**C1 - PRIX DE MONTGAROULT - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted -
EUR € 21,000**

- 1. NEGUS DE FORGES** - Qualified in 117"5 at Feurs on 24 February. That was a decent time but will be fully tested in this race
- 2. NIKOS** - Qualifier at Grosbois in 117"8 on 24 February. Appears to have ability and could make a winning debut in a mounted event
- 3. NOFARO** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2925m at Cagnes on 26 February. Will need to do more to be competitive in this field
- 4. NUAGE DES LOUPS** - A moderate 8th in a Class F over 2225m at Feurs on 5 March. Has had a number of opportunities and looks outclassed in this event
- 5. NICO DU CEDRE** - Finished 5th in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 March. He is held by others on that performance
- 6. NITBY** - Finished 4th in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 March. Is held by others on that last race
- 7. NEW DEAL DU ROEN** - A promising 3rd in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 March. That was a decent effort and improvement is expected
- 8. NORD INTENSE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2250m at Enghien on 6 March. Has a lot more to do this time around
- 9. NARCISSE TURGOT** - Disqualified in a Class B over 2200m at Vincennes-GPP on 27 February. That was his first run in a mounted race but will now have a second opportunity
- 10. NAZZARENO** - A decent 2nd in a Class F over 2200m at this course on 4 September. That was a promising first run at this course and he could show further improvement after a break on his debut under the saddle
- 11. NOBI BAROSSO** - Did well when 3rd in a Class D over 2250m at Enghien on 6 March. That was his first run in a mounted race and he can be competitive again.
- 12. NEWTON DE MONGOCHY** - Did well when 5th in a Class E over this course and distance on 25 March. Has good form in harness races and could make a successful debut in a mounted event

Summary: NIKOS (2) gave an indication when qualifying that he had a lot more to come and could make a winning debut in this event. Of the more experienced runners NEW DEAL DU ROEN (7) stands out after a promising third over this trip and track and holds some of his rivals on that performance. NAZZARENO (10) comes back from a break of almost 7 months but has good form at this course. NOBI BAROSSO (11) could improve further.

C2 - PRIX DE BENOUVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NIKE SUPREME** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2875m at Meslay-Du-Maine on 15 March. She looked threatening before making her mistake and could atone for that error this time
- 2. NOTRE HISTOIRE** - An improved 3rd in a Class F over 2850m at Laval on 11 March. That was her first run for a new trainer after a 192-day break
- 3. NUIT DE MAI** - Won a Class F over 2275m at Nantes on 16 November. She looked good in that race and can improve further after a 4-month break
- 4. NUANCE KADESH** - Ran 4th in a Class E over 2150m at Vire Normandie on 1 March. Takes on a lot stronger on this occasion
- 5. NAUSICA DE CORBERY** - A mediocre 4th in a Class E over 2825m at Cordemais on 27 February. Unlikely to trouble this field
- 6. NINA HAGEN D'OR** - Finished 4th in a Class D over 2600m at Saint-Galmier on 16 February. That was her first run back from a layoff but she will need to do more
- 7. NEFERTITI PIYA** - Looked good when winning a Class F over 2150m at Argentan on 6 February. A second successive win would not come as a surprise
- 8. NATIVE DE PLAY** - Finished 7th in a Class E over 2725m at Lisieux on 14 March. Will need to up her game if she is to feature
- 9. NOVA TURGOT** - Disqualified in a Class C over 2100m at Vincennes-GPP on 19 December. Has three successive disqualifications and will need to focus better
- 10. NAYA D'ERONVILLE** - A decent 3rd in a Class F over 2150m at Argentan on 6 February. That was not a bad effort and she could be competitive if she can improve on that run. Will be fitted with padded shoes
- 11. NUTELLA DE VANDEL** - Far from disgraced when 7th in a Class D over 2150m at Enghien on 10 March. She ran above her rating in that race and a win cannot be far off
- 12. NICE PACE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2100m at Vincennes-GP on 10 February. Won her penultimate race and should be competitive if she keeps her mind on the task at hand

Summary: NUTELLA DE VANDEL (11) was a little unlucky in her last start but should show her true ability against a field of this level. When she keeps her mind on the job NICE PACE (12) does well but she also has a tendency lose concentration. At her best, she must be considered. NEFERTITI PIYA (7) won her last start and there is no reason why she cannot score a quick double. NOTRE HISTOIRE (2) changed trainers and came back well from a break.

