## C1 - PRIX LORELEY - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- **1. ILUX DU CAUX -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 12 December. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- **2. HAPPY DE TOUCHYVON -** Holding form and finished fourth last time out in Class F at Cordemais over 2650m on 20 April. Can be competitive again
- **3. HARPIE DE JED -** Disappointing form this year and was 9th in Class F at Cordemais over 2650m on 20 April. Did better last year and is capable of playing a minor role
- **4. HESPERANCE ELTE -** Disqualified last time out at Ecommoy on 20 April. Has struggled of late and needs major improvment to win
- **5. IBRAHIM DU RIB -** Only modest of late and was 9th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Capable of better and could make the frame
- **6. JAZZ D'OURVILLE -** Needed his only run of the year and was 9th in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 21 April. Fitter this time and is not out of it
- **7. GENIALISSIME -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in Class D at Cherbours over 2625m on 6 April. Has a winning chance
- **8. FRONSAC DE BOMO -** Unreliable and was 11th in Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 17 October. Returns from a break but could earn some money
- **9. JAVA DU CHERISAY -** Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D Mounted race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 16 April. Just as good this distance and should fight out the finish
- **10. HARMONIE JO -** Did not show her best when 7th in Class G at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Capable of an upset this course and distance
- **11. GYPSIE MAGIQUE -** Uneliable and was third in Class G at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Can be in the mix of things once again
- **12. HIVAROSA DU BOCAGE -** Unreliable but was third last time out in Class H at Oleans over 3400m on 21 April. Might play a minor role
- **13. IMOKO DU BOUILLON -** Unreliable and was thid last time out in Class F at Tours over 3500m on 13 April. Could sneak into a minor place
- **14. JUST DAYDREAM -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 April. Struggling to find best form and others are preferred

**Summary:** GENIALISSIME (7) was a solid third at Cherbourg earlier this month, and that performance sets the standard for this race. JAVA DU CHERISAY (9) usually gives her best and is well-suited to the distance. She should be right there at the finish. JAZZ D'OURVILLE (6) is unreliable but has run some nice races at this track and has a winning chance. HAPPY DE TOUCHYVON (2) is holding form and could benefit from the drop in distance this time.

## C2 - PRIX LIBUSSA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 62,000

- **1. MAURICIEN -** A winner of his last two starts, with the latest being in Class C at Toulouse over 2750m on 4 April. Can contest the finish
- **2. MORE AND MORE -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up for this third time in a row, in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 19 April. Has a place chance
- **3. MAGIC MAN -** Improving and won his second start in a row when winning in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 18 March. Can complete the hat-trick
- **4. MONTEQUILLO -** Unreliable and was 8th in Class B at this track over 2175m on 12 April. Distanc suited and is capable of earning some minor money
- **5. MARZIPAN -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 12 April. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role when wise
- **6. MAHARAJA ATOUT -** Unbeaten in three starts, with the latest being in Class D at this track over 2850m on 8 April. Can extend winning streak to four
- **7. MAESTRO JAMINI -** Unreliable but was fourth last time out in Class B at this track over 2175m on 12 April. Might play a minor role
- **8. MIX CASH -** A winner of two of his four starts, including last time out in Class B at this track over 2850m on 26 February. Has a winning chance
- **9. MAKE YOUR DAY -** Has only been beaten once in four starts and was victorious last time out in Class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer. Be right there at the finish
- **10. MADE IN PRIMO -** In good shape and was a winner last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 1 April. Not out of it
- **11. MAGICO DE LOU -** Unreliable and was 7th last time out in Class A over this track and trip on 23 February. Yet to win a race and others are preferred

**Summary:** A decent race. MAHARAJA ATOUT (6) remains unbeaten and looked particularly impressive when winning at this track last time out, setting the standard for the race. MAKE YOUR DAY (9) has tasted defeat only once and will challenge for top honours. MAGIC MAN (3) is improving and should be competitive once again. MADE IN PRIMO (10) won over this track and trip on 1 April and has solid claims.

