- **4. JUSTE PARFAITE** Well-supported when sanctioned in a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne a fortnight back. Starts in front, returns to racing unshod-all-4, and could yet get a look-in

- **7. JOY PERRINE** Quickly sanctioned on comeback in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class F on 19 March. Is preparing for a campaign under the saddle and can be passed over
- **8. JAMINISTAR** Returns to the harness code after faulting in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D mid-month. Races shod and will pose no danger

- 10. GOLF DU BUISSON Lacklustre 10th of 16 in a 2700m Machecoul Class G last Sunday and is not about to trouble the judge
- **11. FLICFLAC DU LOGIS** Is confirmed in this category but has not been seen out since coming 9th of 16, to FIGLIO MERITE (6), in a 2625m Cherbourg amateur Class G early-November. Disregard
- **12. HENRIETT D'AURCY -** Remarkably consistent mare that was pipped into 2nd in a 2150m Mauquenchy amateur Class G on 18 March but Quentin Champenois is unlikely to settle for 2nd again. Claim
- **13. FANGIO DE CREPIN -** Disappointing on the whole last season and finishing 13th of 16 to HABANO DE GENNES (5) in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine amateur Class G on comeback, does little to inspire confidence
- **14. FRANKLIN STAR -** 8th of 16, on comeback, in a 2200m Caen amateur Class G 9 days ago. Benefits from a good entry and can make a big splash if fully fit
- **15. FURY D'EVEL** Disappointing 6th behind FIGLIO MERITE (6) in a 3000m Nantes amateur event on 20 February. Has had time to get her house in order though and will be worth watching
- **16. FUNKY JET -** Unseen since faulting in a 2925m Cagnes Class E mid-January. Has decent amateur references though and even with shoes on can make his presence felt

Summary: Quite simply an excellent campaigner in the amateur category, HENRIETT D'AURCY (12) just missed out on her hat-trick at Mauquenchy but, a winner here before being sent for a spell, she will take all the beating. With a race under his belt and form at a superior level, FRANKLIN STAR (14) looks to be in with a realistic shout, as does GRAXO (2) who sports front pads after producing a fine effort on re-entry, and the 25m head-start will only work in his favour. FITO PRIOR (4) may not be the most dependable of horses but, when applied, he is never far from springing a surprise.