C3 - PRIX DE CANTELOUP - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MOST WANTED** - A moderate 7th in a Class G over 2625m at Cherbourg on 1 March. Will race without shoes at the back but that is unlikely to produce the improvement needed
- 2. MELINE DU VIVIER** - An excellent 2nd in a Class F over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 5 March. She has been in top form since racing barefoot and looks primed to score again
- 3. MAESTRIA DE CHENU** - Unplaced in a Class F over this course and distance on 5 March. Does not have the ability to be a factor
- 4. MISS LADY DU DAN** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2200m at Caen on 19 October. Her form is poor and she is best left alone
- 5. MISS ROC** - Finished 4th in a Class F over this track and trip on 5 March. That was her first run for a new trainer and came after a 130-day break. Will need massive improvement to feature
- 6. MENEUSE DE HOUELLE** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2625m at Blain-Bouvron on 22 March. Form is moderate and she should not trouble this field
- 7. MUTINE DE L'ITON** - Finished 8th in a Class F over 2700m at Graignes on 15 March. That was not a bad effort coming back from a 108-day rest. Will race unshod for the first time
- 8. MUSE DE BEYLEV** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2675m at Lisieux on 14 March. Not always the most reliable runner but she does go well for Mathieu Mottier who will be her driver once again
- 9. MAQUENZA DU BOCAGE** - Was 7th in a Class F over 2625m at Blain-Bouvron on 22 March. She can be quite tough and put the others under pressure
- 10. MONA LISA GEDE** - Did well when 3rd in a Class E over 2925m at Cagnes on 3 March. The shoes will come off and that might give her some sort of place chance
- 11. MA BELLE ATTAQUE** - Disqualified in a Class E over this course and distance on 12 March. She was looking good when making her mistake late in the race and must be respected
- 12. MAMMA MIA DE LOU** - Won a Class E over 2850m at Mauquenchy on 26 January. Will need to up her game in this field and will race fully shod
- 13. MADAME D'ERABLE** - A decent 3rd in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes-GP on 24 December. Has won over the course and distance so needs to be respected
- 14. MIST NIGHT QUICK** - Not a bad effort when 8th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 6 March. Last three runs have been under the saddle but returns to harness this time with all four shoes removed
- 15. MANILLE SOMOLLI** - A promising 5th in a Class E over this course and distance on 12 March. That was her first run back from a 94-day break and showed up well at this course. More to come
- 16. MADONE DES RACQUES** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes-GP on 31 October. Comes back from a break and looks unlikely to feature

MONDAY, 30/03/26

Summary: There is a lot to like about MELINE DU VIVIER (2) who has been in top form since racing without shoes. She stands out as the runner to beat. However, she could face a strong challenge from MANILLE SOMOLLI (15) who looked good in her return from a break. One also needs to consider MA BELLE ATTAQUE (11) who was looking strong when making a mistake late in the race. MUTINE DE L'ITON (7) also showed up well on her comeback and will have her shoes removed.

C4 - PRIX D'ARROMANCHES - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MAMBO D'AMOUR** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2600m at Bernay on 1 May last year. Was disqualified in both starts, has not raced in almost 11 months and is best ignored
- 2. MISTRAL DE FORGES** - A poor 8th in a Class E over 2625m at Paray-Le-Monial on 22 February. Has no chance based on exposed form
- 3. MEMPHIS PARIS** - A good 3rd in a Class F over this course and distance on 13 March. That run was behind MILORD DES ARRIS (10) and MARECHAL TURGOT (4) and while he does have temperament issues, he should go well again.
- 4. MARECHAL TURGOT** - A close-up 2nd in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 March. Did well when narrowly beaten by MILORD DES ARRIS (10) coming back from a break and looks a real threat this time
- 5. MIL REEF** - Finished 4th in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 March. He is held by others on that run but it was his first race for a new trainer and he could show more
- 6. MAC GYVER** - Won a Class F over 2550m at Reims on 19 March. Has performed well under the saddle with Mathieu Mottier up and their good run can continue. Will race shod behind
- 7. MIRAGE DE KARMELE** - A moderate 7th in a Class F over 2625m Blain-Bouvron on 22 March. Will need to do a lot more to feature
- 8. MAKING TIME** - Won a Class E over 2250m at Feurs on 8 March. Has cracked his first victory and that should give him some confidence
- 9. MOGADOR** - A decent 5th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 6 March. Has run well since racing without back shoes and should be competitive again
- 10. MILORD DES ARRIS** - Won a Class F over this track and trip on 19 March, staying on courageously to hold off MARECHAL TURGOT (4) by the narrowest of margins. Showed his ability with that win and should run well again

