PREVIEW: Racing is hard to work out at the best of times and when one sees maiden winner at his 12th attempt, SPIRIT OF SILVANO, pick up an eight-point penalty for beating Joe Harman, a loser of 29 races, it makes the mind boggle. The handicapper may well be right and we are going for him, but this is a tougher race for him. Stable companion FIRE LORD returns from a break but is at least proven on the surface. ALINGALONGA is a winner the last time he was on the Polytrack and must be considered. MATSUYAMO was a good winner on this surface but that was the result of a good ride from his jockey. EL ROMIACHI is always a danger.
