C1 - PRIX DE LAXOU - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. JAPLOO DE CAMBRI** - Disqualified five times in a row, the latest at Savenay over 3100m on 3 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 2. JULKO D'OCQUE** - Has struggled all year and was disqualified last time out at Le Touquet over 2625m on 24 May. Others are much preferred
- 3. JOCKO MESLOIS** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Arras over 2900m on 25 May. Often competitive and could make the frame once again
- 4. JAZZ OPERA** - Has won his last five starts, the latest in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Can add another win to the tally
- 5. JERIDAN** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. JACKARY D'OCQUE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class G at Le Touquet over 2625m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. JESSIE RITAL** - Disqualified in four of her last five starts, including last time out at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. JEROME PICOULERIE** - Yet to win a race after 62 starts and was 8th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. can make the frame
- 9. JOLIE CLAIRE** - Has shown improvement of late and was third in Class H at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 14 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 10. JIVE BOY** - Disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Returns from a break but has a place chance
- 11. JIGSAW D'AMOUR** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 11 July. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough

Summary: AZZ OPERA (4) is on a winning streak and will understandably attract strong support but this is a tougher assignment than his recent races. JIGSAW D'AMOUR (11), one to note on his return. The in-form JOLIE CLAIRE (9) has shown some improvement of late and will try to challenge. JEROME PICOULERIE (8), well placed on the front line, is always capable of making the frame but has yet to taste winning success.

C2 - PRIX DE LA PLACE SAINT-EPVRE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **NA JYL** - Has not shown much so far and was 7th in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
2. **NOBLESSE DU CHENE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Might make the frame if staying in stride
3. **NERON DES LOYAUX** -
4. **NITRO DEUGE** - Unreliable but was third in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. has a place chance in this line-up
5. **NIGHT CLUB** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class G at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. Might earn some minor money
6. **NEVADA DARBY** - Showed some improvement when victorious in Class G at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 14 May. Can follow up
7. **NETWORK** - Improving and was successful in Class F at Arras over 2900m on 10 May. Looks quite capable of following up
8. **NAY MADRIK** - Disqualified in two of three starts so far, including last time out at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Did win her penultimate start and is not out of it if smart
9. **NICO DU CAIEU** - Has not done much wrong yet and won last time out in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 14 May. Can score again

Summary: A very competitive looking race. NEVADA DARBY (6) and NETWORK (7) both opened their accounts last time and will look to follow up, NEVADA DARBY (6) did impress at Bihorel-lès-Rouen so gets the narrow vote. NETWORK (7), is however, improving and will not go down easily. They must be wary of the ultra-consistent NICO DU CAIEU (9) and the tricky NAY MADRIK (8), who start from the second row and are capable of scoring.

C3 - PRIX DE LA PLACE D'ALLIANCE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 19,500

1. **JULIOSCA MANNETOT** - Disqualified last time out at Le Touquet over 2600m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
2. **KILYAN DU FOSSE** - Disqualified last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 24 May. In good form before that and is not out of it if smart
3. **KALYPSO MI AMOR** - On a long losing run and finished 7th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 5 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
4. **LUMIERE DAIRPET** - Disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 May. Hard to trust but can make the frame if staying in stride
5. **JOKE DU HOUSSEL** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class F mounted race at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 May. On a long losing run but has a place chance
6. **LOVE ME DE CERISY** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money
7. **KINGALO DU CHENE** - Hard to trust and faulted last time out at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 5 May. Capable of winning when in the right mood
8. **LE TRESOR KRAAILO** - Holding form and was fourth in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 April. Should make a bold bid at beating these rivals
9. **JUNO DAY** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Arras over 2900m on 10 May. Battling to find his best form and others are preferred
10. **JUST BE GOOD** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Arras over 2900m on 10 May. Capable of being a threat when staying on the trot

Summary: LE TRESOR KRAAILO (8) has a formidable record with Florian Desmigneux (two wins and a second from three starts together) and looks the one to beat. The returning but talented KINGALO DU CHENE (7) is a threat but does need to need to smart. JUST BE GOOD (10), has his disqualification issues but could be worth another chance. KILYAN DU FOSSE (2), was unlucky last time and is often competitive so must be considered as well.

