

**C1 - PRIX DU PMU LE CLEMENT - 2550m (a1 9/16m) - National - Class E -
Harness - EUR € 21.000**

1. **KALAMINE** - Bounced back to form when third in latest start. This looks a tougher race but could earn some minor money
2. **KALISTA JIEL** - Not disgraced when fourth last time out. Fitter from that run and could finish in the money
3. **KRECY PONT VAUTIER** - Runner-up earlier this month but has been disqualified in two starts since and probably prefers that shorter distance
4. **KIRA DE CAHOT** - Ran well when runner-up in April but has struggled in her two starts since then and is probably best watched this time
5. **KLARA JACK** - Two promising runs so far. Fair third last time out but has plenty of ground to find on rival KYARA (8) this time
6. **KHADIDJA CASTELETS** - Disappointing three runs since being runner-up at Amiens last month. Needs to do more to win this race
7. **KATE MESLOISE** - Disqualified on debut but has made good progress since and is coming off two runner-up runs. Be right there at the finish
8. **KYARA** - Disqualified on debut but was a wide-margin winner over this course and distance last time out. Big chance of following up
9. **KLASSE DE BRUZEAU** - Unreliable but did run well when third over this course and distance last time out. Should contest the finish once again

Summary : KYARA (8) won well over this course and distance earlier this month. She looks likely to follow up. Danger KLARA JACK (5) was third that day and should at least finish closer to her rival this time. KATE MESLOISE (7) is improving and is coming off two nice runner-up runs. KIRA DE CAHOT (4) ran well when third over this track and trip and is not out of it.

**C2 - PRIX DE SENSAS - 2550m (a1 9/16m) - National - Class F - Harness -
EUR € 18.000**

- 1. JUNIOR DU GADE** - Has really been struggling this year with three disqualifications and a well-beaten effort. Needs major improvement to win this race
- 2. JIVAGO DU CHATELET** - Well tried this year and recent runs have only been modest. Only win so far was over the shorter distance and others are preferred
- 3. JAZZMAN SYGA** - Ignore both disqualifications in Mounted races. Remains barefoot and has looked a promising sort when in the mood. Big chance if at his best
- 4. JACK LONDON** - Remains barefoot but has struggled in three starts at this course including last time out. Is capable of an upset though if finding best form
- 5. JURASSIC** - Has yet to win a race and was only sixth over this track and trip last time out. Could play a minor role
- 6. JALAYA DES BROUETS** - Mostly moderate form this year and seems to have lost her way since only win. Others are much preferred
- 7. JARODE PAULOIS** - Disqualified last time out. Runner-up in penultimate start when first time barefoot and is barefoot again so could finish in the money
- 8. JEZILDA MAUVE** - Won twice in 2022 and has run some fair races over this course and distance but may need this comeback run
- 9. JESSAMINA** - Did well in claimers last year but has done even better this year and was runner-up over this course and distance last time out. Go close
- 10. JAKADY D'EMERAUDE** - Disqualified twice in four starts this year but has won two races including one over this course and distance. Has a winning chance
- 11. JOB DU PERSIL** - May have needed both runs this year. Did a lot better in 2022 and is capable of bouncing back to score

Summary : JAZZMAN SYGA (3) has struggled twice when trying Mounted races but does better in this discipline and could be a bit better than these rivals if showing what he is capable of. JESSAMINA (9) is improving and is looking to go one better on her recent course and distance run. JAKADY D'EMERAUDE (10) has been in good form and is a course and distance winner. JACK LONDON (4) needs to show us that he can run at this track as he has struggled here in the past.

9/16m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 21.000**

- 1. IN MY HEART** - Very experienced in this discipline and has yet to win a race. Fifth when barefoot last time out and needs to do more to win
- 2. JACKSON DU CLOS** - Remains barefoot and is in good form with some nice performances at Caen recently. Could be the one to beat in this line-up
- 3. JAZZ DU GOUTIER** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing runs of late at Vincennes when barefoot. Should do better at this course and has a winning chance
- 4. IDOLE DE CALENDES** - Remains barefoot. Much improved last run when third and has at least won a Mounted race. Might place
- 5. INFAILLIBLE** - Disappointing form of late with two recent disqualifications but has won three Mounted races and is not out of it
- 6. JERK DE PLANCHETTE** - Seems to have lost his way in last four starts. Did well at start of career and has a winning chance if bouncing back to that form
- 7. JUSQUIAME** - Remains barefoot. Has yet to win a Mounted race and has been a bit disappointing of late but could run well in this small field

Summary : JACKSON DU CLOS (2) has been in good form of late and is clearly the one to beat in this line-up. JAZZ DU GOUTIER (3) is better than the recent form suggests and could be a threat on best form. JUSQUIAME (7) has been disappointing of late but could run well in a weak race. JERK DE PLANCHETTE (6) can be a big danger if returning to his best form of 2022 and the last two runs are best ignored.