Summary: MAC GYVER (6) sets the standard in this race as he performed consistently well in mounted races and has an excellent rapport with Mathieu Mottier. The main threat is likely to come from MARECHAL TURGOT (4), who has touched off in his comeback run at this course, and MILORD DES ARRIS (10), who was the runner who beat him. MOGADOR (9) has the ability to upset them all on his day.

C5 - PRIX D'ANGOVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KARO DU BELET** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. KIWI DE CHINE** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
- 3. KISS ME MATCH** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Has a place chance if smart
- 4. KOLOSSE** - In good shape and finished runner-up in Class F at Argentan over 2150m on 6 February. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money if smart
- 5. KENAVO TUILERIE** - Returned from a break and finished 11th in Class D over this track and trip on 2 March. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 6. KARNO D'ARBAZ** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 12 March. Barefoot for this but needs major improvement to score
- 7. KINGALA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Capable of earning some money when staying in stride
- 8. KATAVIA PRESS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. KING TRACK** - Much improved this year, winning his last two starts, the latest in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Barefoot for hat-trick attempt and the one to beat
- 10. KISMIE DE MEMARTIN** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class F at Nantes over 3000m on 16 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. KELSAM DU RUISSEAU** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. A winner of his previous start but may be at very best that shorter distance
- 12. KAABA RINGEAT** - Two wins in his last five starts, including last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 8 March. Capable of doubling up
- 13. KALINE DJOB** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 22 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 14. KELLY DU MENIL** - Not reliable but was third in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 1 March. Capable of being a threat once again
- 15. KADOR DES TITHAIS** - Victorious in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Keeps that shoeing and is not out of it this distance
- 16. KSAR UNICK** - Returned to form when barefoot and fourth in Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 1 March. Remains barefoot and can be competitive once again

Summary: Unshod on all four feet, KING TRACK (9) has impressed this year, winning his last two starts, including a Class E at Cordemais, and looks the one to beat in a hat-trick bid. KAABA RINGEAT (12), a recent Class F winner at Le Croisé-Laroche, can follow up, while KSAR UNICK (16), back in form when racing barefoot, should be competitive again. KADOR DES TITHAIS (15), victorious at Nantes, also commands respect over this trip.

**C6 - PRIX DE ROTS - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D Amateur Riders - Mounted
- EUR € 24,000**

- 1. KORINA DE BEYLEV** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 16 March. Can make the frame
- 2. KENZO D'EVA** - Not reliable but did run well when barefoot and third in a Class F mounted race over this track and trip on 16 March. Can contest the finish
- 3. JASMINE DE LYONS** - Disqualified last time out at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 22 March. Unreliable and needs to do more to score
- 4. JACADY SLY** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Class F mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. JANEIRO TURGOT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a F mounted race over this track and trip on 19 March. Others make more appeal
- 6. KABALA QUICK** - Fluffed her lines with a fault last time out in a mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. In good form before that and has claims at scoring
- 7. KLASSIC FROMENTRO** - Unreliable of late and finished 5th in a Class F mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Quite capable of scoring when in the right frame of mind
- 8. KELLY D'ESSARTS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Capable of a surprise on best form
- 9. KOMEDIE SOMOLLI** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class F mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Can earn some more money
- 10. KENOBI D'HERFRAIE** - Bounced back to best when scoring a Class E mounted race at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Can follow up if in the same mood

Summary: KENOBI D'HERFRAIE (10) bounced back to his best in a Class E mounted race at Vire and can follow up if in the same mood under a favourable engagement. KENZO D'EVA (2), not always reliable but solid when barefoot here last time, can contest the finish. KABALA QUICK (6), better judged on prior form, has claims, while KORINA DE BEYLEV (1) is improving and capable of making the frame.

