- **1. MY QUEEN BLUE -** Honest filly that ran 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2500m Vibraye Class F midmonth but seems to be taking on too much this time
- **2. MODJO CHEF -** Has not been seen out since winning a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne in May and is going to need the race
- **3. MODERN STYLE -** 3rd of 11 in a 2950m Le Mans Class E late last month, on first start on a hard surface. Passed his test with flying colours and will be expected to give MILORD DES CHARMES (6) a run for his money
- **4. MAMBO PLANCHETTE** In the frame in last 2, latterly 2nd of 12 in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle late last month. Mathieu Mottier gets the nod and will be expected to finish thereabouts
- **5. MAGNIFIK BOSDARROS** Modest sort that ran 6th of 10 in a 2750m Cabourg claimer 2.5 weeks ago and in this field looks a rank outsider

- **3. L'ETONNANT TONIC -** Got off the mark at Les Sables-d'Olonne in early-July then ran 3rd of 9 in a 2650m Class E at the same venue 3.5 weeks ago. Is not about to win this but is still good enough to pick up a cheque