**C4 - PX BOWLING PLAZA,MEGAZONE,TRAMPOLINEPARK - 2550m (a1
9/16m) - National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24.000**

- 1. IL DIABLO STAR** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth over this track and trip last time out but is not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- 2. ISALIO JIDO** - Much improved last run when runner-up. Has also won over this course and distance so could be the surprise package of the race
- 3. ILOA DES CHARRONS** - Fit and in the form of her life. Probably prefers it further than this but could finish in the money
- 4. IPSOS DE SIMM** - Showed some improvement when fifth last time out but is on a long losing streak since only win and others are preferred
- 5. ITEM BUISSONAY** - Remains barefoot, Has yet to win after 29 starts but did run well when third last time out and could earn some more money
- 6. IDUNN** - Well tried this year and did win a race in April but has disappointed in two starts since then. Could like that shorter distance
- 7. IRELAND TEAM** - On a long losing streak since last win but did better when third last time out when barefoot and remains barefoot. Has a winning chance
- 8. IRMA BABEL** - Unreliable and has yet to win after 42 starts but did run well when runner-up in penultimate start to have a chance at cracking this race
- 9. IN AMERICA** - Well tried this year and has already won twice. In good form of late and should fight out the finish once again
- 10. INDYDARCHE** - Remains barefoot. On a long losing streak since only win but has run some fair races of late and is clearly in with a chance
- 11. ISPAHAN TEAM** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing recent runs but has won at this course and is capable of bouncing back to cause an upset

Summary : Not too many can be ruled out of winning this open race. IRELAND TEAM (7) could be returning to her best and was a decent third last time out. IRMA BABEL (8) has yet to taste winning success but would not be a surprise winner in this line-up. INDYDARCHE (10) has been doing well of late and is not out of it. IN AMERICA (9) is in good form this year and should contest the finish.

**C5 - PRIX ABELE 1757 - 2550m (a1 9/16m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €
27.000**

- 1. HOLD UP NOCTURNE** - Remains barefoot. Fit but has two disqualifications in last four starts and has yet to win a Mounted race. Might place
- 2. FUTEE DES WAIRIES** - Disappointing in three starts this year. Barefoot this time and could improve. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 3. GENERAL** - Fit but has been well tried this year with not much success. On a very long losing streak and others are preferred
- 4. GLOIRE JOYEUSE** - Modest last two runs. Has run her best races when barefoot and is not barefoot for this. Capable of earning minor money though
- 5. HILTON MAZA** - Remains barefoot. Unreliable has been a disappointment this year. Capable of winning though if in the mood and deserves respect
- 6. FALKIR BUIZARDERIE** - Remains barefoot. Right back to his best with two nice wins recently. Has every chance of completing the hat-trick in this small field
- 7. HISPANIEN** - Remains barefoot. Disqualified in only start of 2022. Returns from a lengthy break but cannot be written off if he finds his best form

Summary : A small field but an interesting race. FALKIR BUIZARDERIE (6) is in top form and can complete a hat-trick where recent form is thin in the book for his rivals. HILTON MAZA (5) has been disappointing this year but is not out of it. HISPANIEN (7) returns from a lengthy break but has tackled the best of his generation before and would not be a surprise winner. HOLD UP NOCTURNE (1) is fit but has not won a Mounted race.

**C6 - PRIX BOODER "LE GRAND CIRQUE" - 2550m (a1 9/16m) - National -
Class E - Harness - EUR € 21.000**

- 1. KOKTAIL LANDEMER** - Disqualified on debut earlier this month. Likely to be smarter this time but is best watched for now
- 2. KSAR DU CORTA** - Disqualified on debut but did much better when fifth at Amiens last time out. More improvement likely and deserves some respect
- 3. KENOR DESBOIS** - Third on debut earlier this month. Likely to be smarter this time and is ready to fight out the finish
- 4. KILLER DE BEAULIEU** - Disqualified on debut but bounced back to win his next start. This could be a tougher race for him but he deserves respect for that win
- 5. KLUEDO DE L'AVRE** - Modest first three runs but did show improvement when dropped in distance in last two starts. Place chance in this longer distance
- 6. KIGALI** - Fit and has been in fair form of late. Drop in distance not likely to suit but is also not out of it
- 7. KRAKEN CASTELETS** - Improving and is fit and ready for this race. Not disgraced when fourth last time out and is likely to do a lot better this time
- 8. KRONOS JIEL** - Won over this course and distance in penultimate start and was not disgraced when fourth last time out. Has a winning chance

Summary : KRAKEN CASTELETS (7) is fit and improving and should have no problems with this track. He is the one to beat. KENOR DESBOIS (3) ran well when third on debut and is likely to be sharper this time. KSAR DU CORTA (2) showed improvement when fifth last time out and is likely to improve further this time. KRONOS JIEL (8) is a winner over this track and track and deserves respect.

