### C1 - PRIX DES ETANGS DE SAINT-PIERRE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- **1. MYSTERY -** Has won consecutive claiming races this year and was retained by his current owner after both wins, the latest over 1600m at Fontainebleau on 15 March. One to beat
- **2. MI C'INFILO -** Consistent hard-knocker who showed his form and well-being by finishing 3rd in an 1800m handicap on this course on 19 March. Will be factor
- **3. JACK OF TRADES -** Finished 3rd behind MYSTERY (1) in a 1600m claimer at Fontainebleau on 15 March. Will have a role to play
- **4. SLEEPY SUZY -** Rewarded for her consistency with a last-start success in a 1400m handicap on this course. Up 2kg for that win but should remain competitive
- **5. SO GOLD -** Consistent handicapper but has been hard to win with (1 victory from 21 starts). Has dropped 1kg in the weights/ratings after finishing 5th in a 1600m PSF conditions race at Cagnes on 19 February
- **6. APRIL GALAXY -** Veteran mare of 104 appearances with 10 victories to her name but has gone off the boil. Has finished 8th in three claimers on French soil this year the latest over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on 16 March
- **7. CHILLI PRINCESS -** Consistent handicapper with sound references/form credentials in that category, seldom far off the mark. Finished 4th in a 1400m handicap at Nancy when last seen on 10 March

**Summary:** MYSTERY (1) is undefeated in 2024 after winning both starts in this category since the turn of the year and is good value to complete a hat-trick. SLEEPY SUZY (4) was rewarded for consistency with a last-start success over 1400m at this venue and is likely to pose a threat. MI C'INFILO (2) arrives in good form and physical condition after a recent 3rd and ought to make his presence felt once more, while JACK OF TRADES (3) has proven his competitiveness at this level and could get into the picture too.

- **1. READY KING -** Won a 1300m PSF handicap at Deauville in January but has struggled (unplaced) under a penalty in 3 subsequent outings was 8th in a 1500m PSF handicap at Marseille-Vivuax on 14 March. Won his only start in this category last year
- **2. FINDERS KEEPERS -** Claimed after making a winning debut over 1300m on the PSF at Deauville. Has regressed in 3 starts since but ought to fare better back in this grade and is open to improvement in his first outing on turf. Finished 12th in a 1500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 10 February
- **3. DSCHINGIS ART -** Finished 7th on debut over 1650m on heavy ground at Machecoul on 3 March. Would have benefitted from that experience
- **4. BEJAR -** Runner-up on debut over 1600m at Saint-Malo in August and caught the eye when finishing 3rd in her comeback outing in an 1800m claimer on this course on 19 March. Should have more to offer
- **5. SCARAMOUCHE -** Finished 6th over 1750m in a maiden on soft ground at Hanovre in October. Ought to have benefitted from that experience
- **6. ON BORROWED TIME -** Consistent filly who made a bright start to her career in England but has finished 6th in both outings on French soil in PSF claimers, the latest over 1900m at Deauville on 5 January. Reverts to turf now
- **7. PURA VIDA -** Unplaced in both starts in conditions races over 1200m at Fontainebleau on debut and over 1400m on this course on 19 March. Best watched for now
- **8. BOMBEY -** Finished 4th in a 1400m claimer at Saint-Cloud on his reappearance and confirmed both his form and well-being by finishing 2nd in an 1100m handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche on 22 March. Keep safe
- **9. DIDJIE -** Didn't go unnoticed in each of her three starts last year (on turf at Deauville and Saint-Cloud, and on turf at Chantilly) but has been disappointing in both comeback outings. Finished 14th in a Quinte+ handicap on PSF over 1400m at Chantilly on 18 March

**Summary:** FINDERS KEEPERS (2) ought to benefit from this favourable commitment by bouncing back to form on his return to the claiming category. BEJAR (4) is lightly raced but has already shown she retains the means to be regarded as a candidate for success at this level. Like the selection, READY KING (1) won his only outing in this grade, so should play a leading role. BOMBEY (8), runner-up at Le Croisé-Laroche on Friday, completes the shortlist.

