R4 CHATELAILLON [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX LMB DISTRIBUTION BOISSONS - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F -
Harness - EUR € 17,500**

- 1. NEMESIS DU METZ** - Disqualified in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Capable of playing a minor role when smart
- 2. NORDIK** - A runner-up on debut, in class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Should go one better this time
- 3. NINJA D'AIMTE** - Not reliable and was 5th in class E at Reims over 2550m on 23 November. Returns from a break and could make the frame if fit enough
- 4. NIKITA WOOD** - Showed promise when a runner-up in class F on debut, at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Can fight out the finish once again
- 5. NESSICA PLANCHETTE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Caen over 2450m on 25 March. Not easy to trust and needs improvement to score
- 6. NORIGANO** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class F at Caen over 2450m on 16 March. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 7. NOUVELLE DU JOUR** - Finished 7th in class G at Fougères over 3225m on 22 March. Has room to improve but others are preferred
- 8. NEYMAR DU POTO** - A three-year-old colt by Gatsby Perrine out of Vickire des Apres who is making his debut. His Dam won 2 of her 48 starts. Could need this run
- 9. NINAMYS** - A three-year-old filly by Dollar Macker out of Thyamis who is making her debut. Her mother won 3 of her 39 starts. Could need this experience
- 10. NARCUS DE PLAY** - Disqualified in class F at Cordemais over 2150m on 23 November. Has a good qualifying time and can be a threat if smart

Summary: NORDIK (2) ran a cracker on debut. That looks the best form on offer in this opening event and he is a confident pick to score. NINJA D'AIMTE (3) also only found one better on debut and can be a threat once again. NARCUS DE PLAY (10) fluffed his lines with a disqualification, but it may be worth remembering that he qualified in a good time and is capable of being a threat when smart. NINJA D'AIMTE (3) returns from a break but could make the frame.

C2 - PRIX DES FOOD TRUCKS SUR L'HIPPODROME - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MOONLIGHT GABY** - Finished 6th on debut in class G at Chartres over 2800m on 16 November. Capable of improvement but could need this run returning from a break
- 2. MONTH DE BEAUM** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. MEDAILLER DE BOMO** - Needed the last run when 11th in Class H at Saumur over 2700m on 8 March. Capable of being a threat on best form
- 4. MAGIC DU VALLON** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Has won with this shoeing and could cause an upset
- 5. MAGIC D'AIMTE** - Finished 7th in class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 24 July. Victorious in March last year and can be a threat barefoot for the first time
- 6. MILLESIME D'ARZAL** - Returned to form and was 3rd in class F at Chartres over 2800m on 15 March. Victorious back in December, can make the frame
- 7. MAHORA D'OURVILLE** - Finished 6th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 September. Not reliable but is capable of being a threat to these rivals if fit enough
- 8. MONA SAUTONNE** - Victorious in Class F at Laval over 2650m on 5 March. Remains barefoot and can double up if in the same mood
- 9. MAESTRO DE FORGAN** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 12 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. MAGISTER** - Finished 3rd in class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Has shown improvement and remains barefoot so should contest the finish

Summary: MONA SAUTONNE (8) showed what she is capable of when a barefoot winner at Laval. She may well follow up as she remains racing without shoes. MAGISTER (10) showed some improvement at Lisieux and could be more of a threat to these rivals. MAGIC D'AIMTE (5) returns from a lengthy break but is barefoot for the first time, so must be respected. MAHORA D'OURVILLE (7) is also a threat returning from a break.