**C7 - PRIX DES PARTENAIRES : ZODIO, CULTURA - 2550m (a1 9/16m) -
Class E - Harness - EUR € 24.000**

- 1. HASHTAG DU LION** - On a very long losing streak and has been well tried this year with mostly moderate runs. Others are preferred
- 2. HOT SHOT** - Improving of late and broke a long losing streak to win latest start. Tougher task this time but is not out of it
- 3. HELMA D'OCQUE** - On a very long losing streak since only win but has been barefoot and in fair form of late. Has a winning chance
- 4. HOOK DE BEAULIEU** - Well tried in 2022 without adding to win tally. Disqualified in last start of 2022 and is likely to need this run returning from a break
- 5. HARIETTE DE LIZMAR** - She has regressed since fourth in first run of this year. Struggling at the moment and is best watched for now
- 6. HARMONIOUS** - Very consistent this year and is coming off his best win to date. He looks the one they all have to beat
- 7. HUGOLINO** - Remains barefoot. Improved last run when fourth. More needed to win this race but could play a minor role
- 8. HARIBO PAJE** - Modest last two runs and has been best when barefoot and is not barefoot this time. Others are preferred
- 9. HIBISCUS NORMAND** - On a very long losing streak but is fit and did show improvement when sixth last time out and is barefoot this time. Might place
- 10. HENJOY DE MONGOCHY** - Remains barefoot. Disqualified in both starts this year but is capable of bouncing back to score
- 11. HASHTAG CHAMANT** - Disappointing last run but did win penultimate start when barefoot and is back barefoot for this race. Has a winning chance

Summary : Consistency got rewarded when HARMONIOUS (6) scored last time out. The confidence of that win could enable him to double up and score again. HASHTAG CHAMANT (11) is barefoot again and is an obvious danger. HENJOY DE MONGOCHY (10) is better than the recent disqualifications suggest and can upset. HOT SHOT (2) broke through a long losing streak to win latest and has a winning chance as well.

**C8 - PRIX DE L'ASSOCIATION ROSEAU - 2550m (a1 9/16m) - European -
Class E - Harness - EUR € 30.000**

- 1. FRANKLIN STAR** - Disqualified last time out when barefoot. Did better in some runs before that has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. GLORIEUX** - Unreliable and broke a very long losing streak when winning latest start and deserves respect for that win
- 3. GEISHA DU PONCELET** - Unreliable throughout 2022 but did win a race. Well beaten in last two starts of 2022 and is likely to need the comeback run
- 4. STARO MOJITO** - Moderate last two runs. Does better in France and will be barefoot this time. Has a place chance
- 5. GRANIT DU MONT** - Remains barefoot but has been disqualified in last two starts. Capable of doing better but is best watched for now
- 6. GENERAL BRAVO** - Fit and has been in good form in claimers of late. This is tougher but is clearly not out of it
- 7. DIGITAL DOMINANCE** - Remains barefoot. Seems to have lost his way this year with some moderate runs of late. Others are preferred
- 8. LAST WINNER (BEL)** - On a long losing streak but has been consistent all year and she could be ready to strike a winning turn
- 9. GABY DES VALS** - Very unreliable but won nicely at Laval in March and was not disgraced when third last time out. Has a winning chance
- 10. FOREVER JIEL** - Remains barefoot. Disappointing form of late but has won at this course and could be the surprise package of the race
- 11. GENERAL DE LOIRON** - Disappointing last two runs and last win was when barefoot and is not barefoot now but is capable of winning this race

Summary : GABY DES VALS (9) is very unreliable but gets the vote to score. LAST WINNER (BEL) (8) has been consistent all year and deserves a winning turn. GENERAL DE LOIRON (11) is clearly capable of winning a race like this but has done best when barefoot and is not barefoot this time around. GLORIEUX (2) broke a long losing streak when scoring last time out and can follow up if in the same mood.