C4 - PRIX DE LA PLACE CARRIERE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,000

- 1. MINIE DE TOUCHYVON** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Rambouillet over 2800m on 14 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. MONA CROWN** - Disqualified in three of her five starts, including last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. MYSTIC LEGEND** - Finished 5th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 23 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 4. MISS MOON** - Disqualified in half of her 8 starts so far, including last time out at Angoulême over 2750m on 18 May. Quite capable of getting into the frame when smart
- 5. MUSE DE DOMPIERRE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 16 May. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it
- 6. MILADY OAKS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Capable of scoring when staying on the trot
- 7. MERRY STAR** - Scored in her 16th attempt, a claimer at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2625m on 24 May. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 8. MALINE DU PLESSIS** - Often competitive and finished third in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 12 May. Big chance in this line-up
- 9. MARIANNE** - Consistent this year and finished third in Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Should fight out the finish

Summary: MALINE DU PLESSIS (8), is consistent and has the ability for a race of this nature so gets a confident vote. MARIANNE (9), edging closer to a win, look capable of overcoming her initial handicap. The tricky MUSE DE DOMPIERRE (5), well placed on the front line, is unreliable but clearly a danger this time around. MISS MOON (4), barefoot for the first time, can also challenge for top honours this track and trip.

- 1. MONACO JENILOU** - Has struggled this year and was tenth in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Yet to win and others make more appeal
- 2. MISTER MEDLEY** - Disqualified twice in his three starts this year, including last time out in a Class F at Laon over 2850m on 17 May. Others are preferred
- 3. MISTRAL DES LUCAS** - Finished fourth in a claimer at Bernay over 2825m on 18 May. Might earn some minor money at best
- 4. MAMOUR DU CHENE** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. MILO DE NAPPES** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, the latest in Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Did better last year and is capable of scoring
- 6. MARAL** - Returned to form and finished fourth in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Often competitive and could make the frame
- 7. MAX DU CAMPDOS** - Unreliable of late and finished 6th in Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 8. MAESTRO D'ELFE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. Did better in his penultimate start and has a place chance
- 9. MENHIR** - Finished fifth last time out in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Has won over this track and trip and can score again
- 10. MARSTON VICTORY** - Broke through with a victory in his 16th attempt, in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 16 May. Might just follow up
- 11. MEDELLIN ELLIS** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 May. Has also done well in harness races and is not out of it

Summary: A very open race. MENHIR (9), back on the track of his last success could be he one to beat. MARSTON VICTORY (10), an impressive winner at Amiens, should fight it out for victory. MILO DE NAPPES (5), capable of bouncing back after some recent faults and did better last year. The well-treated MEDELLIN ELLIS (11) showed some improvement last time out and that hinted that he could be ready to shine brightly.

C6 - PRIX GEORGES GIRONDE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. LUSSAC DE VANDEL** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, including last time out at Wolvega over 2600m. Hard to trust but could play a minor role
- 2. LENNON DU VIVIER** - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Can be a threat when staying in stride
- 3. LOVELY DU RABUTIN** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Has won twice this year and can be competitive yet again
- 4. LADY DE JANEIRO** - Faulted last time out at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money
- 5. LUCKY BOY VERTRAC** - Disqualified in two of his last three starts, including last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Did win his penultimate start and is capable of another victory
- 6. LEADER DU POMMEAU** - Disqualified in five of his last six starts, including last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 February. Hard to trust and could need this run returning from a break
- 7. LISSANDRA JIEL** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Not easy to trust and needs improvement to score
- 8. LEXOVIENNE** - At the top of her game and has won twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Can score again
- 9. LA SPEZIA DE LOU** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Should be involved with the finish

Summary: LEXOVIENNE (8) has struck form with some solid successes and should have no reason to stop here. LA SPEZIA DE LOU (9) is clearly better than her last run would suggest and can lead the opposition. The in-form LOVELY DU RABUTIN (3) is not reliable but can be competitive once again. LUCKY BOY VERTRAC (5), is hard to trust but is best judged on a good penultimate start victory so cannot be ruled out from scoring when smart.

