# C1 - PRIX DE SAUVAGNAS - 2575m (a1m 1/2) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. FEELING MESLOIS -** Unreliable and was a bit of a disappointment when only 8th last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 4 February. Might play a minor role
- **2. FIRST DE BRETAGNE -** In very good form and was runner-up last time out in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 28 December. Can contest the finish again
- **3. HERMENCE DAIRPET -** Disqualified in two of last three starts including at Toulouse last time out on 10 February. Capable of better but is battling to regain winning form
- **4. GUAPA DU PADOUENG -** Disappointing last run when 10th in Class F at this course over 2050m on 4 February. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **5. FRENCH SO GOOD -** Disappointing recent form and was only 9th in Class F at this course over 2625m on 21 January. Others are preferred
- **6. GOLD DE BANVILLE -** Unreliable and was a bit of a disappointment when only 9th last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 4 February. Might play a minor role
- **7. GOLD DU CALICE -** Has major disqualification issues and is coming off one at Toulouse on 10 February. Probably best watched for now
- **8. GALAXY DE CASTELLE -** Returned to her best when winning in Class F at this course over 2050m in 4 February. May prefer that shorter distance but can fight out the finish
- **9. FALPACINO -** Remains in very good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on . Just as good this distance and can go one better
- **10. FIZZ SAINT GERMAIN -** Unreliable and has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 4 February. Has won over this course over further and deserves some respect

**Summary:** FALPACINO (9) is in very good form and had a lot of these rivals behind him last time out and is likely to be even better this longer distance. GALAXY DE CASTELLE (8) was ahead of rival FALPACINO (9) last time out when scoring but may prefer that shorter distance. FIRST DE BRETAGNE (2) is still in good heart and should be a threat once again. FIZZ SAINT GERMAIN (10) has won at this course over further but is hard to trust.

- **1. DIGITAL INDY -** Last win was in Sweden in February 2022 and is coming back from a lengthy break so is likely to need the run
- 2. HONNEUR DE BRY Holding form well and was 4th in a Class F Mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 11 February. Not out of it
- **3. GOOD BYE ANGOT -** Has major disqualifications and that was the case again at Toulouse in 13 January. Capable of running well when wise
- **4. IROKO DU LOIR -** Ignore his last run when disqualified in a harness race at Angers on 24 January. Good form in Mounted races before that and should contest the finish
- **5. FROMHEAVEN IDZARDA -** On a long losing run and was well beaten in a Class E harness race at Vincennes over 2100m on 13 February. Others are preferred
- **6. ISIS WILD -** Much improved last run when runner-up in a Class C Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 January. Unreliable but can win
- **7. GUADALUPE -** Only 9th last time out in a Class F harness race at Toulouse over 2750m on 23 January. Better in Mounted races and could earn some money
- **8. IMPERIAL COGLAIS -** Returned to form with a good runner-up performance in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 9 February. Can go one better this time
- **9. EMBA DU VIVIER -** Modest last two runs and was 6th in a Class F harness race last time out at Toulouse over 2750 on 23 January. Tries a Mounted race
- **10. FIKO SAUTONNE -** Last win was in 2022 and was 7th in a Class F Mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 5 February. Others are preferred

**Summary:** IMPERIAL COGLAIS (8) bounced back from a disqualification in his penultimate start to nearly scoring last time out. He can go one better in a competitive race. ISIS WILD (6) has struggled of late but indicated he may be ready to score with a good runner-up performance last time out. IROKO DU LOIR (4) has been better in Mounted races of late so the last run is easily discarded with. HONNEUR DE BRY (2) tackles stronger but is holding form and not out of it.

- **2. LAZZARO DES NOES -** Did all that was asked of him when winning a Class F on debut at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2125m on debut on 28 January. Can follow up
- **3. LOCKWOOD EFJI -** Ran well on debut when runner-up in Class F at this course over 2625m on 4 February. Not out of it
- **4. LOLITA BOURBON -** Looked good when scoring a Class F race at Challans over 2375, on debut on 4 February. Can follow up
- **5. LA DIVA DE TILLARD -** Has made slow progress so far and was 4th in a claimer at Vincennes on 22 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **6. LISKI DE LA CRIERE -** Has lost his way since a fair debut and was 8th last time out in Class D at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 5 February. Others are preferred
- **7. LOST IN PARADISE -** Fair first two runs and was third in Class D at this course over 2575m on 2 January. Place chance
- **8. LUTIN DES BERNIS -** Has disqualification issues and was fourth last time out in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 2 February. Others are preferred

- **2. STARO MOJITO -** Last win was over this course and distance in September but has struggled of late and is coming off a disqualification at Saint Galmier on 27 January. Can surprise if wise
- **3. HELIOS CADURCIEN -** Unreliable of late but was not disgraced when third in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 7 February. Can fight out the finish again
- **4. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC -** Heavily raced of late and was only 5th in Class E atSaint Galimer over 2025m on 27 January. Might play a minor role
- **5. ECUREUIL PHIL -** On a very long losing streak and was 7th last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 January. More needed to win this race
- **6. EUNIS DU PATURAL** Has major disqualification issues but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 16 January. Might earn some money if smart
- **7. DEEP POCKETS -** On a long losing streak but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class E at Saint Galmier over 2025m on 27 January. Unreliable but not out of it

- **3. KALISKA DE FORGAN -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 2 January. Can do even better this time around
- **4. KOPECK DE CHENU -** Fliffed his lines with a disqualification at Vincennes on 9 February but won well at this track in his penultimate start. Big chance of making amends
- **5. KARPANINO -** Both wins so far were in Claimers but was not disgraced when runner-up in Class B at Amiens over 2900m on 29 October. Has disqualification issues and is likely to need this run
- **6. KANGOUROU -** Bounced back to form with a Claimer win at Vincennes over 2875m on 22 January. Tougher task this time but could play a minor role

- **3. KATARINA DU VIGNAC -** Yet to win a race and was 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 2 February. Modest form and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. KISS ME JIHEM -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 27 January. Can go one better in a difficult race.

- **4. JOYEUSE DE LAVANCE -** Unreliable and has disqualification issues but did run well when runner-up in Class F at this course over 2625m on 4 February. Can earn some money when smart

- **3. DOWHATYOUDODOWELL** Ignore last run when 7th in a Mounted race in Denmark. In good form before that and could play a minor role
- **4. HIWI ROCQ -** Continues to hold his form nicely and was runner-up in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 29 January. Can contest the finish yet again
- **5. FIRST DES CHARRONS -** Not disgraced last time out when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 4 January, Better this distance and can make the frame
