## C1 - PRIX DU CONSEIL REGIONAL DE NORMANDIE - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 29.000

- 1. INSOLENT SOMOLLI Capable but erratic trotter with just one race in him since the layoff and is expected to need the run
- 2. IMPATIENT DU LUPIN Somewhat below-par last time at Caen but prepped for this at Craon and with a new shoeing formula can get back to doing what he does best
- 3. IRIS DES MAUPI Can prove a handful but otherwise always gives her best. In current condition looks a serious prospect from the front line
- 4. HEAVENLY WELL Honest mare but not the most courageous. Is in decent shape though and will have her supporters
- 5. HAPPYDAY VERDIERES Considerably better at a lower level of racing and in this company will have little to offer
- **6. HYOU LOLALYS -** No slouch on a good day but has no love for Cabourg. Does benefit from a front row start but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **7. INTUITION SOYER -** Has never made her mark here but is a quality mare whose recent re-entry will have blown away the cobwebs, and from the front line can have her day in the sun
- 8. HORTENSIA MIKA Seldom gets his nose in front but can trot. Ideally entered here and while not an obvious choice, is still one to note
- 9. IGGYPOP D'HERFRAIE Like a horse reborn during the spring. Off for two months and even with shoes on can still get a look in
- 10. INDICE DU CAIEU Respectable dual-purpose type with better references under the saddle these days and can be passed over
- **11. INDY DARK -** Barring the occasional sanction, is as tenacious as they come. Is confirmed going right-handed and even from the second line looks a major player
- 12. IQUEM D'AMER Useful sort but has not been seen out since January and will be race-rusty
- 13. ICEBERG BLANC Tricky type but rarely lets the side down when focused. Imposed at Enghien earlier in the month and even racing shod this time can play a role
- 14. INVINCIBLE DE BRY Gave a surprisingly good account at Laval last time out. Repeat improbable but will not be sent out at 216/1 this time around
- **15. IDDEN FORTUNE** Blows hot and cold but always does what she can. Drops marginally in category and even with a 25m penalty can still figure prominently
- 16. IRON DE GINAI Moderate trotter with better references in the claiming category these days and others preferred

Summary: A veritable steamroller this year when barefoot, INTUITION SOYER (7) made his comeback here a fortnight ago and if fully fit can make the most of her front line start and win this. INDY DARK (11) is 25m worse off but he is a tough individual and when focused is hard to fault. With hind shoes off for the occasion, he should have little difficulty making up the distance gap. IMPATIENT DU LUPIN (2) is no champion but won last time at the venue and the modified shoeing should pay dividends. IRIS DES MAUPI (3) is on the way back up and, with stride in check, should not be far from the action.

## C2 - PRIX HONFLEUR NORMANDY OUTLET - 2725m (a1 11/16m) Autostart - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23.000

- 1. IMZARA VALIERE Blows hot and cold but placed in two of last four. In this company though, will have her work cut out
- 2. **IMPERATRICE LOVE** Useful mare that is never far from losing her action but Gelormini reining on her debut for new stable and from the 2-spot must be respected
- **3. INTERGALACTIQUE -** Difficult mare that would have finished in the mix last time had she not fallen foul of interference. Lebourgeois at the helm this time and must be taken seriously
- **4. ISTRA -** Quality Swedish mare with nothing to prove at this level. Won two of last four and is ideally placed to make another big splash
- **5. IMAGE D'HERFRAIE -** Hardy but erratic trotter that would have won easily last time out had she not lost her action, but on good behaviour can make up for a wasted trip
- **6. INFERNA DE HOUELLE -** Tricky type that reassured at Amiens last week and should not be far from the action, provided Rochard can keep her trotting
- **7. ISBA DU DOME -** Useful mare with solid references in this category but has struggled to find her way this term and others preferred
- 8. INDRA EURIEULT Very modest mare that seldom makes any impact and is not about to buck the trend
- 9. INDIA D'ECAJEUL Hardy sort when barefoot and focused but has other priorities and best to wait
- **10. INDIANA DE PLAY -** Sprang something of a surprise at Vichy earlier in the month but subsequently failed to confirm and can be ruled out
- **11. IGANA D'ALB -** Not without merit, and currently in decent shape, but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- **12. IRISEE DES GOSSETS -** Can trot but has better prospects at a lower level and the draw does her no favours
- **13. IRVANA JEPHI -** Undeniably capable and goes well right-handed but currently off the boil and must get her house in order

**Summary**: Never the easiest of horses to handle, IMAGE D'HERFRAIE (5) put on quite the show here earlier in the month and with form maintained, and stride in check, she should be able to wrap this up. That said, ISTRA (4) has won two of her last four going clockwise and will be no easy touch. Significantly better than her formcard would imply, IMPERATRICE LOVE (2) makes his debut for the Houel stable and, shod differently for the occasion, can play a leading role. INTERGALACTIQUE (3) was not the luckiest at Vire on Monday and backs up with a realistic chance of setting the record straight.

