C1 - PRIX DE CUQ - 2575m (a1m 1/2) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. FUN DE BANVILLE -** Won over 2850m at Vincennes before finishing 10th over 4125 at the same venue last time on 23 January. Ideally engaged here so is good value to make amends
- **2. GASC** Confirmed in this shoeing configuration and has references at a higher level, including a last-start 7th on this track over 2575m on 22 January. Has leading claims at this level
- **3. FOU DE ROCK -** A model of consistency at this level and is most effective in this configuration (barefoot). Finished 2nd on this course over 2625m on 21 January
- **4. EPERON D'OR** Returned to form in this configuration (fully unshod) by winning on this track and at this level over 2625m on 21 January. Will be a factor here if confirming that improvement
- **5. FURIOSO SMILING** Capable well-performed veteran with sound references in this category, though is most effective when racing unshod. Finished 11th over 2750m at Toulouse on 23 January and is best watched for now
- **6. GUEPARD DE MONE** Most effective when racing unshod and has been out of sorts recently with his irons, so is best watched for now. Finished 8th over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 28 January
- 7. FLUSH ROYAL NARCY Unreliable but is a capable sort who won a similar contest in this configuration two starts back. Disqualified in a stronger race over 2400m at Montauban on 24 December
- **8. FASTER WIC -** Consistent for the most part, especially in this shoeing arrangement (unshod behind). Finished 10th with his irons over 2750m at Toulouse on 23 January in a stronger race so ought to fare better in a race of this nature
- **9. FLO DU DERBY -** Inconsistent but capable sort who finished 2nd with this configuration in a similar contest two starts back. Was 7th in a stronger race over 2050m at this venue on 4 February

- **11. ENVOL THE BEST -** Hard-knocking veteran with sound references in this category and shoeing configuration. Finished 3rd over 2650m at Bordeaux on 29 January place chance
- **12. FESTIVAL DE LARRE -** Seldom far off the mark on a going day but appears to have gone off the boil for some time now. Finished 7th over 2750m at Toulouse on 20 January and is best watched for now

Summary: FUN DE BANVILLE (1) did not shape in a tougher field over 4125m last time but did win over 2850m at Vincennes two starts back and, on the evidence of that victory, is good value to reconnect with success. GASC (2) has been competing in stronger races so also has legitimate claims for the leading places. FOU DE ROCK (3) is proven in this category so ought to be competitive, while last-start winner at this level EPERON D'OR (4) isn't without a chance either.

- **2. JEANWIL D'OLYMPE -** Delicate sort who has been disqualified more often than not, including his most recent outing at Toulouse on 2 February. Posted a career-best 3rd under the saddle in this configuration, so is one to keep an eye on here
- **3. JAGERSRO -** Debut winner in the harness category but has been disqualified in each of his six subsequent starts. Was still in contention for victory when penalized last time in his first start under the saddle at Toulouse on 2 February
- **4. JOCK DE NARMONT -** Finished a reassuring 4th over 2625m on this course in a harness race on 21 January but has no references in the mounted code. Watch for now
- **5. JAZZ MARTINEZ -** Has taken well to the mounted code. Finished 2nd under the saddle last time over 2400m at Châteaubriant on 8 January and need only a repeat of that performance to play a leading role
- **6. JO DE L'ORMERIE -** Delicate in the harness category but found his way under the saddle last time by opening his account with a win at Bordeaux over 2650m in this configuration on 7 January. Could have more to offer
- **7. JAVA DE BEUVRON -** Consistent for the most and is confirmed in this configuration, but has no references in the mounted code. Finished 5th on this course over 2625m in a harness race on 4 February
- **8. JAPAN GIRL -** Usually does well when avoiding disqualification although is seldom far from faulting. Was sanctioned in her last start at Toulouse in a harness race on 2 February but should fare better back under the saddle now
- **9. JAMES D'OVAKI -** Capable with his irons but inconsistent in the harness category, although was 2nd in both outings under the saddle. Finished 6th over 2625 on this course in a harness race last time but has claims back in this code

Summary: Arnaud Desmottes's charges JACKSON DU CLOS (12) and JOLIE INDIENNE (14) boast the best references and have the means to make up the ground from the second row to get the better of JAZZ MARTINEZ (5), whose last performance at Chateaubriand did not go unnoticed. JO DE L'ORMERIE (6) has never disappointed in the mounted category and could pose a threat, while it will be a question of wisdom with JAGERSRO (3) who need only prove his diligence to stake a claim too.

