TRIP TO MAVERICK'S and FRENCH WAR LORD are back from layoffs but showed potential and must be watched.

TRIP TO VENUS was narrowly beaten over course and distance last time out with a claiming apprentice aboard and now gets a seasoned rider. Expect another solid run. THE FLAT CAT has shown recent improvement after being stepped up in trip.

LA MADDALENA is back over what looks to be a more suitable trip and can feature. SPLASH OF LOVE was narrowly beaten first up out of the maidens. She is down in class and from a handy draw should be competitive.