- **2. TRUE VALUE -** Start-to-finish winner of her last start over 1400m on the PSF at Chantilly on 18 March and is capable of defying a 2,5kg penalty by winning again. Won on debut in Germany on soft ground over 1400m
- **3. NOUSDEUX -** Improved to finish 3rd on a 1600m conditions race at Saint-Cloud on 16 March. Will be competitive if confirming that progress here
- **4. SUBLIME CHOPE -** Won a 1600m ParisLongchamp handicap in October but struggled under a resultant 2,5kg penalty until improving to finish 4th in a 1600m handicap at Le Mans on 11 March after a slow start. Keep safe
- **5. LE RAVI -** Finished 6th in three consecutive PSF outings before improving to finish 3rd in his first start on turf at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 12 March. Dangerous to discount on his handicap debut
- **6. BRAMANS -** Finished 3rd over 1700m on the PSF at Pornichet in December but finished unplaced in his other four appearances (8th in a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 24 February). Could be anything on turf
- **7. LA VUELTA -** Unplaced in all four starts to date but has not finished far off the mark in her last two outings, on PSF at Chantilly last month (6th) and over 1600m on turf (5th) at Saint-Cloud on 16 March. Dark horse
- **8. IHOA -** A 15-start maiden unlikely to break her duck here on the evidence of her last-start 9th in a 1400m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 18 March. Outsider
- **9. SANTO -** Finished 4th on debut at Bordeaux over 1900m on heavy ground in October but failed to confirm that promise in 4 subsequent unplaced outings 7th in 1800m handicap at Fontainebleau on 15 March
- **10. SEMPER FI -** Unplaced in three starts on the PSF and made no impression in his first outing on turf last time (11th) in an 1800m handicap at Fontainebleau on 15 March. Others preferred

**Summary:** TRUE VALUE (2) returned to winning ways with a start-to-finish victory over 1400m on PSF at Chantilly and is capable of following up here reverting to the turf, having won on debut on soft ground last year. GRAN HABANO (1) finished 5th on his handicap debut over 1600m on the PSF in January and represents a stable in good form, so has to be respected. Also on the right track after an encouraging 3rd last time, NOUSDEUX (3) ought to be competitive. The shortlist is completed by SUBLIME CHOPE (4) whose recent 4th at Le Mans was evidence of improvement.

- **1. JEWEL DE CERISY -** Finished a disappointing 10th in a 2600m handicap at Fontainebleau on 25 March having previously run 3rd in a 3000m handicap at Nancy behind the selection. Chance if bouncing back to that form
- 2. TYTAN Out of sorts but has dropped to a more competitive mark in the weights/ratings and did finish 3rd in 2 previous visits to this track. Can do better than a last-start 12th in a 2700m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 16 February
- **3. MOMOUR** Never worse than 3rd in seven associations with Kévin Braye. Runner-up to WELL DE VINDECY (6) over 3000m at Nancy on 10 March and is weighted to finish closer to that rival on these terms
- **4. DAISY SENORA -** Has rediscovered her form recently after dropping to a more competitive mark in the weights/ratings. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th in a 2400m PSF handicap at Cagnes on 17 February
- 5. ARMORIGENE Inconsistent but capable veteran handicapper who confirmed as much by winning a 3000m handicap at Fontainebleau on 15 March. Ought to remain competitive under a 2,5kg penalty
- **6. WELL DE VINDECY -** A new addition to Julien Phélippon's stable after winning consecutive 3000m races at Nancy latest a handicap by 8 lengths on 24 March. The booking of Florent Guy bodes well for her chances
- **7. TARCENAY -** Inconsistent veteran handicapper of 165 appearances and 13 race wins. Didn't go unnoticed when 8th in a 2600m Fontainbleau handicap on 25 March
- **8. GALWAY CITY -** Lightly raced hard-knocking veteran handicapper whose consistency over staying distances recently is encouraging, albeit at a lower level. Runner-up in a 3000m handicap at Fontainebleau on 15 March
- **9. MONJARAZ -** Out of sorts an probably more effective in the claiming category. Finished a well-beaten 10th in a turf handicap over 2400m on this course on 10 March
- **10. MARIE D'ARGONNE -** Unreliable veteran mare who won a 2350m handicap on soft ground at Strasbourg in November but struggled (unplaced) under a resultant penalty. Soundly beaten (13th) in a 2400m handicap last time at Toulouse on 20 March
- **11. TENDER WINNER** Inconsistent but capable veteran handicapper who showed his form/well-being with blinkers refitted by finishing 2nd in a 2150m PSF handicap at Lyon-La Soie on 24 March

**Summary:** WELL DE VINDECY (6) changed hands after the second of her consecutive 3000m Nancy victories recently and is capable of making a winning start for new connections, especially with Florent Guy engaged to ride in her bid to complete the hat-trick. Never disappointing with Kévin Braye until now, MOMOUR (3) has just reassured Nancy. Also entrusted to a talented gentleman, DAISY SENORA (4) will have pretensions, like JEWEL DE CERISY (1), who goes the distance. The form of ARMORIGENE (5) is beyond doubt.