- 1. KIRUNA DU PONCELET** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class G at Laon over 2850m on 17 May. More is needed to win a race like this
- 2. KEOPS JUTH** - Very unreliable and finished 11th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 February. Victorious earlier in February and is not out of it
- 3. KIMBILA** - Unreliable and finished 11th in class F at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Capable of a surprise on best form
- 4. KAKI DE VAL** - Has only been modest of late and finished 9th in class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. KEYSTONE OAKS** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including last time out in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 18 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 6. KANON OXFORD** - Has only been modest this year and was 6th at Waregem over 2400m on 1 May. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- 7. KALYNKA LANDING** - Consistent of late and finished 3rd in class G at Laon over 2850m on 17 May. On a long losing run but has a place chance
- 8. KIONA DU SKY** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and 4th in class F at Tours over 2800m on 10 May. Not this time but can make the frame
- 9. KALINA DE LAURIERE** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a claimer at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2625m on 24 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 10. KORLEON** - Disqualified in class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 11. KEEP TOUCH** - Disqualified in class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Not easy to trust but should be competitive if smart
- 12. KANDAR JIEL** - Disqualified in class F at Gounay-en-Bray over 2550m on 24 May. Has not won for some time now but is capable of playing a minor role
- 13. KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Lignieres over 2825m on 17 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 14. KLOE D'ARRY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in class D at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Capable of scoring on best form
- 15. KYRIELLE JOMUNA** - Disqualified twice in her last two starts, the latest in class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 24 May. Does well for this driver and has claims in this line-up

Summary: A very tricky and it will be a case of who is left without faulting. KYRIELLE JOMUNA (15) has a couple of disqualifications of late but is capable of bouncing back to win a race of this nature. KLOE D'ARRY (14) has struggled of late but could be a threat to these rivals on best form. KEOPS JUTH (2) won nicely in February but has struggled since. KIONA DU SKY (8) hinted at a form return when racing without shoes last time out and is one of many more to consider.

- 1. LUKA MODRIC** - Only modest of late and finished 6th at Mons over 2840m on 26 May. Victorious in March but this is a tougher task
- 2. NAIL'EM** - Disqualified in class E at Le Croise Leroche over 2825m on 20 May. On a long losing streak and othes make more appeal
- 3. JUDGE D.** - Disqualified in class E at Le Croise Leroche over 2825m on 20 May. Consistent before that and has a place chance
- 4. JESSY D'ARCY** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class F at Vichy over 2150m on 4 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. COSTELLO O.E.** - Victorious in his last three starts in his last three starts, the latest at Waregem over 2900m on 5 May. Can score again
- 6. MICHIGAN BRO** - Not reliable but was runner-up in class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Capable of being competitive once again
- 7. WALDGEIST** - Victorious in class D at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Very consistetn and should be involved with the finish once again
- 8. DOMENIK JET** - Successful in class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Has been in very good shape of late and could follow up
- 9. UN MEC PAASLOO** - Disqualified in three os last four starts, including last time out in class D at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 10. JADORE D'ISQUES** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 16 May. Can go one place better
- 11. NEO TURBO** - Unreliable this year and finished 4th at Mons over 1750m on 28 April. More is needed to win this race
- 12. ISIA DU CHENE** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, including last time out in class D at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Can make the frame when staying in stride

Summary: A very open lucky last race. COSTELLO O.E. (5), in top form and a winner at Cabourg on his latest start in France sets the standard. DOMENIK JET (8) and MICHIGAN BRO (6), who recently met at Le Croise-Laroche are in good shape and capable of further success. ISIA DU CHENE (12), if she keeps her stride, is also capable of getting involved with the finish so should be respected in this line-up.