- **2. JEZABEL DUFOURNEAU** Inconsistent mare who seldom finishes far off the mark but has no more than a place chance here. Finished 7th over course and distance on 4 February
- **3. JIKOA EFJI -** Out of sorts but proven in this shoeing configuration and usually does well when avoiding disqualification. Was sanctioned in her last start over course and distance on 4 February
- **4. JERIKA LOVE -** Was unshod behind when finishing 6th over 2750m at Toulouse on 20 September but is rarely far from a fault. Watch for now
- **5. JOLINE TUILERIE -** Delicate but usually does well when avoiding disqualification and is ideally entered here on the front row. Was disqualified at Toulouse over 2950 on 16 January, so this will again be a question of her wisdom
- **6. JOYEUSE D'ATOUT -** Capable sort with sound references, although is most effective racing unshod. Finished 3rd over course and distance on 4 February with her irons in a weaker contest

- **2. KAELIE DU DAN -** Last-start winner at Toulouse over 2150m on 2 February. Seldom far from a fault but has serious means and s moving up in class category with legitimate ambitions
- **3. KATONA -** Consistent sort with sound references and a good record on this course. Finished 3rd over 2750m at Toulouse on 20 January in configuration and should have a role to play once more
- **4. KHEA DRY -** Would have finished among the leading positions were it not for her faux pas over 2550m at Bordeaux in her last start on 29 January. Capable of better, especially racing unshod for the first time
- **5. KEBBIE -** Last-start winner over 2150m at Toulouse on 13 January and has plenty of room for improvement but is rarely far from a fault. All or nothing

- **3. INTENSE AMOUR -** Has been carefully prepared for this engagement, which represents a good chance for him to reconnect with success having finished 2nd in this configuration at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 26 January
- **4. ILOU FIRST RICHER** Finished a reassuring 2nd over 2150m at Toulouse on 16 January and could have a role to play with a repeat of that performance
- **5. ISIA DU CHENE -** Excellent right-hander who won her last start at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 27 January. Maks the long trip with legitimate ambitions

- **3. JIMMY THORP -** Showed considerable early promise in 2022 but flattered to deceive in 2023 and was disqualified on his return from a layoff at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 17 December over 2725m
- **4. JAFAR DE L'ITON -** Delicate sort who has been disqualified in four of his last five starts, though did finish 2nd at Toulouse over 2325m in his only completed race in that sequence. Sanctioned at Toulouse over 2750m on 2 February

- **3. BLUFF DEI GREPPI -** Last-start winner at Vincennes over 4125m on 23 January. If he adapts to this right-handed course, this Italian veteran could have a role to play
- **4. IGGY ROCK** Continues to push his limits and steps up in class justified ambitions, having won both starts this year in this shoeing configuration. Winner recently over 2950m at Tolouse on 23 January
- **5. ICI PARIS EFJI -** Consistent for the most and is confirmed in this configuration. Was 5th at Toulouse over 2950m on 2 February and could have a say here

- **15. ENTRE AMIS -** Inconsistent sort who seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day but is more effective racing unshod. Was 5th at Toulouse on 20 January over 2150m
- **16. FRANCEVILLE -** Unreliable but capable sort with sufficient means, although has better references racing unshod. Finished 7th over 2150m at Toulouse 20 January

- **17. HELIOS D'ELA -** A model of consistency with sound form references at this level and in this shoeing configuration. Finished 4th at Bordeaux over 2650m on 11 January and has the means to stake a claim in a race of this nature
- **18. HAPPYJO DE LIGNY -** Finished a reassuring 3rd at Cagnes over 2925m on 24 January but that was without his irons. Best watched for now with irons refitted

Summary: FREEDOM (1) is a good horse and has won at Vincennes, as well as proving himself on a right-hand track. He gets the nod ahead of IN LOVE WITH CHENU (8), who has caught the eye on several occasions but has been very delicate lately. IGGY ROCK (4), after 3 consecutive victories, is also capable of joining that fight for victory, as is ICARE DU BERYL (7) who will be fully unshod for this commitment. MADAME AF DJUPMYRA (2), HELIOS D'ELA (17) and BLUFF DEI GREPPI (3) appeal most of the remainder.