- **1. HUMAN EVOLUTION -** Acquitted himself in three starts as a two-year-old, finishing 5th on each occasion and is open to any amount of improvement on his reappearance/handicap debut. Last seen at Chantilly on 11 October
- 2. MEISHO BONHEUR Improving with each start and was supplemented to run in this race after an encouraging 3rd over 2350m at Machecoul on 25 February
- **3. CLASH ROYALE** Inconsistent filly who has shown her limits in two handicap appearances, finishing unplaced on both occasions. Needs to improve to have a say after finishing 6th in an 1800m claimer here on 19 March
- **4. LUCKY BERE -** An easy last-start winner of a 2400m claimer on this course on 19 March. Ought to reman competitive under a 1kg penalty
- **5. LADYSHOW -** Made an encouraging handicap debut, finishing 2nd over 2100m at Senonnes-Pouancé on 23 March. Can get into the picture
- **6. DELIRIUM TREMENS -** Placed once in six starts when 3rd in a PSF claimer at Deauville in November. Will need to improve to have a say after finishing 6th on handicap debut over 2100m at Senonnes-Pouancé on 23 March
- **7. ROI DE BAVIERE -** Consistent sort with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a handicap third over 2100m at Saint-Cloud on 12 March. Could improve over this extended trip
- **8. KENPIC -** Has made no impression in each of three outings on the PSF in conditions races. Needs to improve to have a say here on his handicap/turf debut after finishing 12th over 1800m at Chantilly in December
- **9. BAAL HOWARD -** Unplaced in all six starts in conditions races on the turf and PSF, including when only 7th over 2150m at Lyon-La Soie on 15 March. Others preferred

**Summary:** HUMAN EVOLUTION (1) looked like a work in progress as a two-year-old but still acquitted himself competitively in three appearances in well-composed maiden races. He ought to have improved over the winter so it could be worth following his progress on his reappearance/handicap debut. LUCKY BERE (4) was an easy last-start winner of a 2400m claimer on this course earlier this month and is likely to fight for victory. ROI OF BAVIERE (7) lines up here in good form and physical condition with the possibility of unlocking some improvement over this extended trip, so has to be respected. MEISHO BONHEUR (2) completes the shortlist.

- 1. PRINCEDESCHAMPS A winner on this course over 2400m and finished 2nd in his last appearance at the venue. Has been in good form on the PSF lately (finished 4th in a 1900m PSF handicap on 24 February) so should run well
- **2. MISS COSY -** Out of sorts but does have references in handicaps off a significantly higher mark. Has not been seen since finishing 6th on PSF at Mons over 1500m on 22 January but is dangerous to dismiss at this level
- **3. LUCKY YOU -** Won a 2200m handicap at Amiens in October but struggled in 3 subsequent starts under a resultant penalty. Finished 10th in a 2000m handicap on very heavy ground at Marseille-Borley on 27 February
- **4. SIBUYU -** Inconsistent but capable handicapper more effective on turf than the PSF. Finished 7th in a handicap over 2150m on PSF at Lyon-La Soie on 24 March but ought to fare better reverting to this surface
- **5. COLE CHOP -** Caught the eye on his return from a five-month rest by finishing 3rd in a 2100m Strasbourg handicap on heavy ground last week. Will have a role to play if confirming that improvement
- **6. DUBAI EMPIRE -** Was soundly beaten (11th) in the 10 March reference race over 2400m on this course when resuming after a four-month absence. Needs to to improve to stake a claim but may well do so
- **7. GOT FROST -** Hard-knocking handicapper who has sound references and seldom finishes far off the mark. Steps up in trip after a satisfactory 7th in a 1600m turf handicap on heavy ground at Fontainebleau on 2 March
- **8. DARENIX -** A long-time maiden with 8 places to his name from 42 starts. Finished a reassuring 3rd over 2400m in the reference race contest at this venue on 10 March
- **9. LADY VALOU -** Out of sorts and is hard to make a case for on current form unplaced in both starts this year after an absence of 5 months. Best watched for now after finishing 9th in a 1500m Cagnes handicap last time
- **10. LIE HIGH -** Veteran 10-year-old with 5 wins from 102 appearances. Soundly beaten in both outings this year, the latest of which was in the 2400m reference race on this course on 10 March others preferred
- **11. ABORIGENE -** Showed signs of improvement when finishing 5th, behind DARENIX (8), in the 2400m reference race at this venue on 10 March. Can make his presence felt
- **12. MITARC -** Took advantage of a drop in the ratings to open his account in a 2500m Le Croisé-Laroche handicap in April last year. Returned from a lengthy layoff to finish 8th in the 2400m reference here on 10 March
- **13. THE FOOTMAN -** Hard-knocking handicapper who remains a battling maiden with just a solitary place to show from 28 appearances. Steps up in trip after finishing 6th in a 1400m handicap on this course on 19 March

