- **2. AL BAYYIN GRINE -** Finished 7th at Toulouse on the 22nd of June over 2100m and can build off that. Include in larger quartets
- **3. SKY AMBER KRF -** Will need to progress on latest run when 8th at La Teste over 1900m in a classy race and can. Good chance
- **4. KHATTA'AB** Caught the eye on debut when 2nd at Montauban over 1525m on the 15th of June and can run well. Chance
- **5. ARCTYC DE TESE -** A son of Yazeed out of a Al Maury mare that could win on debut. Watch the betting trends as race time looms. Selected to make a winning debut
- **6. RB NAIF -** Unraced son of Baseq Al Khalediah out of a Burning Sand mare that never raced nor won. Could be anything and good enough to go close first up
- **7. AGHIANKIR** Son of Jasco Du Cayrou that might need a few runs to tighten up and can be passed by for today
- **8. ALZABYR -** Son of Alsaker that should need this run . Watch the betting trends as race time looms. Happy to ignore
- **9. NERCI D -** By Muraaqib out of a Dormane mare that never won a race but can be expected to run a bold race first up. Watch the betting. Big chance
- **10. FATH ALKHAIR** Might be able to provide plenty of cheek on debut and must be factored into all bets. Son of Mister Ginoux that could be anything. Good chance