#### C3 - PRIX HENRI CHRETIEN - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 54,000

- **1. JAZZY THOURJAN -** Very consistent and was runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 25 March. Be right there at the finish
- **2. JOKER DE FROULAY -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 18 April. Capable of better and could might play a minor role
- **3. JALISCO FLIGNY -** Has needed both his starts this year and was 11th in Class D at this course over 2100m on 18 April. Barefoot this time and has claims
- **4. JANE AIMEE -** Unreliable but was third last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 April. Can contest the finish
- **5. FIDELIO DU LOISIR -** Has only been modest this year and was 9th last time out in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Others are much preferred
- **6. HELITE ELEVEN -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 April. Clearly unreliable but is always capable of earning some money
- **7. GO GO GIGI -** Battling to regain best form and was 9th in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 31 March. Needs major improvement to win
- **8. HECTOR DE BASSIERE -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 14 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. IN LOVE DE JIEL -** In good form of late and was fourth last time out in a Class D at this course over 2700m on 4 April. Tries a Mounted race and is not out of it
- **10. GENIE DES LUCAS -** Unreliable and was 14th last time out in a claimer at this track over 2850m on 22 April. Capable of earning some money when in the mood
- **11. IVORINO D'ECHAL** In very good form and was runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Angers over 3125m on 2 April. Big chance in this line-up

**Summary:** IVORINO D'ECHAL (11) has been ultra-consistent since switching to the saddle and should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. JANE AIMEE (4) is not the most reliable but ran well when third in this discipline and can contest the finish again. JAZZY THOURJAN (1) finds it hard to win but is very consistent, and a second victory is not far off. JALISCO FLIGNY (3) is fit and barefoot this time, so could be a threat.

## C4 - PRIX VANADIS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- **1. JOYAU DE BELLANDE -** In good form and was victorious last time out in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 20 April. Not barefoot this time but could surprise
- **2. JUEN EMONDEVILLE -** Has disqualification issies but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 13 April. Probably best watched for now
- **3. JOYEUX NONNA -** On a long losing run but was fourth in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 13 April. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **4. JIRENZO -** In good form and was third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 24 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **5. JACK DU CEBE -** Has some fair form of late and as not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Cholet over 2800m on 21 April. Can contest the finish
- **6. JUMBO JACK -** A runner-up of his last three starts, the latest being in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Can go one better this time
- **7. JAGUAR DU LOISIR -** Disqualified last time out at Carpentras on 20 April. On a long losing run but could pop up in a place when in the right mood
- **8. JUST D'ACADIE -** Very unreliable but was a winner last time out in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 21 April. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **9. JASMIN PHIL -** Disqualified last time out at Laval on 24 April. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- **10. JOYAU BLUE -** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 21 March. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **11. JORLANDO -** Very consistent of late and was victoriious last time out in a Class G Mounted race at Rambouillet over 2800m on 20 April. Just as good in harness races and has a winning chance
- **12. JAZZ UP -** Much improved when runner-up in Class F at Tours over 3500m on 13 April. Might play a minor role at best
- **13. JASMIN DHELPA -** Has really struggled this year and was 13th in Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 April. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** JUMBO JACK (6) is knocking hard at the door and is capable of securing a victory at this course and distance. JORLANDO (11) has beaten the selection before and will be a serious rival once again. JACK DU CEBE (5) goes well for Yves Verva and can be in the mix once more. JOYEUX NONNA (3) has not won for some time but is holding form and can contest the finish.

## C5 - PRIX HEVELIUS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. LUTECE D'ELA Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this course and distance on 22 April. Can make the frame
- **2. LADY BIRD JENILAT -** Very unreliable and was 8th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. More if needed to beat these rivals
- **3. LA MITIDJA -** Showed improvement when barefoot and runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 15 April. Not fully barefoot this time but could earn some money
- **4. LUANA SPORT -** Returned from a break in good shape and was third in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 14 April. Clearly not out of it
- **5. LA VIE EST BELLE -** Disqualified last time out at Argentan on 14 April. Hard to trust and others are much preferred in this line-up
- **6. LYRA POTERIE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 6 January. Yet to win a race but is capable of earning some minor money when wise
- **7. LEEDS -** Returned from a break and was fourth in Class B at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 20 April. Fitter this time and has a winning chance
- **8. LESTANCIA BELLA -** A winner of three of her five starts and was runner-up last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 22 April.
- **9. LOVINA PERRINE -** Has disqualification issues but was runner-up last time out in Class D at this track over 2100m on 4 April. Should contest the finish wise
- **10. LILY DE L'AUNAY -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 April. Unreliable of late and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **11. LA LAGOSTERIA -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latets being on 1 April. Not easy to trust but is capable of a playing a minor role when wise
- **12. LIBERTY AVENUE -** Did not show her best when 7th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Capable of doing better but others are preferred

**Summary:** LESTANCIA BELLA (8) was narrowly beaten by one better last time out at this track and is an obvious pick for top honours. LOVINA PERRINE (9) is talented but unreliable, making her a danger to these rivals. LEEDS (7) returned from a break in good form, is barefoot, and looks ready to strike. LUANA SPORT (4) is highly regarded by her connections and came back from a break in decent shape. She should be involved in the finish.

