# C1 - PRIX DE LA REGION PAYS DE LA LOIRE, EPREUVE APGO (PX ETIENNE FOUCHER) - 3700m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 27,000

- **1. LES FONTENELLES -** Two wins of late, the latter over 3500m in a Class 3 hurdle at Moulins on May 10th. Capable of getting a hat trick
- **2. LET ME DREAM -** Ran well to be 2nd over 3700m at Le Lion d'Angers on May 6th in a handicap hurdle. Leading contender
- **3. MESSY -** Four unplaced runs of late, the latter over 3500m in a Listed chase at Auteuil on May 8th. Back in calmer waters this time and warrants respect
- **4. L'EPOPEE ALLEN -** Three solid efforts of late, a win two runs back over 3700m on April 21st in a Class 3 hurdle at Le Lion d'Angers and a 3rd at the same track and trip in a handicap hurdle on May 6th. Player
- **5. LORD CIERGUES -** Five unplaced runs of late, the latter over 3600m at Auteuil in a Class 2 handicap hurdle on May 17th when well beaten. Needs to recapture his better form
- **6. LA NORMANDIE -** 3rd on her last start over 3550m in a claiming hurdle at Fontainebleau on April 16th. Might find a few of these too smart
- **7. CLOTH OF SEA -** 5th last time over 3600m at Senonnes on April 12th in a Class 2 handicap hurdle. Outside place chance
- **8. LOVEBABY BLUE -** 3rd last time out over 3500m at Royan in a Class 4 hurdle on May 8th. Handicap debut and has work to do

**Summary:** LET ME DREAM (2) was a decent second at Le Lion d'Angers on his last start 23 days ago and is capable of playing a lead role in this handicap hurdle. LES FONTENELLES (1) has scored in her last two starts and seems to be improving. A hat-trick of wins is not out of the question. L'EPOPEE ALLEN (4) has been consistent recently and can once again be involved at the business end. MESSY (3) is also worth considering back in calmer waters.

- **1. BONNY GLITTERS -** A winner of two of her latest three starts, including last time out in a Conditions race at Machecould over 2350m on 21 April. Tough task this time around
- **2. AQUACELL -** Only modest this year and was 6th in a conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 27 April. Needs to do more to win this race
- **3. LOVE RUSH** Did not show her best when 9th in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 4 October. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- **4. SHEEMA'S ROSE -** Battling to regain form and was 7th in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2500m on 24 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **5. LAURA BAY -** Consistent and was runner-up in a handicap at Nottingham over 2050m on 6 November. Returns from a break but can be competitive again
- **6. STAR OF THE NIGHT -** In good form and was victorious in Class 3 at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 1 May. Tougher task in this line-up
- **7. ROSE JAIPUR -** May have needed both her runs this year and was 9th in a Group 3 at ParisLongchamp over this distance on 27 April. Capable of being a real threat when in the right mood
- **8. JORDANELLA -** Returned to form with a good runner-up performance in a Listed race at ParisLongchamp over 2400m on 13 April. Big chance in this line-up
- **9. GALAXIE VEGA -** May have needed both her starts this year and was 6th in a Group 3 at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 27 April. Has ability and is not out of it
- **10. VILLA DES ARTS -** Unreliable and was 9th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 11 May. Capable of better and could be the surprise package of the race
- **11. BRODURE -** Much improved this year and she has won her last two starts, the latest in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 23 April. Tackles stronger this time
- **12. HAPPY SAXON -** Finished fifth last time out in a Listed race at Compiegne over 2000m on 11 October. Returns from a break but has a winning chance of fit
- **13. SAXON GIRL -** Returned from a break and was runner-up at Hanover over 2000m on 1 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- **14. LOPE DE LILAS -** Returned from a break and was runner-up at Cork over 2100m on 19 April. Can go one better in this line-up

**Summary:** A very open-looking race, and not too many of them can be safely ruled out. JORDANELLA (8) got close to winning a Listed race at ParisLongchamp and can go one better this time. ROSE JAIPUR (7) is clearly better than what she has shown of late and can be a threat. LOVE RUSH (3) returns from a break but should appreciate this longer distance. GALAXIE VEGA (9) has the ability and holds a winning chance over this track and trip.

- **1. KISS GAME -** Nice win on her third start over 3400m in a Class 4 chase at La-Roche-Sur-Lyon on May 11th. In the mix
- **2. JUST FORTY -** 5th over 3550m in a Class 3 hurdle at Fontainebleau on December 3rd on his last start. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **3. HERE WE GO -** Nice 2nd over 3900m at this track on his last start on May 6th in a Class 2 handicap chase. Can go one place better
- **4. LEGREC -** Got off the mark over 3500m at Morlaix in a Class 4 chase on May 11th on his last start. One to pay attention to
- **5. FOR LIFE -** Fair 4th over 3900m at this track on his last start on May 6th in a Class 2 handicap chase. Capable of being in the shake-up
- **6. LILLY DE VAIGE -** Unplaced last time out, 4th before that over 3500m at Montlucon on April 20th in a Class 4 chase. Others look more persuasive
- **7. DIMITRI -** Three unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 3400m at La-Roche-Posay on May 18th in a Class 3 chase. Opposable

**Summary:** HERE WE GO (3) ran a solid race over course and distance in a Class 2 handicap chase on May 6th on his last start and can go one place better this time. FOR LIFE (5) was back in fourth in the same race and looks like the main threat. LEGREC (4) got off the mark over fences at Morlaix on May 11th and can improve from that success. KISS GAME (1) also scored on her latest start and can have a say in proceedings.