**Summary:** In what is a modest handicap, it could pay to side with top-weight PRINCEDESCHAMPS (1) who has been in good form of late on the PSF but also efficient on the turf, having finished 2nd over 2400m on his last visit to this track. COLE CHOP (5) caught the eye on his reappearance after a five-month absence when finishing 3rd on heavy ground at Strasbourg and is likely to improve with the benefit of that outing, so ought to fight for victory. DARENIX (8) also bounced back to form last time by finishing 3rd over 2400m on this track and need only confirm that improvement to play a leading role. Others to consider are ABORIGENE (11) and SIBUYU (4).

- **2. GAMECHANGER -** He has certainly not won since September 2022 but was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Marseille Borely over this distance on 27 February. Go close
- **3. AFGHANY -** Only fair form of late and was 5th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 14 March. A bit better on grass and can make the frame
- **4. WALLEM -** On a long losing run and was 9th last time out in a handicap in Germany on 5 November. Likely to need this race returning from a break
- **5. L'INDOMPTABLE -** Distance suited and has been runner-up in two claimers of late including over this track and trip last time out on 10 March. Big chance
- **6. HIGHEST MOUNTAIN -** Disappointing last run last time out when 9th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 14 March. Better on grass and is capable of an upset
- **7. MAKTAVA -** Has really been struggling on the PSF of late and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 24 February. Best watched for now
- **8. WELCOME TANGO -** Proved in need of last run when 7th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 6 March. Fitter now and could be the surprise package on handicap debut
- **9. SILVER SCHNOK -** Disappointing last two runs and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Marseille Borely over 2000m. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **10. LIEBE KINDER -** In good form of late and was a winner of a handicap last time out at Pau over 2000m on 18 February. Carries a 1kg penalty but can earn some money
- **11. FOLLOW YOU -** Disappointed when 8th last time out under a penalty in a handicap at this course over 1800m on 19 March. Capable of earning some minor money
- **12. KUPALA -** Has yet to win and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 23 February. Capable of improvement back on the turf
- **13. LES EMBRUNS** Has not shown much in seven starts and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 2100m on 1 March. Others are preferred
- **14. ASPHODELE MIA -** Disappointing last run when well beaten in a handicap at Saint Could over 2000m on 10 November. Capable of better but could need this returning from a break

**Summary:** A winner of two "claimers" on this same course, L'INDOMPTABLE (5) has just shown her form there and can strike back in a handicap. GAMECHANGER (2) has not won since 2022 but is in good form and could go close to winning this time around. TENNESSEE JOHN (1) was not disgraced last time out at this course and could do even better. AFGHANY (3) is a bit better on the grass so could make the frame.

