- 2. MADEMOISELLE JOLIE Disqualified last time out at Meral on 6 April. Capable of improvement but others make much more appeal
- **3. MAKE LIFE DE CLECY -** Has struggled in two starts and was 8th in her latest, in Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 17 November. Might need this run returning from a break
- **4. MISS PLEIN CHENE -** Did not show much when tenth on debut in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
