- **1. MAYA D'ECHAL -** Qualified in a superb 1'16"4 at Laval early this month. Hails from a good family and will be expected to hold her own
- **2. MA BELLE TAL -** Confirmed Abbeville performance when 3rd of 12 in a 2175m Saint-Omer Class G 11 days ago, but takes a notable step up in category and is not a concern
- **3. MANGUE -** 3rd of 7 finishers, a place behind MADOVA DU RILER (11), in a 2225m Laon Class F on 29 June. Unlikely to get off the mark but is progressing all the while and can pick up a first-5 cheque
- **4. MICKAELLA** Went close at Saint-Omer prior to coming 4th of 10 behind MICKAELLA (4) in a 2400m Amiens Class F on 28 June. In even more competitive company here and chances limited
- **5. MINI COOPER'S ERA -** Produced a pair of good efforts before being eliminated in a 2750m Ecommoy Class F 11 days ago. Has evident talent and on good behaviour will be competitive for a step on the podium
- **6. MEFIANCE DU NOYER -** Failed to confirm debut performance when last of 10 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F on 8 June and is unlikely to influence the result
- **7. MILKA DES THUYAS -** Respectable in all 4 runs last month, most recently 5th of 10, a place behind MICKAELLA (4), in a 2400m Amiens Class F on 28 June. Somewhat below-par that day but still has the wherewithal to play a small part
- **8. MONA LE LOUP -** Confirmed Le Touquet performance when runner-up to MAMZELLE D'ARBAZ (10) in a 2300m Abbeville Class H 2.5 weeks ago. Takes on better this time but has learned her trade well and can get in on the action

- **3. MYSTERIOUS LOVE -** Showed nice progress when 2nd in a Class G at Le Touquet on turf on 14 July. has a few lengths to find here and others are preferred
- **4. MAMBO PLANCHETTE -** Produced best performance to date when 2nd of 12 in a 2825m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche mid-June. Not a priority but is still not going home empty-handed. First 5
- **5. MILORD DU LORAULT -** Sanctioned on debut but put things right on 22 June when winning a 2600m Class G at Châlons-en-Champagne. Nicely-related type with a lot of potential and despite the hike in category still looks a major player
- **6. MAXIM D'HERTALS** Yet to win a race after six starts. Well beaten §th at Nancy in a Class F on 27 June. Has work to do
- **7. MY JIBAY -** Runner-up in a Class Fat Biarritz on 22 July. Faces a much stiffer task in this division and will have limited aspirations

- **3. LOVA DE SANA -** Opened her account at Nancy before being eliminated in a 2700m Class F here 3 weeks ago. Reliability may not be her strong suit but is worth keeping an eye on all the same
- **4. LUMIERE DES ISLES -** Won 2 in a row before surprisingly faulting in a 2850m Laval Class E on 6 July. Is a class above most here and looks set to remain unbeaten with her jockey
- **5. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER -** 4th of 11 behind LE VENT DU HOULET (7) in a 2400m Amiens Class E 12 days ago. Always gives her best and while not a priority, is clearly in good shape and can get in on the action
- **6. LILIUM TUILERIE** Course and distance winner 3 months ago but tricky since, latterly last of nine in a 3025m Class E at Montier-en-Der on 19 July. Ability is not in question however and with application should not disappoint
- **7. LE VENT DU HOULET -** In the frame in all 3 monte starts to date, most recently 2nd of 11 in a 2400m Amiens Class E 12 days ago. Is close to his race, and sports modified shoeing, but in this company looks more a first-5 chance

Back in shape, ILIADE MENCOURT (11) finished a place behind him that day and should again apply the pressure, as should a barefoot IOLAS (2) who is 25m better off. Thoroughly convincing here in early-July, IKA JOSSELYN (1) can again finish close.
