 15. JAD DE CALIX** - Unreliable and both wins were in Mounted races. Disqualified when last seen in a harness race and others are preferred
- 16. JOCKSTRAP** - Disappointing last two starts after winning over the shorter distance. Has won over this type of distance but seems to prefer the shorter distance these days. Place chance

**Summary :** JONAGOLD (13) ran well over this shorter distance last time out and is just as good this distance but needs to prove himself at this course and it is a very open looking race. JACK SURPRISE (8) is in good form and is comfortable over this course and distance so should be right there at the finish once again. JO DU DON (14) is in good form but has a disappointing record at this course. JE REVE DU BOIS (2) has been disqualified in last two attempts at this course but is also not out of it.

**C6 - PRIX DE MORTAIN - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
59.000**

**1. HANNIBAL TUILERIE** - Fit and in good form of late. Barefoot this time and did win over this course and distance last year. Has a winning chance

**2. HOLD UP RANAIS** - Remains barefoot. Usually gives of his best and has not been disgraced when fifth in last two starts but may need to do more to win this race. Might play a minor role

**3. FALCON JET** - Remains barefoot. Much improved of late and is hat-trick seeking after two nice wins. Deserves respect in this line-up

**4. FUYARD DE BALLON** - On a very long losing streak. Well beaten in last two starts and could be better in Mounted races. Others are preferred

**5. HARRY DE SASSY** - Has only been beaten once in last six starts but has to prove himself at this course. Clearly not out of it

**6. GIVE ME** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing last two runs but is versatile distance-wise and runs well at this course. Has a winning chance

**7. GAZOLINE DU SEUX** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing of late and was disqualified last time out. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money if smart

**8. GRANDE DE RANCHY** - Remains barefoot. Only modest form of late and is on a long losing streak. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**9. FETICHE ATOUT** - Knocking hard on the door with some good runner-up runs but was only seventh over this course and distance in April. Place chance

**10. GAMIN DES PERDRIX** - Remains barefoot. Good last win over this distance and did win over this track and trip earlier this year. Go close

**11. GOLD DAIRPET** - Remains barefoot. Fit and has been in very good form of late with three wins in a row. Has also been very effective at this course. Big chance

**Summary** : GOLD DAIRPET (11) has completed a hat-trick and there is no real reason to suggest another win is not forthcoming. GAMIN DES PERDRIX (10) won well over this distance last time out and should be a threat. HANNIBAL TUILERIE (1) is fit, barefoot and in good form and is clearly not out of it. HARRY DE SASSY (5) has won five of his last six starts but has to prove himself at this course.

**C7 - PRIX D'ANTIBES - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class A - Harness - EUR €  
62.000**

1. **KEEN WINNER** - Disappointing last run when eighth. A bit unreliable and is capable of better but others are preferred
2. **KIF DU BIEF** - Very consistent so far and is coming off a nice win. Good last win and is capable of contesting the finish
3. **KELLE BEAUTE** - Unreliable and has been disqualified three times in six starts. Won her other three starts so clearly can win this if smart
4. **KIRA BO FACE** - Has made vast improvement of late and won well last time out. This is a tougher ask but she can earn some minor money
5. **KENO PETTEVINIERE** - Won twice last year and is knocking hard on the door this year. Should be right there at the finish once again
6. **KEYBOARD** - Won on debut and his latest start but was only fair inbetween the wins and has to prove himself at this course. Might place
7. **KANCALAIS** - Disappointing last two starts. All three wins were over a shorter distance. Probably best watched this time
8. **KYOTO DIGEO** - Disappointing record at this course and was only seventh last time out. Capable of better and could contest the finish
9. **KOTKIE** - Has disqualification issues and both her wins were over the shorter distance. Others are preferred
10. **KEPI DU HOME** - Disappointing form of late and only win was last year. Has won at this course but is probably best watched this time
11. **KANAWA** - Both wins were last year and she may have needed both her runs this year. Fitter now and could be the surprise package of the race
12. **KILLER QUEEN** - Holding her form and is distance suited. Tougher ask this time but she can contest the finish
13. **KUNG FU QUICK** - Not disgraced when fifth last time out. May be at very best over a bit shorter but can win over this distance
14. **KASSIDY KID** - Fit and has been very consistent this year. Ran well when fourth at this course in April and has a winning chance

**Summary** : KUNG FU QUICK (13) may be at very best over a bit shorter but does have a winning chance in a very competitive-looking race. KYOTO DIGEO (8) has ability but has to prove himself at this. He has a winning chance. KASSIDY KID (14) has been consistent all year and is proven at this course so should contest the finish yet again. KENO PETTEVINIERE (5) is knocking at the door and is clearly not out of it.

## C8 - PRIX DE BARBIZON - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Autostart - Class D - Harness - EUR € 46.000

- 1. INDOCILE** - Versatile distance-wise and has won his last four starts including over this distance. Barefoot and can stretch that streak to five in a row
- 2. INVICTUS DE HOERDT** - Returned to form with a nice win and he has won a couple of races at this course but is at very best over further. Might place
- 3. INDICE DU CAIEU** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing last three runs and has been unreliable over the shorter distance. Might place
- 4. IGOR VICKING** - Remains barefoot. Effective over the short distances but is also unreliable and is coming off a disqualification. Hard to trust but can upset
- 5. ILLUSION D'AMOUR** - Remains barefoot. Unreliable and is better over further but she is also capable of earning some money this distance
- 6. ICELANDER** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing since winning in May and is better over a longer distance. Others are preferred
- 7. IZIO DU POMMEREUX** - Likes this course and is quite capable of winning but has been disqualified in his last two starts and is hard to trust
- 8. IMPACT DES BAUX** - Has some disqualification issues and has to prove himself at this course but he does have talent and is not out of it if smart
- 9. INDIEN DE FONTAINE** - Fair form of late with this shoeing arrangement but is probably better over further and has yet to win this year. Might place
- 10. IDEAL DE CASTELLE** - Disappointing and unreliable since winning over this course and distance in February. Capable of winning but is best watched for now
- 11. IRON SPIRIT** - On a very long losing streak and has been very unreliable. Capable of earning some money but others are preferred
- 12. IDEFIX DHELPA** - On a very long losing streak and has been moderate for some time now. Barefoot and can improve but others are preferred
- 13. ICARE DE LA DORETE** - Remains barefoot. On a very long losing run and has been struggling this year. Needs major improvement to win
- 14. IN LOVE DE JIEL** - At the top of his game with three good wins in a row. Likes this shoeing arrangement and is capable of winning over this distance. Go close

**Summary :** IN LOVE DE JIEL (14) has struck form well and is on a spree of three and looks the one to be with in the lucky last race. INDOCILE (1) has won his last four starts and will not go down without a fight so it should get interesting. IGOR VICKING (4) is probably more effective over the shorter distances these days but is not out of it. IMPACT DES BAUX (8) is talented but has disqualification issues.

IN LOVE DE JIEL (14) - INDOCILE (1) - IGOR VICKING (4) - IMPACT DES BAUX (8)