- 1. HERADAMES Fine trotter that won in good order over track and trip two weeks ago. Out of his age category this time but is still capable of doubling his money
- 2. INFANT PERRINE Not the most reliable of horses but is proven in better company. Will have come on for his recent superb comeback run and is expected to finish closer this time around
- 3. DOLCE D'EBANE Very modest mare that has done nothing of note in either code for some time and will have few friends
- **4. GHOSTBUSTER -** Four times a winner here and has excellent references at this level. Oddly out of sorts at Vincennes but returns to a track he likes and should not disappoint
- 5. ERASME WILLIAMS Previously a good sort but has been off the boil for a while and will have little to offer
- **6. FIRST DU BOIS -** Quality individual that simply adores Cabourg. Presently at the top of his game and even with just front shoes off this time still looks a player
- 7. EVER DREAM MUSIC Showed significant improvement under the saddle here last week but a return to the harness code is unlikely to yield a similar result
- **8. FALCO DES ROCHERS -** Useful sort when focused and appreciates Cabourg. Should not be too hastily judged for recent efforts and is worth retaining
- **9. DISCO D'OCCAGNES -** Hardy veteran that is still giving everything he has. Showed marked improvement at Enghien recently but still no more than a minor place prospect
- 10. FIESTA DU BELVER Better mare than recent results would suggest. Unlucky last time out but can play a part if she can keep her action together
- **11. DE LA CHENEVIERE** Erratic type that showed significant improvement at Caen last time out. Unseen since and even though shod for competition is not an obvious choice
- 12. EFFIGIE ROYALE Unexceptional type with just one run in her since the year-long hiatus and has no realistic chance
- 13. HIDALGO DES NOES Blows hot and cold but has nothing to prove at this level. Appreciates Cabourg profile and looks competitively well in
- 14. DERBY DU DOLLAR Unremarkable sort with better prospects at a considerably lower level and can be confidently ruled out
- **15. EQUINOXE JIEL -** Mixes the good with the less good but can perform when focused. Untried here but has won right-handed and with application will not be far off the mark
- **16. HAPPY VALLEY -** Hardy mare taking a big dip in class after setting her personal best at Vincennes. Incurs the penalty but oozes class and is still in the running for victory

**Summary**: An excellent servant with form at the highest level, INFANT PERRINE (2) made a fine comeback late last month and, after a good breather, goes first time right-handed and from the front line can win this if he turns. That said, HAPPY VALLEY (16) is similarly effective in exalted company, has won at the venue, and even with a 25m handicap can make a big splash. HERADAMES (1) has been in cracking form all year and his recent course-and-distance victory bodes well for his chances. FIRST DU BOIS (6) thrives at Cabourg and in present form is very hard to ignore.

## C4 - PRIX SYMPHONIE (PRIX FANDANGO) - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Class A - Mounted - EUR € 57.000

- **1. DEEDJAR DU VIVIER -** Has ample ability but has a temperament too and recent sanctions to nothing to help his cause
- **2. FILOU D'ANJOU -** Serious dual-purpose type with consistency on his side. Boasts solid Cabourg credentials and is not one to be overlooked
- **3. EMIR DE REBOMARD -** Has been off the boil in both codes for some time and will have nothing to offer
- **4. FOUGUE DU DOLLAR -** Gives a good account for the most part in this branch of the business. Good third in a Gr.3 9 days ago and with form maintained can finish in the thick of things
- **5. FINE PERLE OF LOVE -** Has done nothing but progress over recent weeks. Not of the same calibre as the favourite but in current form has a lot to offer here
- **6. FILWELL** Hardy campaigner that seldom disappoints when barefoot. Is confirmed under harness here, is clearly in excellent shape and will not be far off the mark
- **7. DORGALI -** Useful sort with two races under his belt since the break. Unlikely to spring any surprises but could still get a look in
- **8. INES DES RIOULTS -** Quality individual with nothing to prove at this level. Latterly 4th in Gr.1 Prix de Normandie and will be no pushover
- **9. INTUITION** Enormously talented mare that is never far from losing her action but on good behaviour the race is hers for the taking
- **10. GANGSTER DU WALLON -** Unseen under the saddle for some time but has previously won at the highest level. Currently failing to fire under harness and the code switch may be just what the doctor ordered

**Summary**: An excellent edition of this race in prospect with the delicate but remarkably talented INTUITION (9) looking to get back on track after faulting in two of three starts this season. Should she get this right, the spoils are hers, although INES DES RIOULTS (8) is a less difficult individual and could yet steal her thunder. FINE PERLE OF LOVE (5) returned to winning ways at Enghien last weekend and backs up with a solid chance of making the frame. A Gr.1 winner under the saddle, GANGSTER DU WALLON (10) returns after a long hiatus from the discipline and is not to be underestimated.