- 1. KALIFE ALAPLACE Bounced back to form when reverting to the turf last time. Finished 4th behind KOLPLET (5) that day at Saint-Cloud, on 16 March, so warrants respect here
- 2. MANDRES Finished 3rd on this course over 1600m on debut in October last year and has acquitted herself well in both comeback outings, albeit at a lower level. Finished 4th over 1600m at Lignières on 2 March
- **3. ARCUBIATU** Wide-margin winner of a 2000m handicap at Saint-Cloud on very heavy ground on 16 March. Ought to remain competitive under a 3kg penalty
- **4. NEOWISE -** A 12-start maiden who seldom finishes far off the mark but not likely to open her account in this race. Finished 4th in an 1800m handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche on 22 March
- **5. KOLPLET -** Won a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly in December and has proven his worth/competitiveness off a 3kg higher mark by finishing 2nd and 3rd twice each in his last four starts the latest (3rd) in a 2000m handicap on very heavy ground at Saint-Cloud on 16 March. Winning chance
- **6. ELAUNEIL -** Won a 1600m PSF handicap at Cagnes in January but could only finish 9th in a 1600m PSF handicap at Chantilly last time under a 2,5kg penalty. Remains unexposed in handicap on turf
- **7. RECOLEROS -** Opened his account when winning a 2100m PSF handicap at Pornichet last year but struggled under a resultant penalty (unplaced in all 6 starts since, including a 2000m Saint-Cloud handicap (13th) on 16 March
- **8. KIM DE GAUDEL** Runner-up in her last two starts, in a 2100m PSF handicap at Pornichet in January and at Le Mans in a 1950m conditions race last time (11 March). Not taken lightly
- EURYTHMICAL Finished a well-beaten 2nd to ARCUBIATU (3) at Saint-Cloud in a 2000m handicap on 16 March. Ought to finish closer on 3kg better terms
- 10. DANSEUSE CELEBRE Won over 1800m at Dieppe on handicap last year but has lost her way since soundly beaten in all 10 subsequent outings, including her latest (10th) over 2000m in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on 16 March
- **11. ARYA -** Unplaced in all 10 outings and made no impression when finishing 13th in a 2000m Saint-Cloud handicap on 16 March. Others preferred
- **12. OCTOBER CHOPE -** Bounced back to form when finishing 5th in a 2000m Saint-Cloud handicap on 16 March. Has to build on that improvement to get involved

**Summary:** KOLPLET (5) opened his account on the PSF and maintained his form/consistency on that surface under a 3kg penalty. He proved his efficiency and competitiveness on the turf by finishing 3rd in a 2000m Saint-Cliud handicap last time, so is capable of winning a race of this nature. However, he will be tested by wide-margin last-start winner ARCUBIATU (3) who won over the same course and distance (2000m at Saint-Cloud) recently. EURYTHMICAL (9), runner-up last time out, and consistent KALIFE ALAPLACE (1) ought to acquit themselves competitively too.

- 2. MY UNIVERSE Consistent for the most part and would've needed her comeback outing, when finishing 8th on PSF at Chantilly over 1500m. Capable of a lot better
- 3. MOON RIDER Made no impression (16th) in a 1600m PSF handicap at Chantilly on his reappearance from a 4-month absence on 5 March. Best watched for now
- **4. GOLDENSIM** A model of consistency who hasn't finished worse than 4th in his last 14 appearances. Unlucky not to have achieved a better result when finishing 4th in a 1600m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 8 March
- **5. LERY -** Consistent throughout 2023 but has finished 7th in both comeback outings this year, the latest in a 1600m conditions race on this course. Makes her handicap debut off an attractive opening mark
- **6. KYNADA** Won five consecutive races at a lower level from May to September last year but finished unplaced in consecutive handicaps in October and a 1600m handicap at Toulouse (9th) on 20 November
- **7. ALCOTAN** Has regained his form/consistency in two comeback outings on the PSF this year, finishing 2nd over 2100m in a handicap at Chantilly on 1 March. Chief
- **8. AMERICAN HOPE** Inconsistent and out of sorts at present but has dropped to a dangerously low mark. Finished 12th in a 1600m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 8 March
- **9. GRECIAN STAR -** Consistent for the most part and did show signs of improvement last time when 5th in a 1600m turf claimer at Fontainebleau on 15 March. More needed
- **10. RISING BLAST -** Versatile and capable colt with sufficient means and sound references/form credentials. Finished 6th in a 1600m handicap on heavy ground at Fontainebleau on his reappearance (2 March) one to note
- **11. AL ALAALI** Consistent for the most part and has sound references, including a last-start 4th behind ALCOTAN (7) on 1 March over 2100m on the PSf at Chantilly. Dark horse
- **12. MONTGAUDRY** Has shown his limitations in the handicaps, finishing unplaced in all 3 appearances in this category. Was soundly beaten (15th) in a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 14 November

**Summary:** GOLDENSIM (4) has been a model of consistency throughout his career and was unlucky not to have won on the PSF last time at Chantilly. He is effective on turf and deserves to get his head in front again, so gets the nod ahead of ALCOTAN (7) despite the latter's lack of references on heavy ground. LINGOTTO (1) proved he has the means to be competitive in a race of this nature by finishing 5th in a recent Quinte+ event, so is capable of joining those rivals in the fight for victory. MY UNIVERSE (2) is out of sorts but not incapable of getting into the picture.
