- **15. JACOMO DES BOTS -** Classy campaigner that made it 2 in a row when comfortably winning a 2150m Argentan Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Champion driver in the bike and looks the horse to beat
- **16. JAVELOT -** Imposed at Meral before running 4th of 14 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class D on 11 May. Jacques Bruneau could not have asked for a better entry and Anthony Barrier will be keen to take advantage

**Summary:** Currently firing on all cylinders and well-entered here, JACOMO DES BOTS (15) comes to Nantes on a hat-trick and with Eric Raffin in the bike can pull it off. They can still expect to feel the heat from the complicated but talented JEUNESSE ETERNELLE (13) who has been reconfigured for the occasion, and the wonderfully-engaged JAVELOT (16) who has yet to disappoint here. JACKSON D'ECAJEUL (11) is never far from faulting but is just pennies from elimination and even with shoes on looks a player.
