- **1. FLO DU DERBY -** Unreliable and was disappointing when tenth in a claimer last time out. Battling to win but can contest the finish when smart
- **2. HAUTAIN DE HOUELLE -** Unreliable since winning in July and was well beaten last time out at this course. Capable of an upset on best form and barefoot this time
- **3. GRISBI DE CARVEL -** Disqualified when last seen at this course but has been fair since then and was fourth last time out in class D race over 2650m in December. Not out of it
- **4. GINGER DU PADOUENG -** Remains barefoot. On a long losing streak and was only ninth in latest start over a similar distance. Others are preferred
- **5. GATWICK -** Disqualified last time out. Unreliable last year but did win over this track and distance in November and has a winning chance

- 4. KELLE LOVELY GIRL In good form of late with three thirds in a row. Returns from a short break and could need this race. Might place
- 5. KIRSTY DU PASSAGE Very unreliable but was not disgraced when third over a similar distance last time out. Can contest the finish
