

TUESDAY, 31/03/26

C1 - PRIX BEATRIX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NEMO DU VARLET** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2175m on 25 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 2. NARCO DU CHATELET** - Has improved with each start and was successful in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 22 December. Could need the run returning from a break
- 3. NOVO SUPREME** - May have needed his comeback run when 7th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. N'OUBLIE JAMAIS** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2100m on 11 February. Might prefer that shorter distance but is not out of it
- 5. NORWEGIAN GIN** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 March. Might play a minor role
- 6. NEVADA JAMES** - Remains in good shape and finished third in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Can be competitive once again
- 7. NAUTILIO BELLO** - Not easy to trust and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2200m on 27 February. Others make more appeal
- 8. NOCTURNUS AVIS** - Has not done much wrong so far and was runner-up in Class C over this track and trip on 19 February. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 9. NOUGAYORQUE** - Consistent when smart and was fourth in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 10. NEMO DES CARREAUX** - Consistent and finished third in Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 January. Returns from a break but can earn some money
- 11. NO TIME DU DONJON** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this course over 2200m on 25 February. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 12. NELOMBO BELLO** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 24 January. Quite capable of making the frame
- 13. NIX SPEED** - Has won two of his four starts so far and was third last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Leading claims

Summary: A very competitive opening event. NIX SPEED (13) was not disgraced at Enghien earlier this month and has some solid wins to his name. He gets the vote to score. NOCTURNUS AVIS (8) should make that rival work hard for victory, as he has shown promise and has course-and-distance experience. NEVADA JAMES (6) is also in good form and can contest the finish once again. NELOMBO BELLO (12) faulted last time out but is another to consider.

TUESDAY, 31/03/26

C2 - PRIX ALCYONE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NOMINEE** - Disqualified in four of her six starts so far and was 9th in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. Needs major improvement to score
- 2. NACARIE PRINCESSE** - Not reliable and finished fourth in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 3 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. NOSTRA DE LAUNI** - Disqualified in two of her five starts so far, including last time out at Enghien over 2150m on 10 March. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. NEW WAVE** - Consistent without scoring so far and was fourth in Class D at this course over 2850m on 20 March. Can contest the finish yet again
- 5. NOUMEA DES BROUETS** - Returned from a break and was disqualified at this track over 2200m on 5 February. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race
- 6. NOVA DE CELLAND** - Has three disqualifications in her last five starts, including last time out at this track over 2200m on 25 February. Can make the frame if smart
- 7. NALA LEALMANI** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class B at this track over 2200m on 25 February. Should be right there at the finish
- 8. NUIT MYSTIC** - Yet to win a race and finished 6th in Class A over this track and trip on 7 February. Hit the crossbar twice before that and can score

Summary: A very open race where all of these runners still hold their maiden tag. NUIT MYSTIC (8) could be the best of them, as she is clearly better than her last run would suggest and was knocking loudly at the door before that. NEW WAVE (4) is usually competitive and can challenge for top honours this time around. NALA LEALMANI (7) has hit the crossbar a couple of times already, so would not be a surprise winner. NOVA DE CELLAND (6) is hard to trust but is also not out of it.

C3 - PRIX OBERON - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MALINE DES ARRIS** - Unreliable and was not disgraced when fourth in Class D over this course and distance on 18 February. Barefoot this time and has a place chance if smart
- 2. MUSICA JULMA** - Yet to win a race but remains in good shape and was third in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Can make the frame
- 3. MUSE DE MONTCEAU** - Returned from a break and was third in Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Keeps that shoeing but others make more appeal
- 4. MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - Has improved of late and finished fourth in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 5. MUSIQUE CLASSIQUE** - Has struggled this year and was 12th in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. MILLIONDOLLARSBABY** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Barefoot this time and could earn some money
- 7. MAGIE MESLOISE** - Did not show her best when 9th in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. A barefoot winner before that and is racing without shoes again. Consider
- 8. MANZANA ERA** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 9. MOANA MESLOISE** - Disqualified in three of her last five starts, including last time out at this track over 2100m on 20 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 10. MOONSTAR JYL** - Back to her best and has two good recent wins, both over this course and distance, the latest in Class D on 19 February. Keeps that shoeing and can complete her hat-trick
- 11. MYGIRL DES FORGES** - Finished 8th in a Group 1 mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 11 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 12. MAYA D'AVRIL** - Not reliable but did show improvement when third in Class B over this track and trip on 22 February. Keeps that shoeing and is a threat again
- 13. MIYA DE JOUDES** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2100m on 20 March. Has won half of her 8 starts and can bounce back to score if smart

Summary: MOONSTAR JYL (10) has some solid enough victories over this course and distance of late and she can complete her hat-trick. A narrow pick in a very open race. MIYA DE JOUDES (13) knows how to win races, so perhaps her last-start disqualification is best ignored. MAYA D'AVRIL (12) is unreliable but keeps the same shoeing and can challenge for top honours. MAGIE MESLOISE (7) did score when racing barefoot in her penultimate start and is barefoot again, so must be respected.