- **1. SPIRIT OF DANCE -** Finished 8th in a handicap at Nates over 3100m on 5 May. Had good form in claimers before that and could earn some money
- **2. GREASE -** On a very long losing run and was 5th in a handicap at Nantes over 3100m on 5 May. Might sneak a minor place at best
- **3. HISTOIREDEMARS -** Improving and was victorious in a Conditions race at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2850m on 27 April. First time in a handicap and has a winning chance
- **4. ARGYRON -** In good shape and was fourth in a handicap at Nates over 3100m on 5 May. Can be competitive yet again
- **5. TIGRE ROUGE -** Holding form and finished fourth in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 17 April. Just as good this distance and can make the frame
- **6. ILLUSTRE BERE -** On a very long losing run and was 5th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2600m on 15 May. Could play a minor role
- **7. MANSSOURIO -** Has already won twice this year and was runner-up in handicap at Nantes over 3100m on 5 May. Can go one better this time
- **8. NORQUI DES ROSES -** Unreliable but was victorious in a handicap at Nantes over 3100m on 5 May. Carries a 1KG penalty and is not out of it

- **12. JOSHUA MOON -** On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in a Conditions race at Limoges over 2400m on 4 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** MANSSOURIO (7) is ultra-consistent. He has no issues with this course and distance and can go one better this time. HISTOIREDEMARS (3) looked good when scoring at Sablé-sur-Sarthe and could have more wins in the tank. NORQUI DES ROSES (8) beat the selection at Nantes, and there's no real reason she can't do so again. ARGYRON (4) remains in good form and can also get involved at the finish.

- 1. SPEED DES LANDES Fair 3rd over 4200m in a Class 4 chase at La Roche-Sur-Lyon on May 11th. He has won in the code at Blain recently in late March and can be dangerous
- **2. JUTATHIR DU BREUIL -** 2nd on the last run over 4200m in a Class 3 cross-country on April 27th at Mont-De-Marsan. Opposable
- **3. HARDEQARDE -** Ran well on her last two starts, a win at Blain on his penultimate start on March 23rd and a 2nd at the same track in a Class 4 cross-country on April 21st over 4800m. Warrants respect
- **4. GREATGOLD -** Three unplaced runs of late, the most recent when 6th over 5800m on April 13th in a Class 3 cross-country race. Might find this a step too far
- **5. POKER DE BALLON -** Creditable 3rd over 4750m in a Class 4 cross-country chase on May 4th on the last run. Hard to overlook
- **6. CAPE OF LOVE -** 4th on the latest outing over 4100m at Blain in a Class 4 chase on April 21st. Makes his debut in this discipline and others make more appeal
- **7. SUBSET -** Two unplaced efforts of late, the latest of them at Punchestown (IRL) over 4900m in a cross-country on May 3rd. Hard to fancy
- **8. IRIS DES VIGNAUX -** Won on the sole run last year on December 1st at Craon in a Class 3 cross-country chase by 6L. She will be fit after a nice break and looks like a leading contender

**Summary:** IRIS DES VIGNAUX (8) impressed with a dominant six-length victory in a Class 3 cross-country race at Craon in December. Well-rested since, she should be primed for a strong performance. SPEED DES LANDES (1) shaped well when finishing third in a Class 4 chase last time out and, as a proven winner in this discipline, is dangerous to overlook. POKER DE BALLON (5) looks like a solid each-way contender, while HARDEQARDE (3) is in good form and worth considering.

- 2. SHE'S A TEASE May have needed her only run of this year when 9th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 25 March. Won on her debut and could be a threat
- **3. ZOLIA -** Very unreliable and was 15th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 4 May. Better over shorter but could surprise
- **4. REAL SOCIEDAD -** Showd improvement to win a Conditions race at Le Mans over 1950m on 10 March. Can get into the mix of things
- **5. DEFULLY -** Bounced back to form with a runner-up performance in a Conditions race at Angers over 2100m on 26 April. Can contest the finish again
- **6. CORTELLA -** Finished 6th in a Listed race at this track over 2200m on 4 May. Capable of better and is not out of i in this line-up
- **7. KIMBIA -** Has some fair form on the PSF and was fourth in a Conditions race at Pau over 1400m on 21 January. Tougher task this longer distance

**Summary:** AL UQDA (1) won well on debut last year and did even better when scoring at Saint-Cloud in April. She should complete a hat-trick if in the same mood. REAL SOCIEDAD (4) is improving and could have more to offer.

- **1. BINGO DE L'AUNAY -** 5th on the last start over 4600m in a Class 4 cross-country on April 13th. Capable of being competitive
- **2. SHAWINIGAN -** Two unplaced runs of late, the latest over 5200m at this track in a Class 2 cross-country on April 21st. He won this race in 2023 and can be involved
- **3. GENTILHOMME -** He has won his last two races, both at Fontainebleau. The latest success was over 6000m in a Listed cross-country on March 29th. Looks a live contender
- **4. HAWAX -** Two placed runs recently, 2nd on the latest of them over 5200m in a Class 2 cross-country at this track on April 21st. Warrants respect
- **5. ESPOIR -** Unplaced last time, a win before that over 5300m in a Class 3 cross-country at Saumur on March 30th. This is a tougher test
- **6. WAL CASSANDRE -** Two placed efforts at this track recently, the latter when 3rd over 5200m in a Class 2 cross country on April 21st. Likes this track and is hard to ignore

- **2. KAMELIA DE CORTON -** Broke through with a victory in her 15th start, in a Conditions race at Moulins over 2800m on 10 May. Might earn some minor money
- **3. LIEIRA -** Improving and was victorious last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 20 April. Can double up
- **4. LADY MAGIC -** Consistent and was victorious in a Conditions race at Fougères over this distance on 1 May. Tackles stronger but could make the frame
- **5. LADY GA -** Has held her form and was fourth in a Group 3 at Moulins over this distance on 8 September. Returns from a break but has a winning chance if fit
