The Yarmouth round course is a narrow, left-handed, oval track, about thirteen furlongs in extent, with a run-in of five furlongs. There is a straight mile course. Apart from a slight fall just before the run-in, the track is perfectly flat, with sharpish bends, and prominent racers are favoured on the round course at distances up to a mile and a quarter. The track was shut for the majority of 2015 to allow the surface to be relaid.