C4 - PRIX ALMANON - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 59,000

1. INVISIBLE SUN - Kept to harness races this year and was 9th in Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 March. Should be competitive back under the saddle

2. GUOPECK DE VIVOIN - On a very long losing run and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Others are much preferred

3. ROSSI GARLINE - Not reliable and finished fourth in a Class E harness race at Amiens over 2400m on 4 March. More is needed to beat these rivals

4. DENIA - Victorious last time out in a Class F harness race at Machecoul over 2700m on 15 March. In good shape but has faulted in his last two mounted races. Others make more appeal

5. JUBLA VIKING - In good shape and finished third in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Can make the frame

6. HOLD THE LINE - Well tried this year and was fourth in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Has a place chance in this line-up

7. IRIS DU PERCHE - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Very unreliable but is capable of a surprise

8. HATE YOU BEYLEV - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including his latest start in a harness race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 16 March. Others make more appeal

9. JAMAICA PHEDO - In good form this year and was successful in a Class E harness race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Just as good under the saddle and can double up

10. JOY JENILOU - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class E harness race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Can earn some more money

11. XERAVA C.D. - Has some fair recent form and was barefoot and third in a Class D harness race at this track over 2100m on 3 February. Not fully barefoot this time but can play a minor role

12. IDEAL DU NOYER - Not reliable and faulted last time out in a mounted race over this course and distance on 16 November. Returns from a break but can be a threat if fit enough

13. JACQUARD - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest a mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Capable of scoring when smart

14. NEO TURBO - Not reliable and finished fourth in a harness race at Mons over 2840m on 4 March. Has the ability but has to prove himself in a mounted race

Summary: JAMAICA PHEDO (9) has returned to her best this year and was a good winner of a harness race last time out. She has also won a mounted race this year, so is a confident pick for this. JACQUARD (13) has three faults in a row but is capable of scoring in a race of this nature. IDEAL DU NOYER (12) returns from a disqualification and a break but can contest the finish if fit enough. INVISIBLE SUN (1) will like being back in a mounted race and should be a real threat.

C5 - PRIX ANDRE DREUX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. GOELAND DE JANZE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 5 March. Can be a threat to these rivals dropping in division
- 2. HORSY ROYAL** - Finished tenth in a Class C mounted race over this course and distance on 30 November. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. GRANIT DU FRESNE** - Faulted last time out in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 March. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 4. IF I TELL YOU** - Unreliable but was victorious in this division at this track over 2100m on 27 January. Not fully barefoot this time but could double up
- 5. HERMES LUDOIS** - Returned to form and was barefoot and runner-up in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Remains without shoes and is not out of it
- 6. FILOU SMILING** - Off form and finished 9th in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Needs major improvement to score
- 7. GREG DE NIRO** - Not reliable and was unplaced in Class D mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 February. Did win a claimer earlier this year at this course and can bounce back to score
- 8. FAMEUX SAX** - In good form and was runner-up at this level R at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 March. Should be in the mix of things
- 9. GUAPO MARBOULA** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 6 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 10. FOREVER JIEL** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class C at this course over 2100m on 21 March. Capable of scoring at this level
- 11. FEEL GOOD DESBOIS** - Has struggled of late and was 13th in this division at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Others are much preferred
- 12. GABELOU CARISAIE** - Consistent in this division this year and was third at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Should fight out the finish
- 13. FUTUR DU CHENE** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2625m on 3 March. Capable of a surprise when staying in stride
- 14. GUEVARA DU PONT** - Disqualified last time out at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Barefoot this time but does need to find a few lengths to score

Summary: A very open claimer. GREG DE NIRO (7) was victorious in this division at this track earlier this year and can bounce back to score but is not reliable. GABELOU CARISAIE (12), on the other hand, has been consistent and is at home in this division, so would not be a surprise winner. GOELAND DE JANZE (1) drops to this level and should be a lively danger. FAMEUX SAX (8) has been running well in this division of late and must be respected for that.