- 1. JALANSKI Not the most attractive horse here but always tries hard. At this level though, he can be expected to show his limits
- 2. JULIO DU RIB Showed considerable promise at 3 but rather disappointing this term. It is only a matter of time before he comes good again though and should not be ruled out
- 3. JENKO DU HENNEQUIN Consistently in the thick of things when applied. Has never been tested at this level though and others easier to back
- **4. JARDIN DE MAHEY -** Decent type that has gone from strength to strength lately. In tougher company this time but is barefoot again and can challenge for a place in the frame
- **5. JUMPING DU RIB -** Sanctioned as often as not but has talent in spades. Shoes back on and from the front row will be dangerous if he can stay in stride
- **6. JUNIOR D'OURVILLE -** Alternates the good with the less good but has been showing form of late. Pads fitted this time but at this level will struggle to make his mark
- 7. JAPLOO DE CAMBRI Has been giving a good account of himself since the spring but can expect to find this a much stiffer test
- 8. JOKER DES LANDES 16 starts and yet to lose his maiden tag, but always gives his best and will generate some interest
- **9. JUMBO DU HOULBET -** Can prove a handful but has ample ability. Returned to winning ways at Graignes and with form maintained, and stride in check, should not be too far off the mark
- 10. JASMIN DES ILES Has demonstrated decent aptitude for both codes but bites off more than he can chew here and not an obvious choice
- 11. JEUDI D'AUBRIERE Sanctioned more often than not but can trot when focused. Better suited to a lower grade though and others preferred
- **12. JYSKO DE GODREL -** Like a horse reborn since beginning to race unshod all four. Flew up last time out and even with an extra 25m to travel can repeat
- **13. JULIUS BERRY -** Has been given a new lease on life this season. Currently in excellent shape and going unshod behind this time could yet impose
- 14. JOAKIM BILOU Looks a different horse when racing unshod but shoes on this time and appears to have other priorities
- **15. JUNIOR DU CHERISAY -** Unexceptional sort that imposed at Laval at 85/1 last month but, unsurprisingly, failed to confirm and will have few takers
- **16. JEWEL HEMSSON -** Dependability not his strong suit but benefits from a decent entry here and can play a small role if he takes to the Cabourg profile

**Summary:** Twice a winner in three starts since starting to race barefoot, JYSKO DE GODREL (12) incurs the penalty but is still expected to attract the lion's share of support. Clément Duvaldestin can nevertheless expect to encounter resistance from the promising, and better-placed, JUMPING DU RIB (5) who returns to racing shod after his Clairefontaine fault. Excellent when going unshod behind, JULIUS BERRY (13) has been on a fine run of form this year and even from the back line looks a player. JARDIN DE MAHEY (4) is doing nothing but progress and steps up in category with legitimate ambition.

- **1. HERMOSA BELLA -** Occasionally loses her action but otherwise giving a good account of herself under the saddle. In this code, however, looks to have her work cut out
- **2. HAUTAIN DE HOUELLE -** In the frame in last three under harness. Untried at Cabourg but starts in front and can give this a good go
- **3. HARTEFAX -** Has not been firing on all cylinders lately but thrives at Cabourg and from the 3-spot must be taken seriously
- **4. HENRY DE L'ECLAIR -** Rather disappointing since winning at Amiens three months ago but is ideally placed in front and is not incapable of springing a surprise
- **5. HAPPY ATOUT -** An exceptional servant when barefoot. Arguably better racing left-handed but has everything going for him here and can complement his Croisé-Laroche victory
- **6. HEROINE DARCHE -** Unexceptional mare that has failed to make the frame in last six starts and is not about to break the mould
- **7. HISTOIRE DE JAVA -** Kicked the year off respectably but rather disappointing of late and needs to raise her game
- **8. HECTOR DU MINON -** Capricious character that consistently struggles with stride woes and the draw does nothing to help his plight
- **9. HOUSTON ROCKET -** Monté horse making an appearance here for a change of scenery and can be ruled out
- **10. HAVE DREAM BEYLEV -** Delicate sort that reassured behind HAPPY ATOUT (5) at Le Croisé-Laroche last time but on the back line this time and faces a much stiffer test
- **11. HERBIERE -** Handy mare that produced three fine performances before flopping ten days ago. Returns to a track she appreciates though and even from the second line can make amends
- **12. HARLEM LOCA -** Never far from losing his action but is evidently in excellent shape. Handed a tough draw but with stride in check can play a prominent role
- **13. HAMILTON DU PERCHE** Nothing noteworthy on his formcard all year and can expect to remain friendless in the markets
- **14. HEIDI DU BISET -** Moderate type that won a minor event earlier this month. Handed a bad draw but is proven here and can play a small part

**Summary**: Currently at the top of his game and well-positioned behind the car, HAPPY ATOUT (5) looks a serious candidate here, however Guillaume Desprez will be keeping a watchful eye on HARTEFAX (3) who simply excels at Cabourg. HERBIERE (11) was oddly out of sorts at Châteaubriant but his form is not in doubt and can bounce back. HARLEM LOCA (12) is a handful at the best of times but his form is clear and with application can confirm his Vichy success.

