CHAMPAGNE CASTLE showed her rivals a clean pair of heels in winning back-to-back 1000m contests and the extra 100m isn't likely to inconvenience her. However, ST HARRY could make life difficult for the filly with improvement expected of him after an impressive last-to-first debut victory over 1000m. QUERARI DANCER fits a similar profile and should again have the measure of stablemate MARSEILLES who, along with CATWALK KING and RED SPICE, has the form and experience to get involved. Watch the newcomers!

On that evidence, the extra 200m could be more to her liking. WORLD FIRST, winner of that race, carries a 4-point penalty but is progressive and will likely improve to play another leading role. NOTE TO SELF and stablemate ERIC LIDDELL are also lightly raced 3yo geldings with scope for progress - both can get into the picture. Older hard-knockers ARBITRATION, SIGNOR DANTE, GENTLEMAN JOE and ELEGANT NOBLE have claims too.

He has 2kg less to shoulder and no stamina doubts, whereas runner-up MAGIC VERSE (1kg better off) has to confirm the improvement he showed last time over this extended trip. AHEAD OF THE FACTS and stable companion TRIPLE TIME are held by those rivals on form and at the weights but are capable of making their presence felt. East Cape raiders ZATARA MAGIC and BOURNEMOUTH get the trip so shouldn't be underestimated.

PREVIEW: Many with chances in a big field so go wide in Leg 1 of the carryover Pick 6. Fillies WHIRLWIND (best weighted), UNA THE UNICORN (returning from a rest), MIDNIGHT LADY (lightly raced) and MIRACULOUS (fit and in good form) are favourably treated by the conditions of the race. The latter was 2nd over track and trip last time and won't need to improve much in her peak outing to turn the tables on KELP FOREST (50-1 winner). MAURITIUS KESTREL and FOLLOW YOUR HEART are also better off at the weights with their last-start conqueror, so they must enter calculations along with debut winner INFLUENCE.

The highly rated 3yo has a bit to find under these conditions but could not have been more impressive when winning last time (1200m), so the 4-point penalty seems both lenient and unlikely to halt his momentum, even over this trip. THE US OF A (unlucky last start) is course-and-distance suited and can pose a threat. GOOD FOR YOU and ABSOLUTELY YES are versatile and not taken lightly over this trip, while SURJAY and CAFE CULTURE will appreciate the extra after encouraging 1000m displays.

He made a winning seasonal reappearance at this level 10 weeks ago and even from a wide draw, another forward showing is expected off an unchanged mark. POWERANDTHEGLORY, SCOTTISH KISS and GALLIC DREAM and SNOW PILOT complete the shortlist.