- **2. LOOPING DU PERRE -** Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 March. Has a place chance
- **3. LOUPIOT DE CHENU -** Much improved since trying Mounted races and was Victorious in Clas E at Feurs over 2850m on 7 April. Can follow up
- **4. LITYGE DE CYM -** Yet to win a race but is holding form well and was third in a Class F Mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Should fight out the finish
- **5. LENNON D'ANS -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Reims on 16 April. Probably best watched for now
- **6. LOVE ME DE CERISY -** In good shape and was fourth in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 17 April. Might play a minor role
- **7. LASCAUX DEL PHEDO -** In good form and was third in Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 8 April. Big chance in this line-up
- **8. LOUKOUM DE L'ITON -** Needed his only run of the year and was tenth in Class D at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 23 April. Others are much preferred

LE ROUPIO (1) has disqualification issues but possesses some talent and will be a threat if behaving this time. LENNON D'ANS (5) is still winless but is in good form and can fight for the finish again. LOUPIOT DE CHENU (3) is showing good progress under the saddle and is clearly not out of it.

# C7 - PRIX ALMAK - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- **1. GREAT KILLS -** Only modest of late and was 7th in Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 23 April. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- **2. HOMMAGE DE LARRE -** Has really struggled this year and was 13th in a claimer at this track over 2850m on 22 April. Others are much preferred
- **3. FAIRPLAY FOREVER -** Disappointing last run when 9th in a claimer at this track over 2850m on 22 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **4. HUGO DU BOURG -** Unreliable and was 7th in a claimer at this track over 2850m on 22 April. Needs to do more to win this race
- **5. IF I TELL YOU -** Bounced back with a win in this division over this track and trip on 22 April. Can double up in this line-up
- **6. HASHTAG CHAMANT** Unreliable and finished tenth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 13 April. Did better in his penultimate start and is not out of it
- **7. ENJEU DAIRPET -** Unreliable and was 9th in a claimer over this track and trip on 1 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- **8. GLOSSY BOY -** Needed his only run of the year when unplaced in Class D at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Barefoot this time and could be a real threat
- **9. GOLD D'ECROVILLE -** Finished 12th last time out in Class D at this track over 2850m on 21 March. Capable of an upset in this division
- **10. FINGER DES BORDES -** Finished 13th last time out in Class D at this track over 2850m on 11 April. Capable of a suprise in this division
- **11. FILOU DE LARRE -** Has improved of late and was fourth in this division over this course and distance on 1 April. Should contest the finish
- **12. GREC D'HAVAROCHE -** Only modest form this year and was 7th in Class D at Biguglia over 3475m on 23 March. Capable of better and has a winning chance

**Summary:** IF I TELL YOU (5) was a good winner at this level over this course and distance just recently and can follow up in this line-up. FILOU DE LARRE (11) has improved since dropping down to claimers and will be in the mix for the finish again. GLOSSY BOY (8) has been specifically prepared for this race, and a much-improved performance can be expected. GREC D'HAVAROCHE (12) drops down to a claimer and could be involved in the finish over a distance that suits.

- **2. MAESTRO DE JILME -** Disqualified on his debut at Lyon-Parilly on 20 April. Capable of vast improvement but others are preferred
- **3. MANANT DE LARA -** Disqualified on debut at Elbeuf on 13 Apeil. Capable of improvement but others amke more appeal in this line-up
- **4. MICKEY MICHETTUDE -** Finished third on his debut in a Class F Mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 20 April. Can contest the finish
- **5. MOUNGO -** Disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 20 April. 14 April. Had some fair form before that and is not out of it
- **6. MARIOLE -** Disqualified last time out at Laval on 24 April. Capable of better back under the saddle and can upset
- **7. MAESTRO GRIFF -** Showed improvement when a winner in a Class F Mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 20 April. Can follow up tackling tougher this time
- **8. MERCATO D'OLIVERIE -** Has improved with each run and was victorious last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 6 April. Can double up
- **9. MACK DAIRPET -** Has improved since trying Mounted races and was fourth in Class D at this track over 2200m on 8 April. Can make the frame
- **10. MITCH DE GRANOU -** Much improved last run when runner-up in Class D at this track over 2200m on 8 April, Can go one better this time
- **11. MANIGOD -** Holding form and was third last time out in Class D at this track over 2200m on 8 April. Has a place chance

**Summary:** A tough lucky last with several improving runners. MERCATO D'OLIVERIE (8) gets the pick to score based on his recent improvement, having been a good winner at Saint-Malo. MITCH DE GRANOU (10) looked much improved at this course last time out and can go one better. MAESTRO GRIFF (7) steps up in distance after a solid win at Lyon-Parilly and deserves respect. MOUNGO (5) is another who could shine if on his best behavior this time.