**C7 - PRIX DE CAUDEBEC - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
21,000**

- 1. LUEUR MAJYC** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 9 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. LA DIVINE ECUS** - Disqualified in 5 of her last 6 starts, including last time out at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Hard to trust but quite capable of scoring when smart
- 3. LIBELLA DU HOULBET** - Returned from a break and finished 9th in Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Fitter this time but others are preferred
- 4. LADY D'HELIOS** - Probably needed her only run of this year when 7th in Class F at this track over 2200m on 16 March. Fitter now and could play a minor role
- 5. LADY FAIRY** - Consistent of late and was runner-up in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 8 March. Can earn some more money
- 6. LA RIVER D'ECCAM** - In good form this year and was runner-up in Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Can get into the mix of things again
- 7. LEANE DU PARC** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class F at this track over 2200m on 16 March. Others make more appeal
- 8. LAETITIA MONTVASON** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at this track over 2200m on 16 March. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 9. LAST CHANCE** - Disqualified last time out at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. In good form before that and has claims in this line-up
- 10. LA PERLA DE LOU** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 15 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 11. LOLITA DES LANDES** - Only fair of late and finished fifth in Class F at this course over 2200m on 16 March. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. LADY BECO** - Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Should fight out the finish once again
- 13. LAZURA PRIOR** - Unreliable and was 6th in Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. On a long losing run but can score

Summary: LAZURA PRIOR (13) benefits from a favourable engagement at the earnings ceiling and can be considered despite a long losing run. LADY BECO (12) remains consistent and should fight out the finish again. LAETITIA MONTVASON (8), capable when at her best despite recent disqualifications, and LA DIVINE ECUS (2), unpredictable but talented, can both feature. LAST CHANCE (9) and the in-form LA RIVER D'ECCAM (6) complete this competitive line-up.

C8 - PRIX DE DEMOUILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. INES DE GLADJESS** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class H at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 15 March. Others are much preferred
- 2. JUSTIN DES MARAIS** - Not reliable and finished fifth in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. IDEAL DE BAULON** - Off form and finished 10th in Class G at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 15 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 4. I PLAY POKER** - Has improved of late and was fourth in Class G over this track and trip on 19 March. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 5. IGOR DES CAILLONS** - Needed his only run of the year when 12th in Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 1 March. Fitter now but others are preferred
- 6. JOKER DE LA CRIERE** - Very consistent and was third in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Should be involved with the finish once again
- 7. JUNIOR DU CHATELET** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 15 March. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 8. JADE FOR EVER** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class G at this track over 2200m on 19 March. Needs to fo a bit more to score
- 9. JOLI GECECA** - Has needed both runs this year and was 6th in Class G at this course over 2200m on 19 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 10. JOURNAIO DU ROI** - Off form and finished 8th in Class G at this course over 2200m on 19 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. JETLAG DE BEAUFOUR** - Disqualified last time out in a claimer at Gournay-en-Bray over 2575m on 22 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 12. IESOLO** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Might play a minor role
- 13. JALDO D'OCQUE** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. Can contest the finish once again
- 14. ICARE DES VALOIS** - Finished unplaced in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 17 November 2024. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 15. ITALIANO DI PAO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Graignes over 2725m n 12 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 16. JOYCE DES GRANGES** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Can go one place better
- 17. IXEL DE L'AUMOY** - Disqualified last time out at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Ran well that day and can be a threat if smarter this time

MONDAY, 30/03/26

Summary: This lucky last race looks open. A good second last time, JOYCE DES GRANGES (16) deserves to have her efforts rewarded and can go one better. IXEL DE L'AUMOY (17), disqualified last time at Vire but otherwise in good form, benefits from a favourable entry and can be a threat if sharper this time. JALDO D'OCQUE (13), a previous winner, should again contest the finish, while the consistent JOKER DE LA CRIERE (6), remains a solid candidate for top honors.
