- **1. ELEGANZA AV -** 4th of 10 behind ELTYME (7) in a 2150m Enghien Class D conditioner 3 weeks ago. Is in competition-mode this time and with Alexandre Abrivard at the helm can impose
- **2. KOSY D'ERONVILLE -** Eliminated in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel a fortnight ago, her first appearance for 3.5 months. Has previously imposed over track and trip and with shoes off should not be overlooked
- **3. KARLA JALLERIE -** Won at Segre before coming 3rd of 9 in a 2875m Class D at Meslay-du-Maine mid-month. Has never been tested over less than 2500m but in current shape, from the 3-spot, must be respected
- **4. QUEEN OF THE NIGHT** Pleasantly surprising 3rd of 10 behind ELTYME (7) in a 2150m Enghien Class D conditioner 3 weeks ago. Handed a fine draw but has little liking for Vincennes and others preferred

**Summary:** Although winless since moving to France, ELEGANZA AV (1) left a very good impression under these conditions in the spring and with shoes off can finally get her nose in front. On the back line for her French bow, DESDEMONA (ITY) (11) is nevertheless in fine fettle and Eric Raffin will be in the bike. - **3. MUST ATOUT -** Last of 7 finishers to MYSTIC SONATO (8) in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Abel Bassigny here 2 weeks ago and is not about to spring a surprise

- **4. ERES DORIAL MAIL -** Opened his French account early this month when dominating a 2150m Enghien Class E. Benjamin Rochard unsurprisingly maintains faith and will be legitimately expecting another big run
- **5. THE LION -** Well-beaten 3rd behind PURE STEEL (3) in a 2150m Enghien Class D 3 weeks ago and is not about to shake things up
- **6. EMPIRE AS -** Ran 2nd over longer here before finishing last but one in a 2150m Enghien Class C on 12 July. Has had ample time to recalibrate and Nicolas Bazire will be eager to set the record straight
- **7. JAZZMAN -** Won 2 of last 3, latterly a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F with ease 2.5 weeks ago. Held his own in both Vincennes starts but still cannot be considered a priority
- **8. ELAND -** Surprising 4th of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class D late last month. David Thomain reining this time but still unlikely to confirm
- **9. DOUTDES -** 8th of 16 behind MERCEDES STAR (2) in a 2150m Enghien Class F on 23 July. Has yet to make his mark in France and the draw just compounds matters
- **10. MAN OF STEEL (GER) -** Eliminated in a 2150m Enghien Class D 3 weeks ago. On back line this time and will struggle to make his mark
- **11. DUMA NEH D'ASTI -** Eliminated in last 2, latterly over 2060m in Villanova d'Albenga last Tuesday. Has placed just once in 4 over track and trip and has little to no chance
- **12. DEMIDOFF CLA -** 2nd at Cabourg before being eliminated in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E on 6 August. Has form in good company here and has never disappointed for Eric Raffin

**Summary:** Beaten only by Kid Parker who has since gone on to win again, PURE STEEL (3) is well-drawn once again and looks the pick of the field this time. He should nevertheless encounter resistance from the good EMPIRE AS (6) who did not enjoy the best of runs last time out, and ERES DORIAL MAIL (4) who steps up in category after romping across town. Hard to knock at present, MERCEDES STAR (2) makes his first harness start here and with Mathieu Mottier in the bike will be no easy touch.