C3 - PRIX DE L'ECURIE DES REFORMES - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. LEONIE DE L'ECLAIR** - Finished 9th in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 7 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 2. LUBIE DE CELINIÈRE** - Returned to form when 3rd in a Class F at Saumur over 2700m on 8 March. Has disqualification issues but does have claims in this line-up
- 3. LIVIE DU BOUILLON** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class F at Chartres over 3300m on 15 March. Consistent before that and is clearly not out of it
- 4. LADY DE BOUÈRE** - Successful in a Class F at Saumur over 2700m on 8 March. Remains in good form and is capable of following up
- 5. LIBRE SAUTONNE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Capable of contesting the finish
- 6. LINEA DE L'ALBA** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Capable of bouncing back to score
- 7. LIA DE LA MORTRIE** - Did not show her best when 12th in a Class F at Chartres over 3300m on 15 March. Better this distance and can be a threat
- 8. LUCKY LADY D'AMOUR** - Not reliable but finished 4th in a Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 22 March. Might earn some minor money
- 9. LIBERTE CERISE** - Successful in a Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 22 February when barefoot. Not this time but can earn some money
- 10. LEZIRA SPORT** - Victorious in a Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 4 January. Unreliable but is capable of doubling up
- 11. LUTINE DU CEDRE** - Disqualified at Vire on 18 March. Very hard to trust and needs major improvement to win this race so others are preferred

Summary: LUBIE DE CELINIÈRE (2) is not easy to trust as she does come with plenty of disqualification issues. Her last run did hint that she may be ready for a winning turn. LIBRE SAUTONNE (5) is unreliable but is also quite capable of winning a race in this division. LADY DE BOUÈRE (4) remains in good form and it would not be a surprise were she to follow up on a recent success. LIVIE DU BOUILLON (3) was consistent before her most recent run and is also capable of scoring.

C4 - PRIX CARREFOUR ANGOULINS - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. LIZAO DU GUESCLIN** - Victorious in his last two starts, the latest a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 15 March when barefoot. Can complete a hat-trick
- 2. LET'S GO VAL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 15 March. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 3. L'ETONNANT TONIC** - Not reliable but was runner-up in class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Has shown improvement and can make the frame
- 4. LOUZAC** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, including in class E at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. LOUSTIC DE DALINE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 January. Can go one place better
- 6. LITCHI CASTELETS** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class D at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. Should contest the finish once again
- 7. LYNX GRIFF** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in class F at Saumur over 2700m on 8 March. Hard to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 8. L'ARCHANGE** - Victorious in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Continues to impress, keeps the same shoeing and can score again
- 9. L'AS DU PERCHE** - Disqualified in class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. In poor form and needs to improve. Best left out
- 10. LORD DOMINIK** - Finished 11th in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 December. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 11. LEWIS D'ESPOIR** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

Summary: L'ARCHANGE (8) has won four of his five starts. He returned from a break in good style and may well keep his winning run going. LITCHI CASTELETS (6) is consistent and looks likely to contest the finish once again. LOUSTIC DE DALINE (5) is threatening another victory and will not go down easily. LIZAO DU GUESCLIN (1) has struck form with some good wins, but his hat-trick task is not an easy one.

C5 - PRIX RACE AND CARE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KERBEROS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Saumur over 3250m on 8 March. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 2. KANTONIN DU GUIVON** - Disqualified at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of popping up in a place when smart
- 3. KOMIFO** - Off form this year and finished 8th in a Class F at Saumur over 3250m on 8 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. KAMELINE** - Has needed both runs this year and finished 6th in a Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Could be the surprise package of this race
- 5. KESSOY GALBE** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at Castillonnes on 8 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. KANDJAR RANAIS** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class E at Maure-de- Bretagne over 2850m on 8 February. Remains barefoot but has yet to win a race
- 7. KARTOON DU FER** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 23 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. KALONEK JEWEL** - Returned from a break and finished 5th in a Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Fitter this time and should be a threat to these rivals
- 9. KEVINA DE VITRAY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class F at Nantes over 3000m on 26 October. Has disqualification issues and could need this run returning from a break
- 10. KEEPER BAY** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 November. Returns from a break and could make the frame if fit enough
- 11. KEIGHT BLESS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 10th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Does better when barefoot and is capable of striking
- 12. KLYDE GALAA** - Not reliable but was barefoot when 5th in a Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 December. Remains barefoot and is not out of it if fit enough from a break
- 13. KRISTALE TONIC** - Disqualified at Toulouse on 20 March. Has disqualification issues and needs major improvement to score
- 14. KINGDOM DE CHENU** - Returned from a break and finished 8th in a Class D at Laval over 2850m on 5 March. Fitter this time and has a place chance
- 15. KLOE DU ROUEZO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 22 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when smart
- 16. KORTX** - Successful in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 November. Did win three times last year but should need this run returning from a break
- 17. KAROLINA DI SEMBLE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Can earn some money

