# C1 - PRIX DES FRONDAISONS - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 28,000

- **1. BATAL YOUMZAIN -** Finished 3rd in a Conditions race over 2000m at ParisLongchamp on 7 May. Ran well to end up just 1.25 lengths behind some talented runners
- **2. MONDO -** Finished 4th in a Conditions race over 2000m at Paris Longchamp on 7 May but is held by BATAL YOUMZAIN (1) on that run
- **3. MERANO -** Ran 4th in a Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 13 May. Tries further this time but will need to improve to feature
- **4. ACACUS -** Finished 4th in a Conditions race over 2150m at ParisLongchamp on 24 April. He has run well in all three of his races and has a chance
- **5. ZAGOR -** Ran 6th in a Conditions race over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. This gelding was well beaten and looks outclassed
- 6. AMILCARE Non-Runner
- **7. QUEEN OF SCIENCE -** Finished 4th in a Listed race over 2200m at ParisLongchamp on 4 May. Drops in Class and is the runner to beat

**Summary:** QUEEN OF SCIENCE (7) ran against a lot stronger in a Listed race last time and dropping in class will be the runner to beat. BATAL YOUMZAIN (1) also put up a good performance when a close-up third behind some decent runners and looks the main threat. AMILCARE (6) has run well in all three of his races, winning well last time and should show further improvement. ACACUS (4) pulled hard in his first attempt at racing on the turf and deserves another chance.

- **3. PINGO -** Finished 8th in a Claimer over 2500m at Saint-Cloud on 19 May but she is better than that run suggests
- **4. IL GRANDE BLACK -** Ran 5th in a Claimer over 2400m at Compiegne on 28 March. That was his best run in a while and it was at this course. Chance
- **5. NATH SHOW -** Ran 14th in a Divided Handicap over 2400m at ParisLongchamp on 7 May. Poor last run but was better in his penultimate
- **6. DIAMOND STAR -** Finished 10th in a Claimer over 2000m at Nancy on 20 May. Will need to find more in order to be competitive

**Summary:** This race does look quite competitive but there was a lot to like about the win of PLAIN BEAU (1) in a similar race last time and he now looks ready to take on stronger company. PINGO (3) did not perform well in her last start but is better than that and could have a chance. IL GRANDE BLACK (4) had his best run since moving to France from Italy last time and it was at this course. He looks to be improving with each run. DIAMOND STAR (6) will probably need to find more to feature but could run into a place.

- **2. WAKIF -** Won a Maiden over 2550m at Gabarret on 8 May. This gelding won well but takes on a lot stronger this time
- **3. CHEVALDOR -** Finished 4th in a Maiden over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on 6 May but uncertain to improve over the extra distance
- **4. DON'T SHUT ME DOWN -** Ran 5th in a Maiden over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on 6 May and is another who should appreciate the longer trip
- **5. CARISHA** Finished 8th in a Conditional Qualifier over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on 13 May. Needs to find more to be a contender
- **6. KETMIE QUEEN -** Ran 4th in a Maiden over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on 23 April. She clearly appreciated the extra distance and is improving
- **7. CLAIRE -** Ran 3rd in a Maiden over 2400m at Le Lion D'Angers on 6 May but was beaten by seven lengths and might struggle
- **8. ROSSONERA -** Finished 6th in a Maiden over 1800m at this course on 10 May. She tries further but her last run indicates it will suit her

**Summary:** There was a lot to like about the manner in which GERARD TER BORCH (1) ran on strongly from the back of the field to finish fourth and should be even better over this distance. KETMIE QUEEN (6) ran 4th in a Maiden over 2400m and she clearly benefitted from the extra distance. ROSSONERA (8) showed a liking for this course having an improved run over 1800m and should enjoy the longer trip. That should also apply to DON'T SHUT ME DOWN (4) who ran well over 2000m and should appreciate the move up to 2400m

- **2. RODOYA -** Finished 5th in a Maiden over 2100m at Haras Du Pin on 13 April. Ran well enough on debut to expect further improvement.
- **3. JANAH -** Ran second in a Maiden over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. She is getting better with each start and is one to watch
- **4. BELLE STAR -** This filly finished 6th in a Maiden over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on 19 May. Has had a run at this track
- **5. MISAFIR -** Ran 7th in a Maiden over 2200m at Fontainebleau on 12 April. Has shown little in her two starts and is held by others
- **6. WOLKE SIEBEN -** Finished 9th in a Maiden over 1800 at this course on 10 May. Tries further this time but will need to do better
- **7. GALIA CI -** Ran 9th in a Maiden over 2400m at this course on 10 May. She was well beaten and does evoke much confidence
- **8. MEKHTALIA -** Finished 5th in a Maiden over 2300m at Angers on 26 April. Ran well enough to indicate that more can be expected
- **9. LADY ACHILLIA -** Ran 3rd in a Maiden over 2200m at Fontainebleau on 12 April. This filly finished just 1.50 lengths behind Melanesia
- **10. MELANESIA -** This filly finished 2nd in a Maiden over 2200m at Fontainebleau on 12 April. She can only improve on that performance
- **11. NOTTE STELLATA -** Ran 8th in Maiden over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on 25 March and will need to show vast improvement to feature

**Summary:** DARAYDANA (1) ran well to finish third on debut and there looks to be a lot more to come from this three-year-old filly. Beaten just two lengths on debut MELANESIA (10) passed a few others in her debut run and is expected to do well over a little further. JANAH (3) has raced three times and has improved with each run. She has more experience than some of her rivals. RODOYA (2) finished fifth on debut in quite a big field and one can expect more from her this time.

- **2. KEY TO VICTORY -** Ran 4th in a Handicap over 1400m at ParisLongchamp on 15 May. That run was good enough to give her a chance.
- **3. LILAS TREZY -** Ran 12th in a ]Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on 28 April. Little to get excited about in her recent form
- **4. BEECHCRAFT -** Won a Claimer over 1650m at Sable-Sur-Sarthe on 27 April. This gelding has won two Claimers in just five starts
- **5. HAZA -** Ran 2nd in a Maiden over 1400m at Nancy on 20 May and will take a jump in class in this line-up
- **6. DIAMANTINE -** Won a Maiden over 1200m at Monte-De-Marsan in 13 April. She will have gained confidence from the win

- **4. TALENTUOSO -** Ran 7th in a Conditions race over 1400m at Chantilly on 15 October last year. Will need to prove his fitness
- **5. WAPI -** Ran 15th in a Handicap over 1600m at Chantilly on 27 March. Will need to improve markedly to feature
- **6. ROYAL RIGHT -** Finished 14th in a Handicap over 1900m at Chantilly on 12 November last year. Unlikely to be a threat
