- **2. MALICIA JIEL -** Makes her debut 8 months after having qualified in 1'18"9 under harness at Grosbois last July. Will have come here with work in her and can be assured considerable support
- **3. MAMAMIA DE MAKHI -** Qualified decently in 1'19"2 here last November. Not a leading contender but is plainly a promising sort who should not be too far off the mark

- **18. IDEAL DELADOU -** Made it 4 consecutive sanctions after faulting, when full of running, in a 2800m Argentan Class E a week ago. Is close to his race, ideally-engaged, and on good behaviour can make a big impact

Summary: Although never far from losing her action, ISIA DU CHENE (13) has bags of ability. She proved the point under these conditions earlier in the month and legitimately bids to keep her unbeaten Caen record intact. She gives recent Châtelaillon-La Rochelle winner, the freshly-barefoot IVORY DU CHERISAY (5), 25m though and can expect resistance. IDEAL DELADOU (18) has picked up a quartet of sanctions but has evident ability and can play a key part if focused. IDEO JOSSELYN (4) may not be the easiest of horses to handle but he excels at Caen and with David Thomain in the bike can begin to make amends.
