- **1. JACKPOT DE VIETTE -** On a long losing run and finished 6th in Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 12 September. Did better before that at this course and could play a minor role
- **2. IROKO DU NORD -** In good form and was runner-up in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 29 September. Can be competitive once again
- **3. JACOVIA MADRIK -** Returned to form with a Class G win at this track over 2700m on 8 September. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- **4. ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS -** Very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 13 September. Can be involved with the finish once again
- **5. JACOBSON -** Unreliable and finished 9th in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 17 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- **4. KANEM -** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Lisieux over 2725m on 13 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. KAPITANO DE LOU -** Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 September. Needs major improvement to win
