- **3. IMPERATOR D'ELA -** Given an easy return race, finishing last but one behind HASARD D'ERABLE (7) in a 2875m Argentan Class D 2 weeks ago. Excels racing clockwise and has a realistic chance of opening his 2025 account

- **3. MON BARTH -** Defied his modest qualification to run 2nd of 13 in a 2425m Class F on debut here 11 days ago. Has been handed an excellent draw and Clément Guillon will be eager to make hay

- **7. JOYCE DELTO -** Tough mare making first start since running 5th of 12 in a 2750m Cabourg Class A last August. Shoes on for re-entry but in this category must be taken seriously
- **8. JAVA D'ANAMA -** Ran 2nd at Agen before faulting early in a 2450m Caen Class D a month back, but can make amends if Anthony barrier gets her off on the right foot
- **9. JUSTICIA SMART -** 6th of 17, a place behind JUNGLE GREEN (12), in a 2800m Cholet Class F a month ago but will be no easy touch if she replicates her Nantes performance
- **10. JUDY MATIDY -** Quality individual that ran 7th of 16 on re-entry in a 2800m Argentan Class E a fortnight ago. Still in conditioning-mode however and not a priority
- **11. INES DE MAJEAN -** Unraced since running 4th of 16 in a 2700m Machecoul Class F last October and is not about to trouble the judge
- **12. JUNGLE GREEN -** 6th of 8 finishers in a 2900m Amiens Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has a brace of runs in her, is plainly in competition-mode, and will be expected to play a leading part
- **13. JUST PRINCESS** Won 2 of last 3, first over course and distance, then a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D on 17 March, and has a realistic chance of leaving Angers unbeaten
- **14. JALAPA DU BUISSON -** Failed to confirm Cholet effort when 10th of 11 finishers in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class E a fortnight ago. Handed a tough draw and is unlikely to spring any surprises

**Summary:** Three times a winner in her last 5 starts, including under these conditions, JUST PRINCESS (13) is forced to break on the back line but still looks the one to beat. She is nevertheless going to come under pressure from fellow back-row starter JUNGLE GREEN (12) who goes barefoot for the occasion, with Matthieu Abrivard justifiably anticipating a big performance. JOMA OV (3) is better-positioned on the front row and reverts to racing with front pads. Starting just upsides, JESTA BUISSONAY (4) reassured at Reims and has already won twice for Benjamin Rochard.
