# C1 - PRIX DE LA PLACE D'ALLIANCE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 19,500

- JOKE DU HOUSSEL Battling to regain best form and was disqualified at Chalons-en-Champagne on 25 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. JULIOSCA MANNETOT Unreliable and was 8th in a Class F mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 21 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- **3. JANGO DE GRAIS -** Finished 12th in a Class E harness race at Reims over 2550m on 20 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **4. INFAILLIBLE -** Has major disqualification issues and has 7 of them in a row, the latest being at Le Croisé-Laroche on 21 May. Probably best watched for now
- **5. KALONEK DU MONT -** On a very long losing run but is consistent and was fourth in a Class E Mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 9 May. Has a place chance
- **6. KANCAENNAISE -** Knocking very hard at the door, with four runner-up performances in a row, with the latest being in a Class E mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 13 May. Can go one better
- **7. JIZUKE JIEL -** Unreliable and was 6th in a Class F harness race at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Fair form under the saddle and might play a minor role
- **8. JUST PACHA -** Showed vast improvement when runner-up in a Class E mounted race at Lisieux over 2725m on 18 May. Can make the frame
- **9. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE -** Has major disqualification issues and is coming off two of them, with the latest being at Salon-de-Provence on 22 May. Does better in mounted races and has a winning chance
- **10. JASMINE DANCER -** Disqualified in a harness race at Vincennes on 9 May in her only start of the year. Fitter this time and can score back under the saddle

**Summary:** JASMINE DANCER (10) does not always show her ability and she was disqualified in her only start this year. That was in a harness race, and she is better under the saddle. She gets a narrow vote to score. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE (9) has disqualification issues, but he does like this discipline and can contest the finish. KANCAENNAISE (6) clearly deserves a winning turn after four runner-up performances in a row. JUST PACHA (8) bounced back with a better run at Lisieux and is another to consider.

- **2. MURMURE -** Returned to form and finished fourth in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 12 May. Can contest the finish again
- **3. MORGANE DE HOERDT -** Did not show her best when 7th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Did much better in her first two starts and is not out of it
- **4. MIGNON DES MACE -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Vire over 2150m on 2 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **5. MASSALIA DU BOURG -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Amiens on 17 May. Could be the surprise package of the race
- **6. MAFIA DU BAS BOSQ -** Unreliable and finished 8th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 17 May. More is needed to win but might play a minor role
- **7. ME AND YOU -** A good debut winner in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 1 May. Has the ability and can double up in this line-up
- **8. MISS STORY -** Did all that was asked of her when scoring on debut in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 27 April. Can follow up
- **9. MELKIOR DE BAILLY -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 6th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 May. Has a winning chance

**Summary:** ME AND YOU (7) impressed when scoring on debut, and he does look to have ability. This is a tougher race, but he can follow up. MISS STORY (8) steps up in distance after her good debut win and should be right there at the finish once again. MELKIOR DE BAILLY (9) did not run too badly in a better race than this at Vincennes and must be respected. MURMURE (2) is another who is also capable of getting into the mix again.

- **1. IBELLO DU BOCAGE -** Consistent of late and was runner-up at Wolvega over 2100m on 17 May. Tougher task this time but might earn some minor money
- **2. IZZY LISZT -** Disqualified last time out at Lisieux on 22 September. Returns from a break and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. ILLICO DUPUITVERT -** On a very long losing run and was 7th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. IT'S ME DIESCHOOT -** In good shape of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Should contest the finish
- **5. ISALIO JIDO -** Has only been modest of late and was 5th in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 17 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

- **3. LEONY DE LA VITARD -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Laon on 18 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. LISA D'OURVILLE -** Has yet to taste winning success and faulted last time out at Lisieux on 18 May. Has major disqualification issues but could play a minor role when wise

- **3. LORD DE JAFA** Yet to win a race but did not run too badly when barefoot and 5th in Class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 18 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. LOVE DE BEAULIEU -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Lignieres on 25 May. Very hard to trust but could play a minor role when smart

- **2. KALAO TOURNIBOIS -** Returned from a break in good form and was runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 12 May. Can go one better
- **3. KRISTAL DES MOYEUX -** Has some fair form of late and was 5th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 12 May. Can make the frame
- **4. KROKEUSE -** Yet to win a race but was fourth in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Might play a minor role
- **5. KOBE EIGHT -** Returned from a break and was victorious in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 17 May. Barefoot this time and can complete a hat-trick

KANEM (9) offers mixed form but certainly has the ability to feature prominently when things fall into place.

- **3. JERIDAN -** Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Chalons-en-Champagne on 8 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **4. JACKPOT DES THUYAS -** Battling to regain form and was 9th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. JOEYSTAR DE NIRO -** Proved in need of his only run of the year when 8th in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 May. Fitter and barefoot this time so could score
- **6. JET DU CAIEU -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Strasbourg on 15 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