SUNDAY, 29/03/26

Summary: KEIGHT BLESS (11) has struggled of late but has done well when barefoot and can score for Eric Raffin. It is a very open-looking race, though. KALONEK JEWEL (8) is fitter after a comeback run and can do a lot better this time around. KEEPER BAY (10) returns from a break but can get involved with the finish if fit enough. KLOE DU ROUEZO (15) has had some faults of late but is another that can be a danger if staying in stride.

C6 - PRIX DU CASINO JOA DE CHATELAILLON - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JOE LE VEINARD** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 8 February. Might play a minor role
- 2. INOPINE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 3. JERO DE PHYT'S** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class F at Pontchateau over 2800m on 6 March. Barefoot and capable of striking a victory
- 4. JOLLITY GABY** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 5 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 5. IDEAL DE REVAT** - Returned from a break and finished 3rd in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 14 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. ISIS DU CORTA** - Only moderate this year and finished 8th in a Class F at Angers over 3125m on 28 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. INVINCIBLE BOURBON** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. Consistent before that and can earn more money
- 8. JETPACK** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Better judged on a good penultimate start and can score
- 9. INKY PERRINE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Laval on 11 March. Very hard to trust but can surprise when staying in stride
- 10. HANACK DE VIVOIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Le Croise-Laroche on 8 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. INVICTUS DE NILREM** - Fit and in good form. Finished 4th in a Class E at Caen over 2200m on 9 March. Should contest the finish once again
- 12. JOLI MANNEQUIN** - Very competitive of late and was runner-up in a Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 March. Can be a threat yet again

Summary: JETPACK (8) is unreliable and comes with disqualification issues. That said, he has ability and gets the vote to score in a competitive-looking race. INVICTUS DE NILREM (11) is fit and remains in good form, so is likely to be right there at the finish once again. JOLI MANNEQUIN (12) is in very good shape and holds obvious claims in this line-up. JERO DE PHYT'S (3) races without shoes and can be a lively danger.

C7 - PRIX MUTUALIA ALLIANCE SANTE - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KHALIFE DELALANDE** - A barefoot winner of a Class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 19 February. Remains without shoes and can get involved with the finish
- 2. IRMA DE L'ECLAIR** - Unreliable and finished 13th in a Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 25 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. JALMAROSA** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Needs major improvement to score
- 4. KASH QUICK** - Victorious in a Class D at Angers over 2350m on 15 January. Not reliable but would not be a surprise winner
- 5. KETBERNY** - Successful in a Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Very game and is quite capable of following up
- 6. KING D'HERMES** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. Remains barefoot and has claims at scoring
- 7. KINDY DU VIVIER** - Successful in a Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. In good form and should challenge for top honours again
- 8. KELAS** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Different shoeing this time but is not out of it
- 9. KISS ME JIHEM** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 29 September. Returns from a break and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. KIVAOA DU PERCHE** - Needed the last run when 6th in a Class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 15 March. Capable of earning some money
- 11. INTRIGUE DE VIETTE** - Only modest this year and finished 7th in a Class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 15 March. Needs to do a bit more to score

Summary: A very open lucky last race. KING D'HERMES (6) is in good form and his last run at Vincennes suggest a winning tune is not far away. KETBERNY (5) is usually competitive and can fight out the finish yet again. KASH QUICK (4) is unreliable but his win was last time out was solid enough and he remains a threat in this line-up. KINDY DU VIVIER (7) is another that won well last time out and is capable of doubling up.