C6 - PRIX ERIGONE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class B - Mounted - EUR € 60,000

- 1. LASKA DU LEVANT** - Finished 6th last time out in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2850m on 17 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. LUCIFER D'ORPHEE** - Remains in good shape and was runner-up in a Class C mounted race over 2850m at this track on 17 January. Can make the frame
- 3. LE PRIEURE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a mounted race over this course and distance on 20 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LOLO DU VELO** - Victorious last time out in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2850m on 17 January. Can follow up returning from a short break
- 5. LERIKA DU CHENE** - Successful last time out in a Class C harness race at Enghien over 2150m on 13 March. Can earn some money trying a mounted race
- 6. KALMIO DE LOU** - Fit and in good form and was fourth in a Class E harness race at this track over 2100m on 20 March. Can be a threat yet again
- 7. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race over this course and distance on 13 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of contesting the finish
- 8. KARNA DES BAULTS** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest being in a Class C mounted race over this track and trip on 27 October. Can complete his hat-trick if fit enough

Summary: A tricky race as many have questions to answer. KARNA DES BAULTS (8) is probably the best of them but does return from a break, so his fitness will need to be taken on trust. KALMIO DE LOU (6) is fit but does have to prove himself under the saddle this time. LOLO DU VELO (4) was a good winner at this course last time out but is also returning from a short break. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER (7) has disqualification issues but has to be considered a possible winner.

C7 - PRIX ALCOR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NIAGARA PLANCHETTE** - Dsqualified on debut in a harness race at Cordemais over 2150m on 4 January. Tries a mounted race and others are preferred
- 2. NORTON KADESH** - Has not shown much so far and was 9th in a Class F harness race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. NOCARIO JEEP** - Showed promise on debut when runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 6 March. Can go one place better
- 4. NECTAR DE LA FYE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class B mounted race over this track and trip on 27 February. Capable of an upset
- 5. NATURE DU CHENE** - Threatening a success when runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 17 March. Should contest the finish once again
- 6. NORGUSSON ATALANTE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Group 2 mounted race over this course and distance on 20 March. Capable of earning some money
- 7. NYLLA DU GOUTIER** - Consistent without winning so far and was third in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2200m on 27 February. Big chance in this line-up
- 8. NELSON THORIS** - Victorious on debut in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 6 March. Looks capable of doubling up, trying further
- 9. NEW MONEY** - Disqualified in a Class Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2200m on 13 February. Can be a real threat if smart this time

Summary: A very open-looking race. NYLLA DU GOUTIER (7) is threatening to have a first success and gets the vote to score. NEW MONEY (9) faulted when trying this discipline last time out but can be a threat if smart. NATURE DU CHENE (5) hit the crossbar last time out and might just go one place better this time around. NOCARIO JEEP (3) ran well on debut and could prefer this longer distance, so must be respected.

C8 - PRIX AUGUSTA - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. JULIE DU NORD** - Finished 9th in Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 7 March. Has disqualification issues and is probably best watched for now
- 2. JERRY DE BELLANDE** - Has some fair form and was fourth in Class G at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Capable of earning some more money
- 3. KADECOLE DE GUERRE** - Disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2750m on 22 March. Can bounce back to score if at her best
- 4. KALI DES LANDIERS** - Not reliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 22 March. Can go one place better
- 5. JULIUS ECUS** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including last time out at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 6. KOMMUNES DE PLAY** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and third in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 4 March. Remains without shoes and could make the frame
- 7. JUSTE UN DALY** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in Class G at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Well backed that day and could follow up
- 8. JOY CAPTAIN** - Not reliable but was victorious in Class G at Cholet over 2800m on 22 March. Keeps that shoeing and can double up
- 9. IMZARA VALIERE** - Finished 9th in Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 19 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 10. JAVA DE BOITRON** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. GAMIN DE COKTAIL** - Off form this year and was disqualified last time out at la Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 23 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. IOHANNA THIEBEN** - Probably needed her last run when 7th in Class F at Graignes over 2725m on 15 March. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 13. ISABEY QUESNOT** - Only modest of late and was 8th in Class F at Graignes over 2725m 15 March. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A tricky lucky last race. JUSTE UN DALY (7) justified good market support when scoring at Enghien a few weeks ago and may follow up if in the same mood. JOY CAPTAIN (8) is not reliable but did win well enough at Cholet just over a week ago and could be a threat once again. KADECOLE DE GUERRE (3) faulted last time out but is not out of it if at her very best. KOMMUNES DE PLAY (6) is not reliable but could shine.
