RACECOURSE: Turf. Summer course 2800m in circumference with 600m run-in. Winter course 2700m with 450m run-in. Races up to 1200m testing straight course (1200m races are occasionally run round the turn, starting on the Summer course and ending on the Winter course); beyond 1200m anti-clockwise round turn. **TOP JOCKEYS AT TRACK:** R Fourie 358-75 (20.95%)-148, G van Niekerk 303-72 (23.76%)-133, L Mxothwa 274-41 (14.96%)-110, A Marcus 159-32 (20.13%)-59 **TOP TRAINERS AT TRACK:** J S Snaith 780-126 (16.15%)-271, C Bass-Robinson 544-67 (12.32%)-210, B Crawford 364-49 (13.46%)-124, V H Marshall 349-35 (10.03%)-116 **DRAW:** Low-numbers draws slightly preferred all races. ISLAND TREASURE caught the eye on debut when flashing up late over 1000m and the step up in trip with that run under the belt makes her the one to beat. PANZANELLA and others with experience could get into the picture. Newcomers TANGO MIST and WAYWARD GIRL warrant respect.

CHARLIE SQUADRON has been costly to follow but has improved with blinkers fitted and could enjoy cutting back in trip, so rates the one to beat. Well-bred BIRDIE AND BOGIE made good improvement from his first to second run, albeit in a work riders maiden, and should take another step forward to pose a threat. FOREVER BILL gave a better account over track and trip when last seen and should have a role to play with a repeat of that effort. Tricky.

PREVIEW: Tricky. INFINITE PEACE caught the eye in a stronger race on handicap debut, staying on well over a shorter trip, so is likely to have more to offer reverting to this distance. STORM DICTATOR was another to draw attention when doing his best work late in a stronger sprint. He should, on pedigree and that evidence, enjoy the extra 200m so could challenge. SOLAR POWER may have just won a maiden but is progressive and should improve. TICKET TO RIDE, off his current mark, and SILENT TRIGGER (who may have needed his last start after gelding) have claims.

MA BLACK disappointed last time over 1000m but could reaffirm stepping up to this trip. Stablemate NIPPY WINTER ran well on handicap debut and should do so again. APOLLO MOON and FEARLESS TRIP have claims.
