**C1 - PRIX DE CUMONT - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. KELLE NANA** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over this distance on 12 April. Can go one place better
- 2. KALINA STAR** - Not reliable but was fourth in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over this distance on 12 April. Might play a minor role
- 3. KOQUINE DE RICO** - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over 2150m on 17 October. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 4. KHALEESI DE KACY** - Needed her only run of the year when 12th in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 5. KARIMA DU PARC** - Faulted last time out in a claimer at Toulouse over 2950m on 24 April. Needs major improvement to score
- 6. KENZA CHOISIE** - Has needed both her starts this year, the latest when 8th in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Might play a minor role at best
- 7. JAMAICA VERDERIE** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 19 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. KANDIE DU BASSIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 9. KRISTINA DU CLOS** - Unreliable but was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains without shoes and has a place chance
- 10. KIRKENESSE** - Showed some improvement when third in Class G at Castillonnès over 2450m on 5 April. Might earn some minor money
- 11. JERSEY BLEUE** - Off form and finished 9th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Returns from a short break and could need this run

Summary: Julien Foin holds a decent hand in this opening event with his pair of runners KEYS (17) and JADE GERBEHAYE (16). KEYS (17) has shown improvement of late and gets the vote to score. JADE GERBEHAYE (16) is not as reliable as her stable companion and does have disqualification issues but can follow up on her recent success. JUDIRA DE HOUELLE (13) remains in good shape and can be competitive again. KALINE BEY (12) is unreliable but is also capable of scoring.

- 1. JAMES D'OVAKI** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 19 April. Might play a minor role
- 2. KING GATE** - Has needed both starts this year, the latest when 6th in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 22 March. Needs to do more to score
- 3. JOYAU DE MASSARA** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 5 April. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 4. JEU MYSTIC** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class G at Toulouse over 2950m on 20 March. Did win his penultimate start and is capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 5. KRAC MICHA** - Consistent this year and finished fourth in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Should contest the finish
- 6. KALISTO FALINE** - Disqualified last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Capable of making the frame when smart
- 7. KAOLIK DE GUEZ** - Faulted last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Has major disqualification issues and others are much preferred
- 8. KOALA DU DROPT** - On a long losing run but did not run badly when 5th in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over this distance on 13 April. Could earn some money
- 9. KILLER SUN DRALIAM** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class D at Cholet over 2800m on 6 April. Can do even better this time around
- 10. JEAN DE GIMAT** - Finished fourth in a Class F mounted race at Lannemezan over 2225m on 20 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. KROONER D'ORION** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 8th in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 10 April. Can play a minor role at very best

Summary: JOHN STEED (18) is at his best when barefoot and he has won at this track. His recent form is moderate, but he can bounce back to win a race of this nature. JURA (16) was successful over this track and trip at the beginning of the month and must be respected for that. KILLER SUN DRALIAM (9) put in an improved performance last time out and could have more to offer. KRAC MICHA (5) is consistent and could have that rewarded with a winning turn soon.

- 2. INDOCILE** - Disqualified last time out at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 3. HARIBO DU CARNOIS** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class D at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 April. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. HINDEN** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. Might earn some minor money
- 5. IRON D'ESPOIR** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

- 1. IRON JET** - Unreliable but was barefoot and runner-up in Class A at Toulouse over 2325m on 10 April. Can be competitive once again
- 2. IENA D'ORGERES** - Off form and finished tenth in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. GLAMOUR YOMA** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. HAMIGO** - Unreliable but did finish fourth last time out in Class A at Toulouse over 2325m on 10 April. Has a place chance on best form
- 5. FOX PAPA TANGO** - Has only been moderate this year and was 8th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. More is needed to score
- 6. IDEFIX DE CENTULE** - Probably needed his only run of the year when tenth in Class C at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 April. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race
- 7. HAUTBRION COLMI** - Broke a long losing run with a victory in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Has a much tougher task in this line-up
- 8. HERMES ANGEL** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 April. Can be a threat when in the right frame of mind
- 9. GAUDEPSOU** - Off form this year and was 9th in a Group 3 at Angers over 3100m on 1 April. Has won over this course and distance and is capable of an upset
- 10. GILBERTO** - Returned from a break and finished third in Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 12 April. Fitter this time and could be competitive again
- 11. JAPPELOUP TURGOT** - Showed improvement when third in a Group 3 at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Must be respected for that and can score

- 1. LIANG DU PATURAL** - Has struggled in both starts this year, the latest when 9th in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 12 April. More is needed to score
- 2. LITTLE ATOUT** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. LITTLE DREAM D'ERI** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest over this course and distance on 5 April. Others are preferred
- 4. LA VOICI DU PERCHE** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 5 April. Battling to find best form and makes little appeal
- 5. LUNA BLACK** - Picked up a breakthrough success in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 12 April. Tougher task this time but has a place chance
- 6. L'ETOILE MASCAR** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 10 April. Can get into the mix of things

- 3. MISTER JENILOU** - Very consistent of late and was a barefoot winner last time out in Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 19 April. Can follow up
- 4. MINA DE BASSIERE** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 3 April. Unreliable but can earn some money when smart
- 5. MAESTRO DE JOUDES** - Unreliable and was 8th in a Class F mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 April. Unreliable but might play a minor role

- 2. NAPOULE** - Improving and finished third in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 13 April. Should fight out the finish once again
- 3. NIKE RIVER** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 13 April. Can be a lively danger if staying in stride
- 4. NIMBA LEAGABIN** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 8 March. Can earn some money if smart
- 5. NIKITA DE LAPENCHE** - Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 5 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score

- 2. KIRIKOU DU DROPT** - Victorious last time out in a Class E mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 17 April. Has major disqualification issues but is also capable of doubling up
- 3. KEEPYOURSELFALIVE** - Has struggled in both her starts this year, the latest in a Class G harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Needs to do more under the saddle this time
- 4. KRITERE DE L'ETRE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class E mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 17 April. Might play a minor role
- 5. KONQUERANT** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 6 April. Might play a minor role at very best if staying in stride
