- **1. KIROGA -** Three unplaced runs this year the latter over 3800m at Compiegne on April 7th in a Class 1 chase. Down in class and can feature
- **2. BEAUTYSTARS -** Fair 5th over 4300m at Nantes in a Class 2 chase on April 9th. He won a Class 3 chase at Angers in December. Player
- **3. DROP -** Nice win over 3500m at Toulouse in a Class 2 handicap chase on March 9th on the last run. Can follow up
- **4. FOLKER -** 4th last time, a win before that over 4200m at Mont-De-Marsan in a Class 3 race on February 2nd. Might need a few to falter
- **5. RISK DU BRIZAIS -** Two 7th placed efforts of late, the latter over 4200m in a Class 2 handicap chase at Toulouse on April 7th. Place chance

BEAUTYSTARS (2) ran a credible race on the latest start at Nantes and won a Class 3 chase at Angers in December. He can make the top three. TOURMALET (6) heads the remainder.

- **4. MANARAH -** Finished 5th in a Conditional over 1600m at Mont-De-Marsan on the 12th of April 2025. One for all quartet plays

- **2. JALWAY -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 3900m at La Teste in a Class 3 handicap hurdle on April 2nd. Leading chance
- **3. CHARLY DEMONMIRAIL** Three unplaced runs this year, the latest over 3900m at La Teste on April 2nd in a Class 3 handicap hurdle. Needs to get back on track
- **4. MISTER CHICK -** Unplaced last time, he won before that over 3600m at Auteuil in a handicap hurdle on June 15th. Player

- **2. PLAY THE GAME -** Supplemented PLAY THE GAME is out of WILSIDE who was a pleasing 4 time winner from 12 starts while the sire, CLOTH OF STARS, was a Group I winner and featured in multiple Group races. If ready, will be one to keep a close eye on
- **3. TCHIKITA -** Supplemented TCHIKITA is out of the unraced mare, PARSIFAL, while the sire, CHARM SPIRIT, was a multiple Group winner. If the sires genetics is dominant, she will be a lurker
- **4. HEPBURN -** is by the mare, KENDISS, who was a 1 time winner from 12 starts and the sire, GALIWAY, was a Listed winner and featured in Group races. Should be respected, follow the betting

- **2. CAMPACITE** is out of the mare, WANAWAY, who was a Listed winner and featured in multiple Group races while the sire, ZARAK, was a multiple Group winner. On pedigree, should hold strong winning claims
- **3. MODELE ABSOLU -** Is out of JUILLEY who did not break her maiden and the sire, DE TREVILLE, Featured in Group races. Others make more of an appeal
- **4. OTHON -** Supplemented OTHON is by the mare, JA JA DING DONG, raced 4 times and did not break her maiden while the sire, COTAI GLORY, was a Group III winner and featured in multiple Group races. Place chance

BARISTO (8) gets the services of Jean-Bernard Eyquem who has every skill to produce a successful debut performance. Supplemented OTHON (4) must be given consideration and does carry a place chance. NAUTIQUE (7) might need the experience on debut.

- **4. MR NOBODY -** Fair 6th on the one run over hurdles at Compiegne over 3200m in a hurdle race on March 4th. One to consider
- **5. MYRIA DE BERCE -** Unraced filly by Silverwave, the dam never ran. Stable runners tend to need a run or two. Monitor the betting for any market support

Summary: LEWIS GREY (1) had several placed runs on the flat and made an impressive start to his career over hurdles when winning over course and distance on March 28th. FUSTIER (2) looks good on paper and will be well tuned for this debut run over hurdles. BRULON DE MIX (3) has a nice pedigree and can be on the premises on his hurdles debut. MR NOBODY (4) looks best of the rest.

- **4. ALYAH -** is out of the mare, WYCKED who was unraced while the sire, GAZWAN, was a Group winner in Doha and Britain. Certainly holds accolades to compete based off the sire

ALYAH (4) should be competitive and give an honest account of herself.