- **2. KALIMERO DE RIO -** Looked promising earlier in the year but disappointing since late May and unlikely to shake things up
- **3. KOOL DU VALVIC -** Not the most flattering of formcards, and has never delivered here, but is well-positioned in front and can get a look in
- **4. KALYPSO DE THIERRE -** From the outset has shown considerable professionalism. Takes on some better horses this time but is ideally placed to pull off the three-timer
- **5. KOOPLES DE LARRE -** Useful type that has shown significant promise. Was not over-taxed on comeback but looks a serious proposition this time around
- **6. KAZACHOK -** Made a lot of progress at the end of last term. Comes here fresh and with Nivard in the wagon will be afforded every chance
- **7. KAPITOL JIHAIME -** Tends to be seen at his best in the claiming division these days but encouraged at Graignes and should be able to pick up a first-five cheque
- **8. KINGALO -** Failed to stay in stride first time out but entrusted to a leading jockey this time and, if as good as believed, should figure prominently
- **9. KARL THORDARSSON -** Modest trotter that has yet to show any particular aptitude for the game and can be passed over
- **10. KISSMAN -** Sanctioned in both public appearances to date and from the second line will struggle to make any impact
- **11. KEMISSORO -** Just one respectable run on his formsheet so far and the draw only adds insult to injury

**Summary**: Winner on debut last month, KALYPSO DE THIERRE (4) went on to score again a fortnight later, and from the 4-spot can keep his successful streak going. He will still meet opposition from the promising KOOPLES DE LARRE (5) who will have come on for his comeback run at Clairefontaine last Sunday. KAZACHOK (6) started to come into himself before being sent for a spell and even though unseen since, he will be reined by Franck Nivard, and should not disappoint. Well-regarded at home, KINGALO (8) lost his action on debut but with Lebourgeois in the saddle this time should be able to bounce back.

- 3. KALMIE HAUFOR Makes first public appearance with a top jockey on board and if as good in competition as she was in qualification, there should be a cheque here for her
- 4. KAMARIE DU SKY Racecourse debutante from a respectable stable. Qualified respectably at Grosbois in May and can expect to generate some interest
- 5. KALONE DE MORGANE Faulted on monté debut but Larue has fitted her with pads this time and should logically show improvement
- 6. KAVIVE Three starts under the saddle to date but has looked very ordinary and will have few friends
- 7. KYARA ARROW Modest filly that has failed to finish closer than 5th in as many public appearances and will be lonely in the markets
- 8. KALIE DE L'ORMERIE Was not disgraced on debut but sanctioned in both since and must reaffirm
- 9. KALMIA DES NOES Well-regarded filly that has shown considerable potential. Pads on all four this time and with Lebourgeois in the hot seat can finally get off the mark
- 10. KIARA DU MARLOU Unexceptional filly that was sanctioned on sole start in the discipline and not an obvious choice
- 11. KARRY WHITE Placed just once in four appearances in the code. Shod for second start back and others easier to support
- 12. KE J'AIME VENISE Produced a pair of decent efforts during the spring but has been disappointing since and chances limited
- 13. KIVIANA Useful filly that has been progressing nicely. Unlikely to open her account but can still get in on the action
- 14. KRISTA TEJY Showed a different side to herself last time out. Benjamin Rochard in charge of her first steps under the saddle and should not disappoint
- **15. KAYENNE** Has looked a different horse since changing vocation. Produced her career-best effort at Agon recently and with pads fitted this time will have her chances
- **16. KELLY DE BANVILLE -** Gave a fine account of herself under the saddle at Caen last month. Ploquin knows her well and, with stride in check, will have a lot to offer

**Summary**: Delicate she may be but KALMIA DES NOES (9) has shown significant aptitude for the monté code; she is fitted with pads for the first time, entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois for the occasion, and looks a serious proposition. KRISTA TEJY (14) switches code after opening her harness account and if form transitions, she should be in a position to apply the pressure. KELLY DE BANVILLE (16) came close to losing her maiden status at Caen last month and is again expected to play a leading role. KALMIE HAUFOR (3) makes her racecourse debut after having qualified well and the engagement of David Thomain will attract attention.
